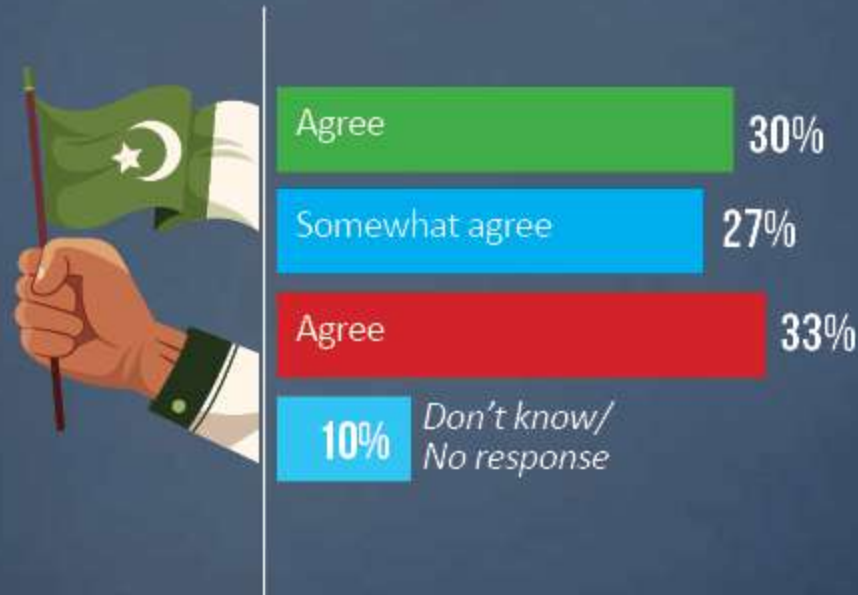

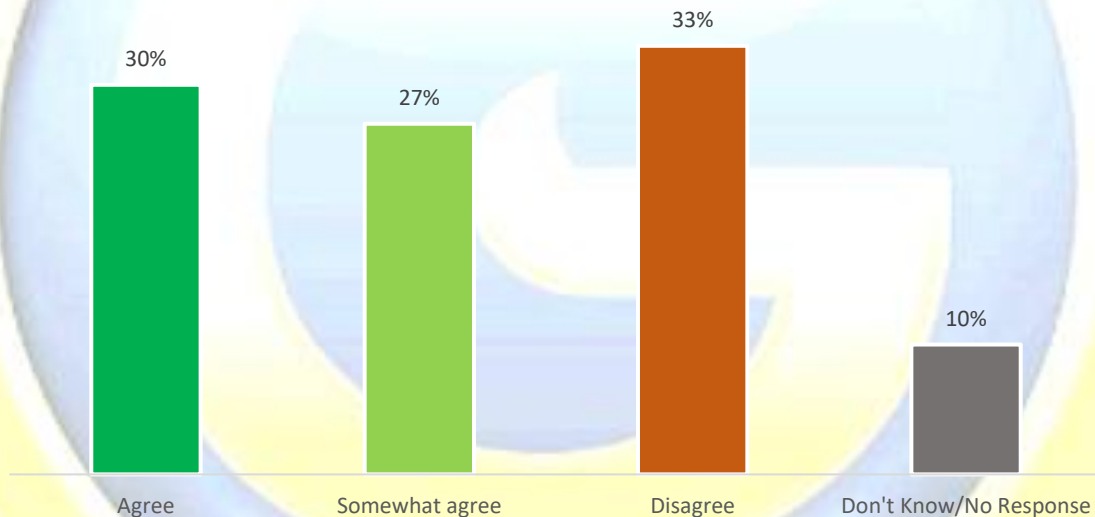
Nearly 6 out of 10 Pakistanis (57%) are optimistic and believe that Pakistan will develop a lot in the next ten years: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 28th February, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 6 out of 10 Pakistanis (57%) believe that Pakistan will develop further in the next ten years.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell me to what extent you agree with the statement, “I believe that Pakistan will develop a lot in the next ten years?” In response, 30% said ‘Agree’, 27% said ‘Somewhat agree’, 33% said ‘Disagree’, and 10% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
