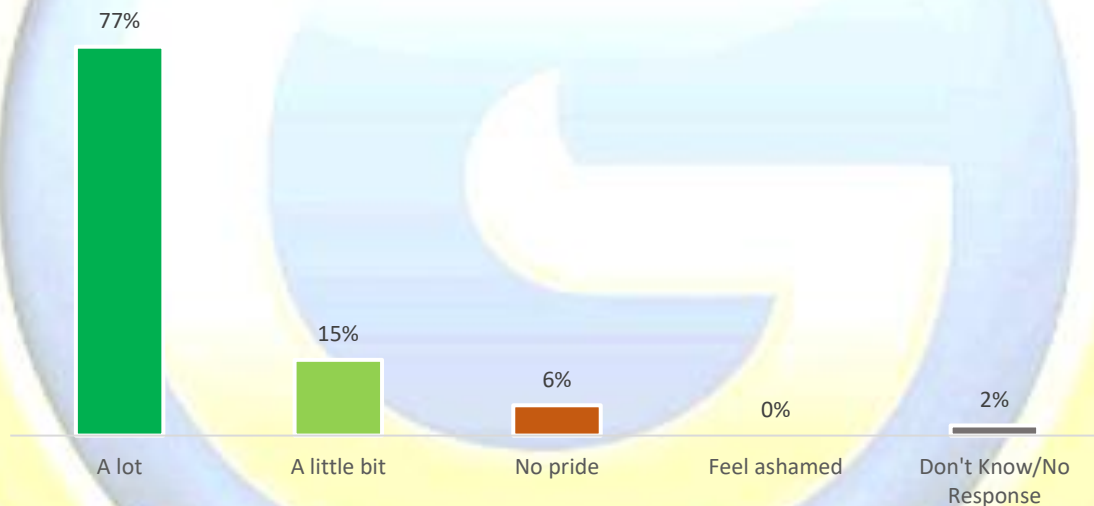
77% Pakistanis feel a lot of pride in their national identity, another 15% feel pride: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 29th February, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 77% Pakistanis feel a lot of pride in their national identity.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “How proud are you to call yourself a Pakistani?” In response, 77% said ‘A lot’, 15% said ‘A little bit’, 6% said ‘No pride’, 0% said they ‘Feel ashamed’, and 2% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
