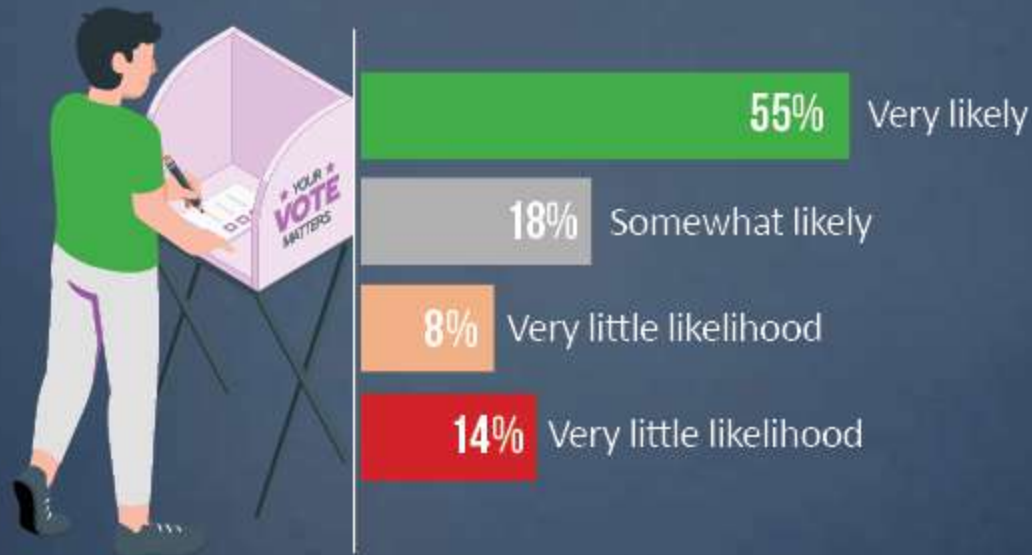

APPROXIMATELY 3 IN 4 RESPONDENTS (73%) ARE EITHER VERY LIKELY OR SOMEWHAT LIKELY TO VOTE IN THE UPCOMING ELECTIONS, INTENTION TO VOTE LOWER AS COMPARED TO 2013 AND 2018 GENERAL ELECTIONS: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

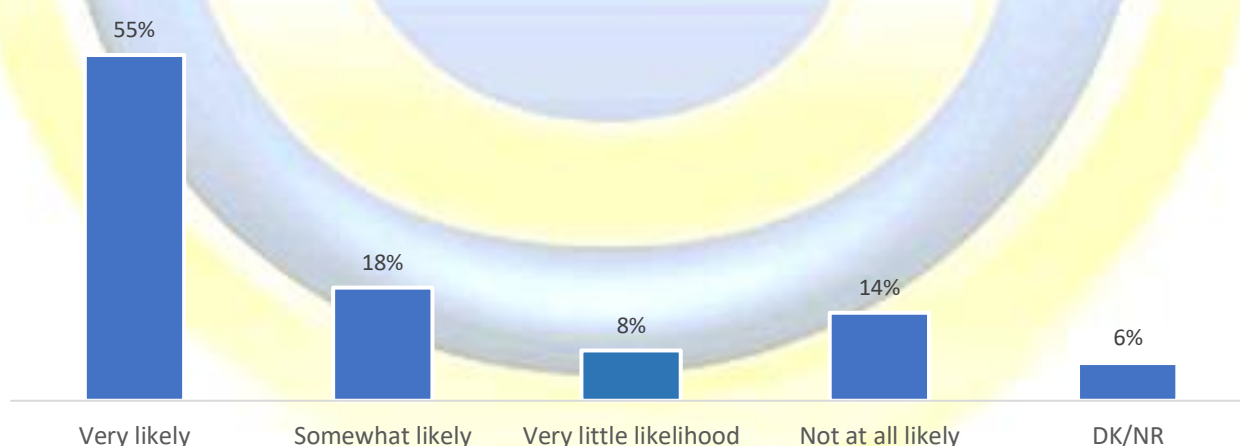

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, approximately 3 in 4 respondents (73%) are either very likely or somewhat likely to vote in the upcoming elections.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, "Please indicate the likelihood that you will vote in the upcoming elections." In response, 55% said 'Very likely,' 18% said 'Somewhat likely,' 8% said 'very little likelihood,' 14% said not at all likely, and 6% said that they did not know or gave no response.

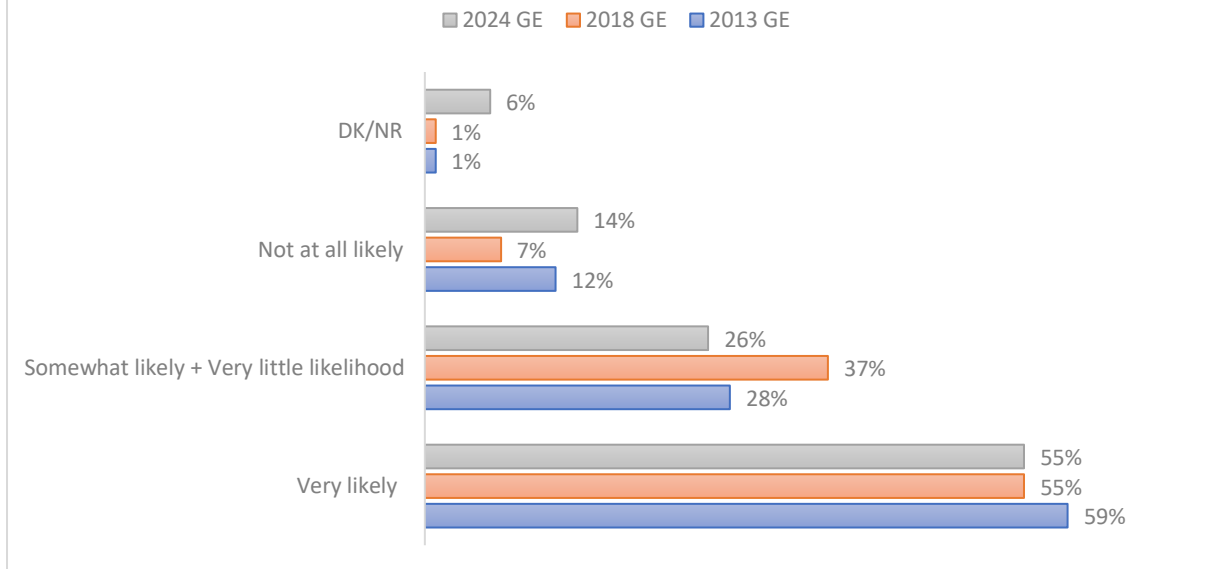
When similar surveys were done prior to General Election 2018 and 2013, the results were not entirely different however this time those intending to not vote and those who chose not to respond to the question combined is more than before (20% before GE 2024 compared to 8% before GE 2018 and 13% before GE 2013). This fact could indicate a potential drop in turnout for 2024 election as compared to 2018 and 2013 elections.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1500 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted on 26th Jan - 2nd Feb 2024, 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
