PTI gets close to 18 million votes, PMLN 14 million votes, PPP 8.2 million votes: Gallup Pakistan
Digital Analytics on Elections

(Islamabad, Pakistan) 26th February, 2024

Gallup Pakistan Digital Analytics team on Elections has performed analytics on Election 2024 data released so far by Election Commission of Pakistan. The results reveal that PTI gets close to 18 million votes, PMLN 14 million votes, PPP 8.2 million votes.

Other salient findings are as follows:

1. Close to 60 million votes were casted in Election 2024 on Feb 8th (59.2 million)
2. After PTI, PML-N and PPP respectively, the 4th largest party in the country was TLP with 2.8 million votes
3. JUI-F, and JI got 2.1 million and 1.3 million votes respectively (their combined votes are only slightly more than TLP)
4. Close to 90% votes that PML-N received were from Punjab. PPP got 63% of its own votes from Sindh (rest were spread across other provinces), PTI got close to 72% of its own votes from Punjab alone.
5. In Punjab province, PML-N and PTI are quite close to each other in terms of votes (PTI 13.3 and PML-N 12.4 million votes respectively)

METHODOLOGY:

The press release is based on data from the Form 47 of the Provisional Results Dashboard from the Election Commission of Pakistan website, noting the details of votes cast in each polling station. The data has been computed to represent overall results at the provincial and national levels.

Gallup Pakistan Electoral Repository: An Introduction

The Gallup Pakistan Electoral Repository is comprised of the following sources:

1. Election Commission data on past 11 elections in Pakistan, available over each constituency. This data was acquired from Election Commission website and converted into digital database in SPSS form and is now referred to as Gilani Index of Electoral Record.
2. Gallup Exit Polls for every election since 1985.
3. Gallup pre and post-election survey record since 1985.
4. Analysis by Dr. Ijaz Shafi Gilani on elections piece by piece, as well as in combined form.
