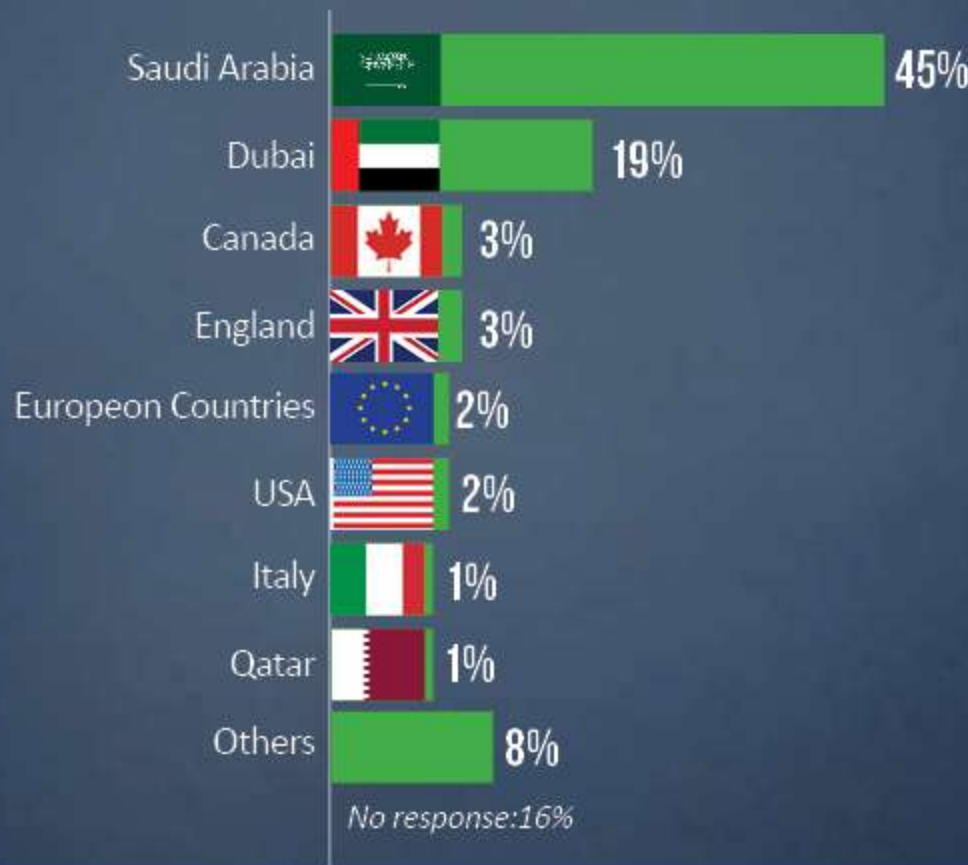

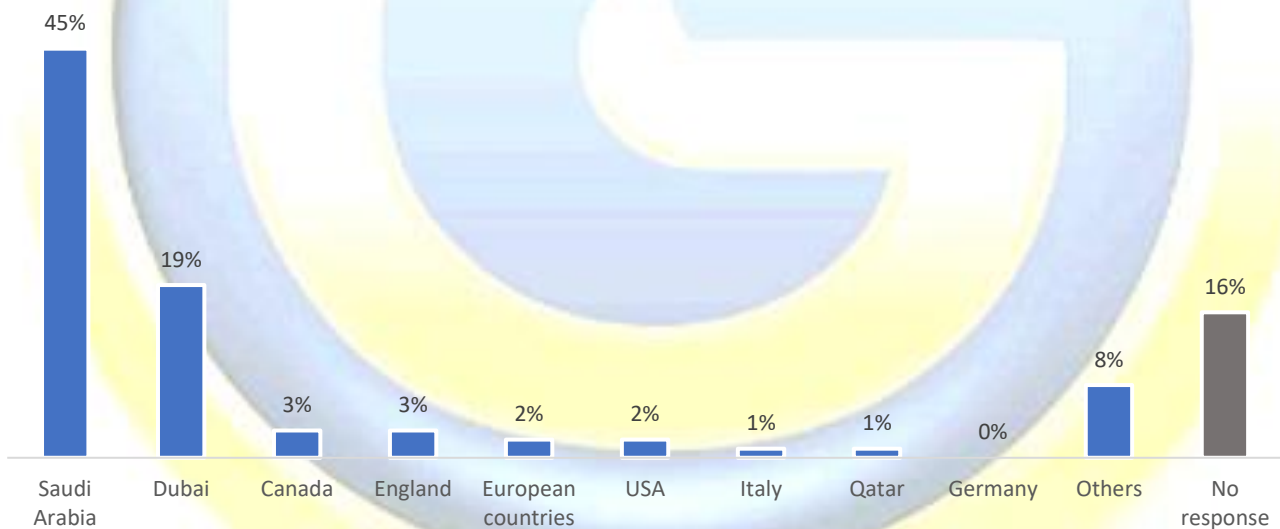

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, of the Pakistanis having thought about moving abroad for work, nearly half (45%) expressed an inclination towards Saudi Arabia.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell (if you have thought about moving abroad for work) which country you have thought about moving to work for?” In response, 45% said ‘Saudi Arabia’, 19% said ‘Dubai’, 3% said ‘Canada’, 3% said ‘England’, 2% said ‘European countries’, 2% said ‘USA’, 1% said ‘Italy’, 1% said ‘Qatar’, 0% said ‘Germany’, 8% said ‘Others’, and 16% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
