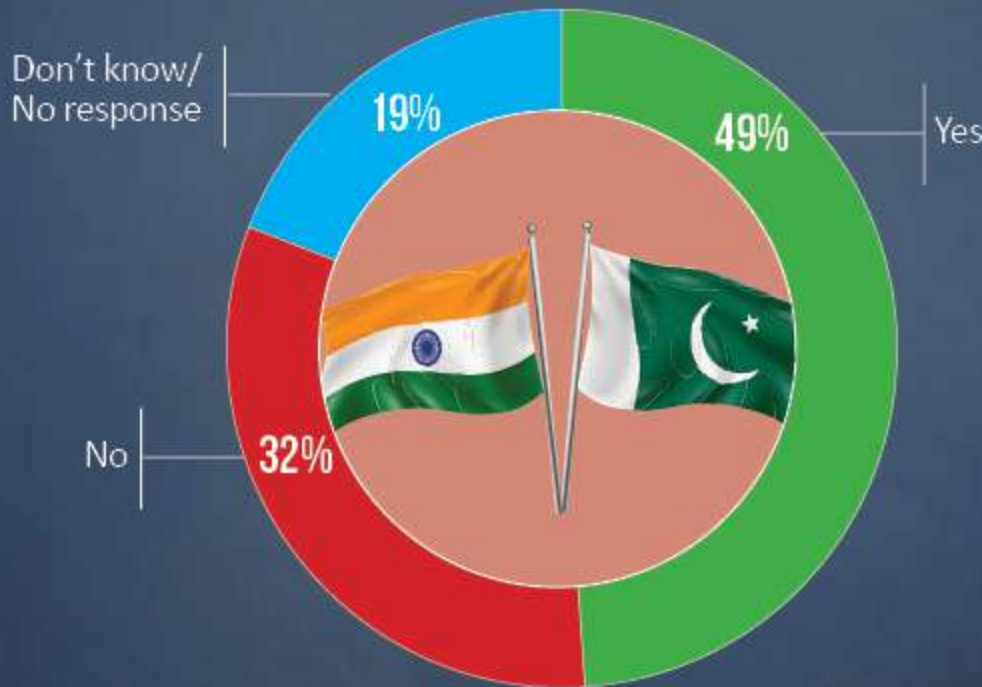

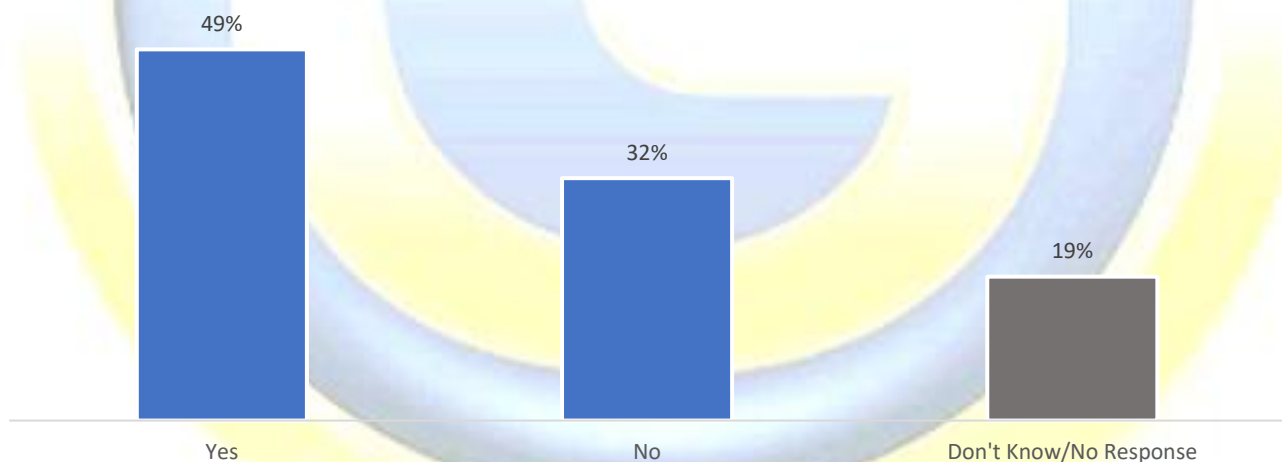
Nearly half of Pakistanis (49%) are of the opinion that air and land connections between Pakistan and India should be restored: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly half of Pakistanis (49%) are of the opinion that air and land connections between Pakistan and India should be restored.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Some people say that air and land connections between Pakistan and India should be restored. While some oppose it. Do you think land and air connections between Pakistan and India should be restored or not?” In response, 49% said ‘Yes’, 32% said ‘No’, and 19% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
