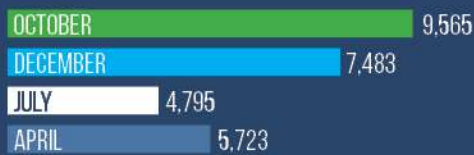


US Visa issuance 2018 to 2023:

Non-immigrant visas showed a steady increase from 40,679 in 2018 to 80,852 in 2023, and while Immigrant visas fluctuated they too increased from 10,114 in 2018 to 16,320 in 2023.

NON-IMMIGRATION US VISA ISSUANCE:

A fluctuating trend was observed for Pakistan with peaks in October (9,565) and December (7,483) and lows in July (4,795) and April (5,723).



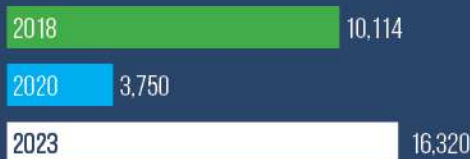
BREAKDOWN IN 2023:

Business & pleasure led with 85.11%, students visa making up 3.67%, while "Temporary Workers" only made up 1.33%.



IMMIGRANT US VISA ISSUANCE:

Immigrant visa issuances fluctuated, with 10,114 visas issued in 2018, 3,750 in 2020 and 16,320 immigrant visas issued in the year 2023.



BREAKDOWN IN 2023:

"Special immigrants" led with 46.65%, closely followed by "Immediate relatives of US citizens" at 32.22%, while "Employment based" visas only made up 1.41% of the Immigrant US Visas issued in 2023, indicating a lesser reliance in work-related sponsorship.

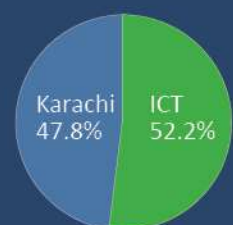


TREND OF US VISA ISSUANCE FOR PAKISTANIS SINCE 2018:

Analyzing visa trends from 2018 to 2023: Non-immigrant visas showed a steady increase from 40,679 in 2018 to 80,852 in 2023. Conversely, immigrant visas fluctuated, with a noticeable drop in 2020 due to Covid-19, but experienced a rebound in 2022 and 2023.

We believe that by making available data accessible to wider population, the level of debate in terms of quality of arguments would improve which would help come up with better policy prescriptions. Immigration or influx from Pakistan is one such issue on which a lot of speculation has been done. In this current Press Release and the Dashboard, we are making public, the trends are far more conservative and sobering than the usual debate. There is an increased number of immigrant visas from Pakistan to US but the numbers are still very low as compared to Pakistan's population. More conversation on why people are leaving and if their leaving the country is beneficial for the country must be held in a more nuanced fashion*'

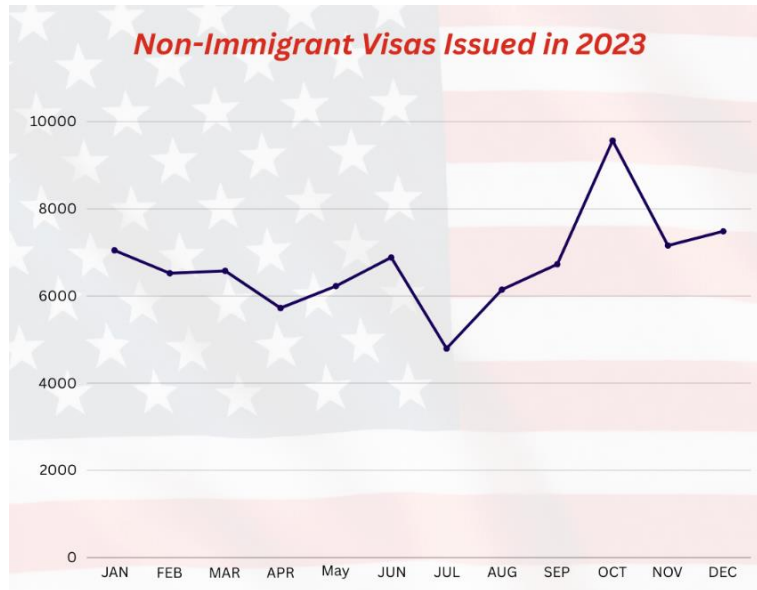
1. There was a fluctuating trend of non-immigration US visas issued for Pakistanis in 2023, with peaks in October (9,565) and December (7,483), and low points in July (4,795) and April (5,723), highlighting potential seasonal patterns or shifts in travel behaviour.
2. Across categories: “Business & pleasure” led with 85.11% of the visas issued, followed by “Student” making up 3.67% of the visas issued, while “Temporary Workers” only made up 1.33% of the total Non-Immigration US Visas issued in 2023.
3. Immigrant US visa issuance for Pakistanis fluctuated month-to-month, reflecting varying demand.
4. Across categories: “Special immigrants” led with 46.65%, closely followed by “Immediate relatives of US citizens” at 32.22%, while “Employment based” visas only made up 1.41% of the Immigrant US Visas issued in 2023, indicating a lesser reliance in work-related sponsorship.

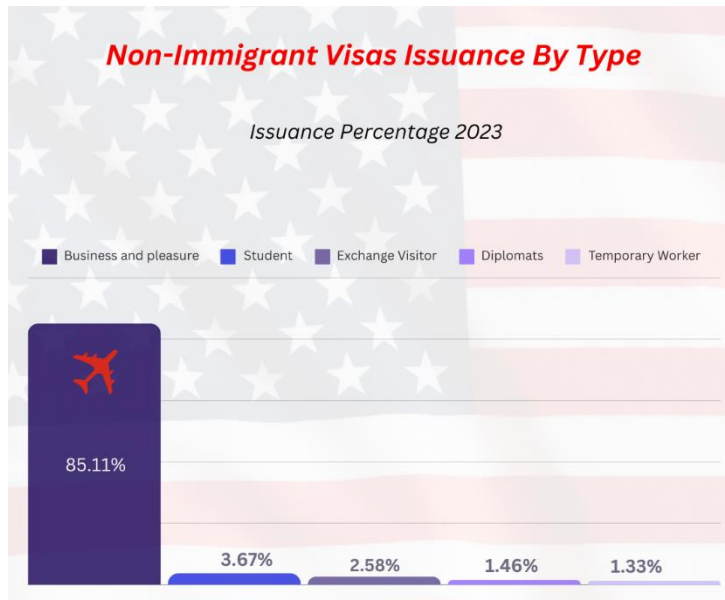
1. Non-Immigration US Visa issuance in 2023 for Pakistanis:

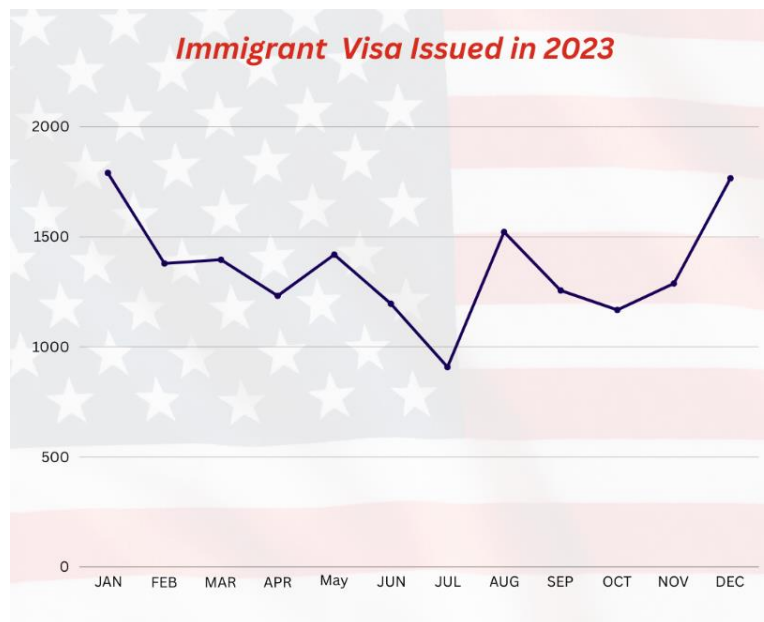
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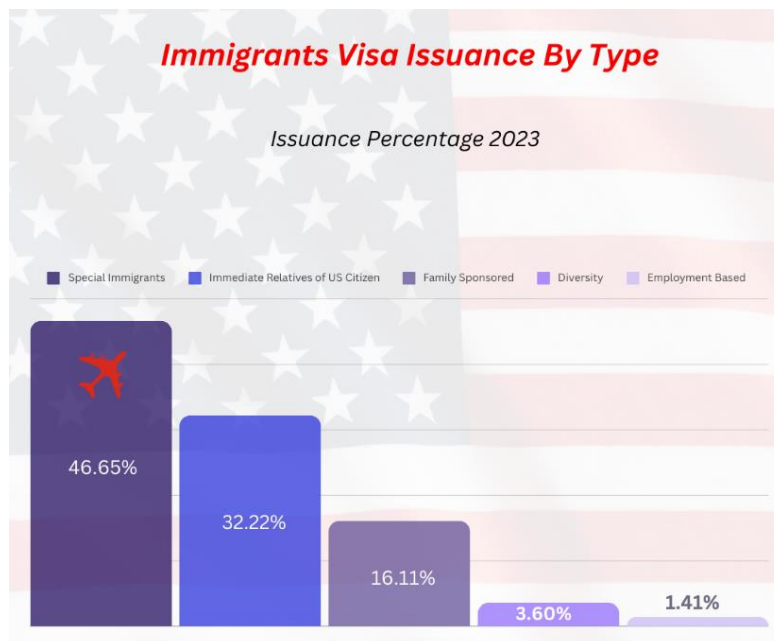

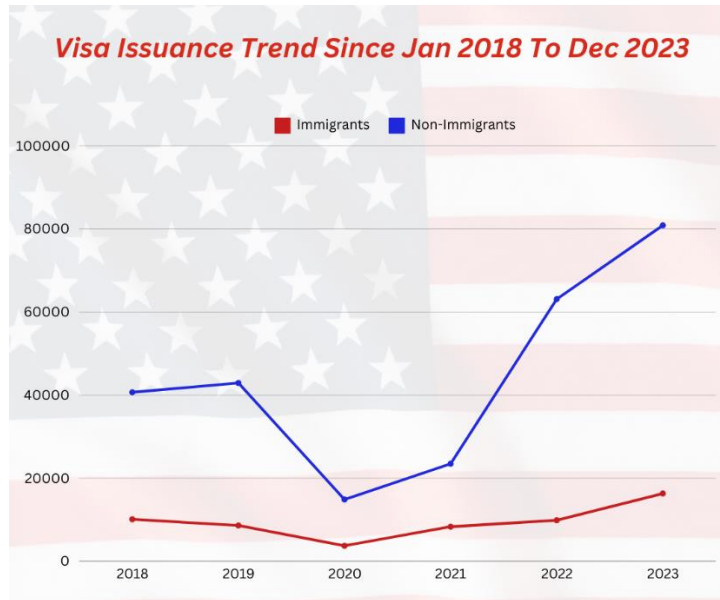

3. Trend of US Visa issuance for Pakistanis since 2018:

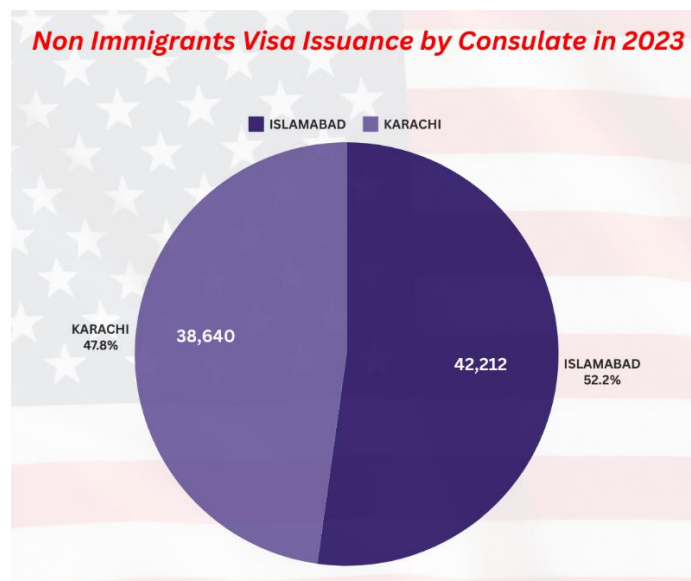
