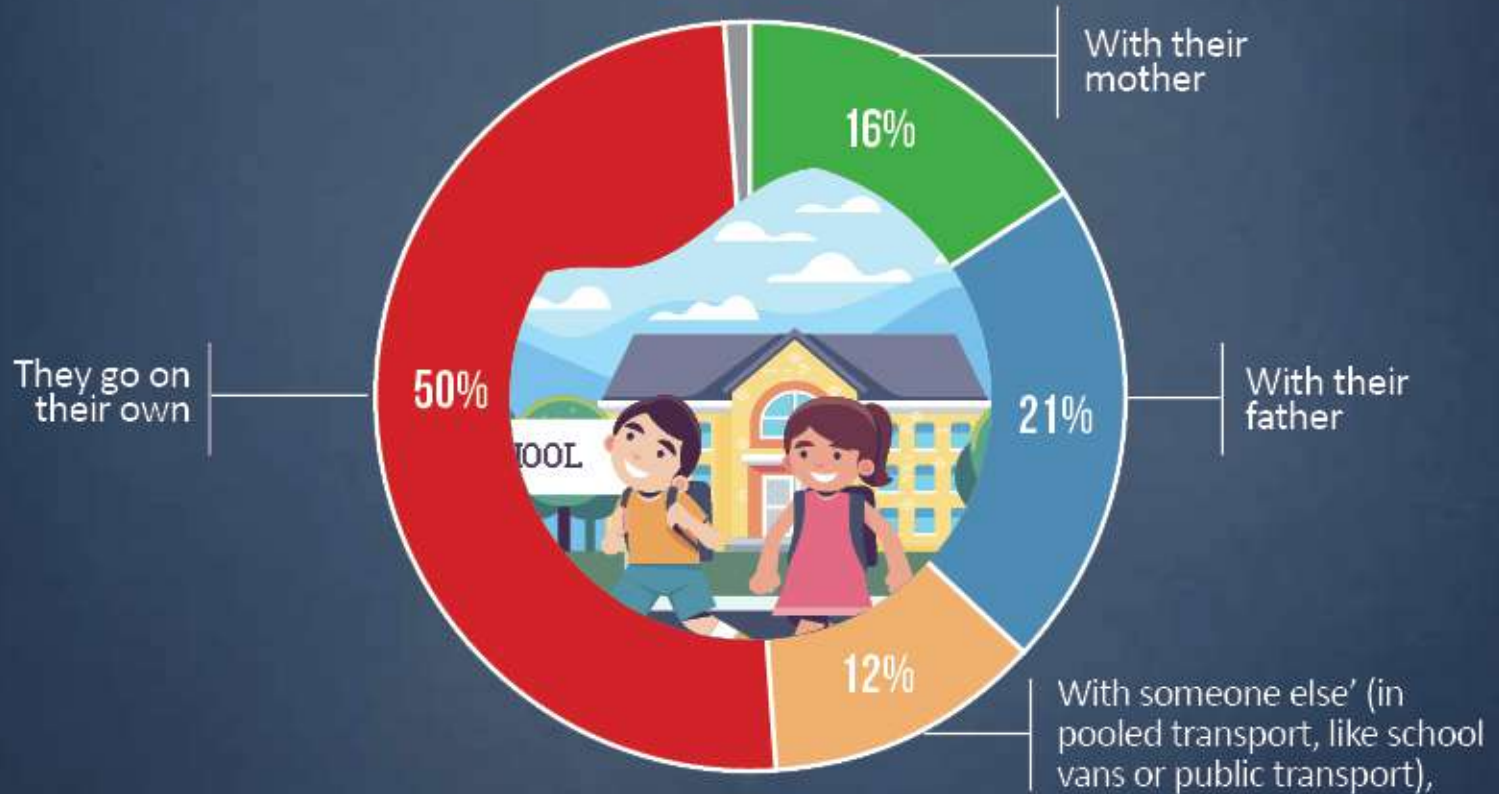

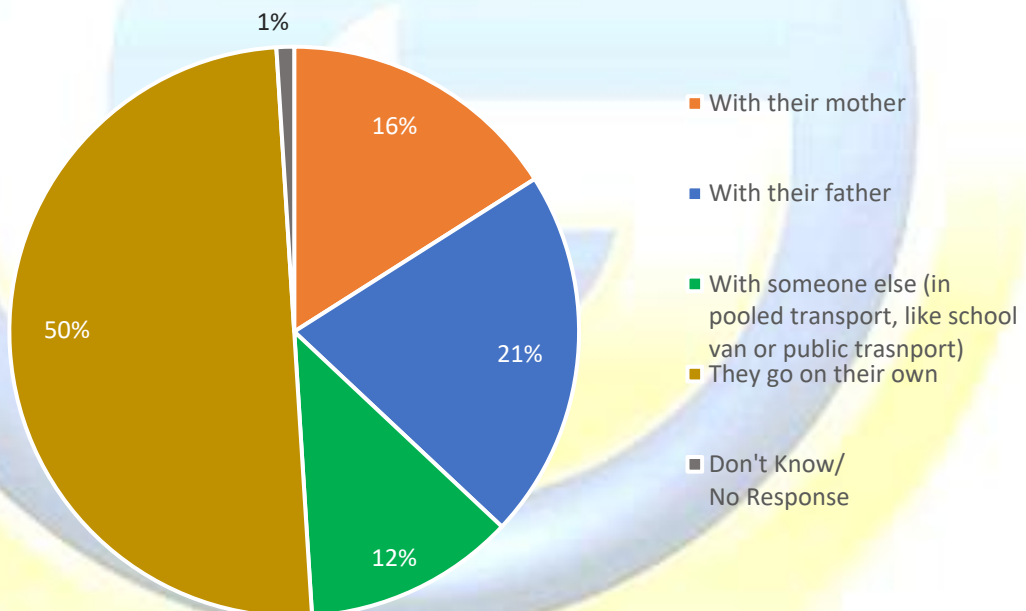
Half of Pakistani parents (50%) report that their children go to school on their own, while 12% go in pooled transportation (like school vans or public transport): Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, half of Pakistani parents (50%) report that their children go to school on their own, while 12% go in pooled transportation (like school vans or public transport).

A nationally representative sample of adult parents from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell who your children go to school with?” In response, 16% said ‘With their mother’, 21% said ‘With their father’, 12% said ‘With someone else’ (in pooled transport, like school vans or public transport), 50% said ‘They go on their own’, and 1% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 579 adult parents whose children go to school in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 18th- 25th March 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
