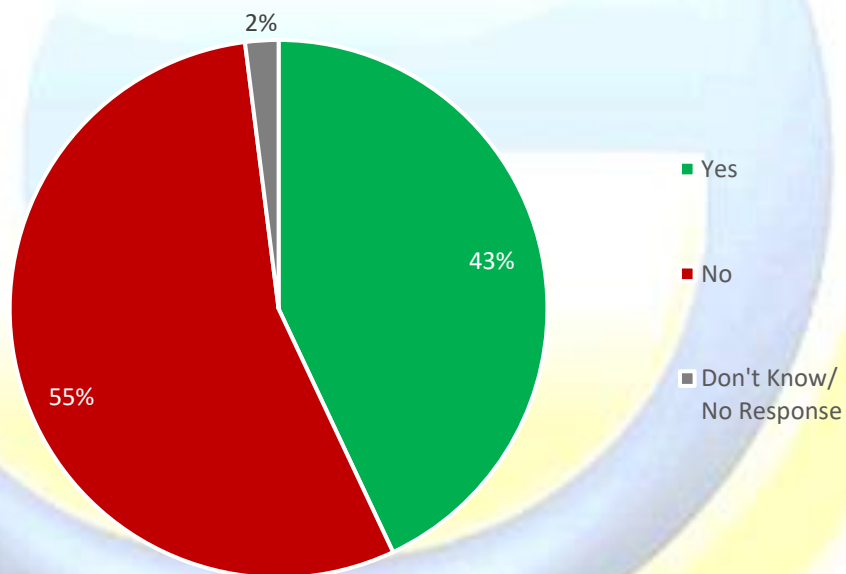
Among those parents who had a Quranic teacher for their children, 55% report paying no monetary compensation to the teacher: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, among those parents who had a Quranic teacher for their children, 55% report paying no monetary compensation to the teacher.

A nationally representative sample of adult parents from across the country was asked the question, “Please let us know if you pay or paid any compensation to this reciter?” In response, 43% said ‘Yes’, and 55% said ‘No’, while 2% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 608 adult parents whose children studied Quran from Quran teachers in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 18th- 25th March 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
