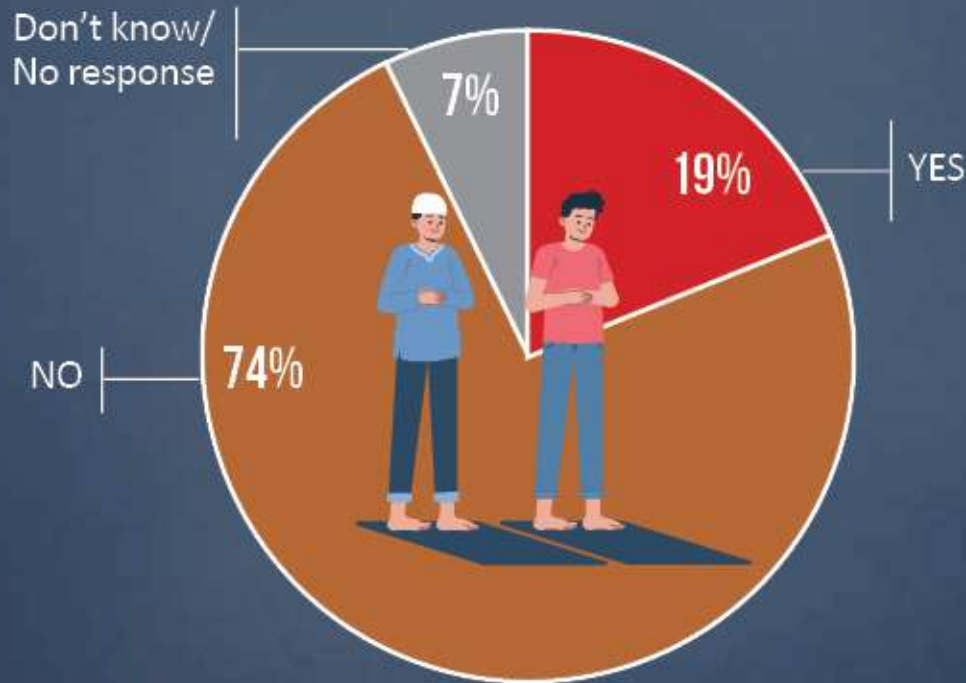

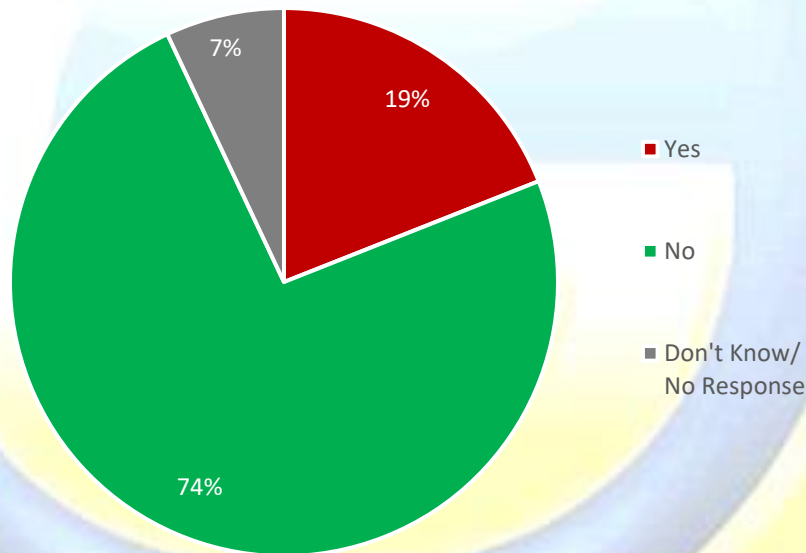
Nearly 2 in 10 Pakistani men (19%) report their fathers having lost their shoes while offering prayers at mosques: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 3rd June, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 2 in 10 Pakistani men (19%) report their fathers having lost their shoes while offering prayers at mosques.

A nationally representative sample of adult men from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell me if your father ever went to mosque and lost his shoes?” In response, 19% said ‘Yes’, while 74% said ‘No’, and 7% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,767 men in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 18th- 25th March 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
