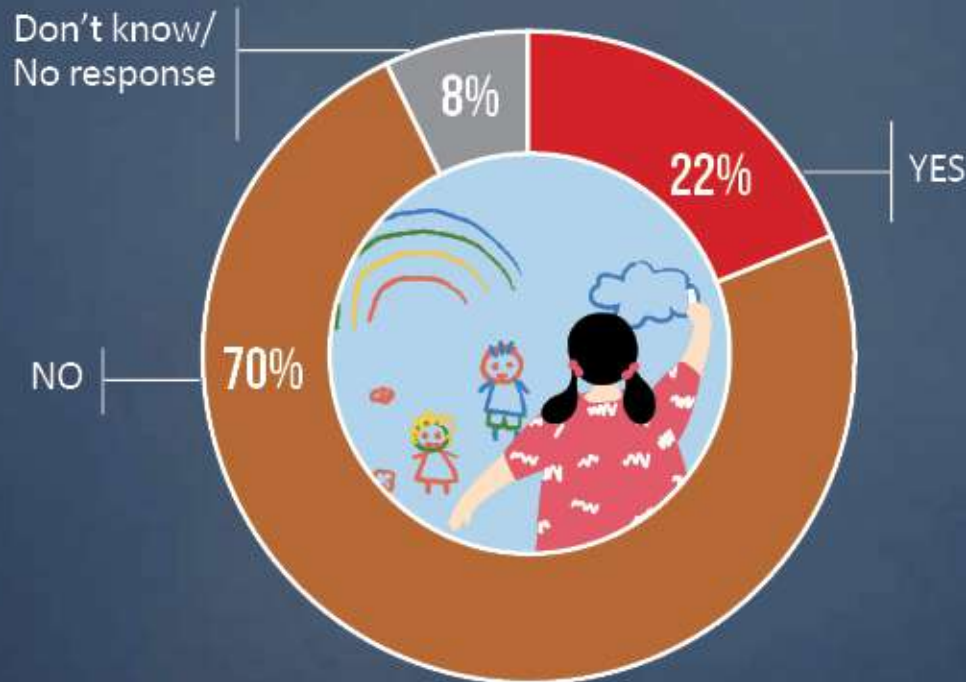

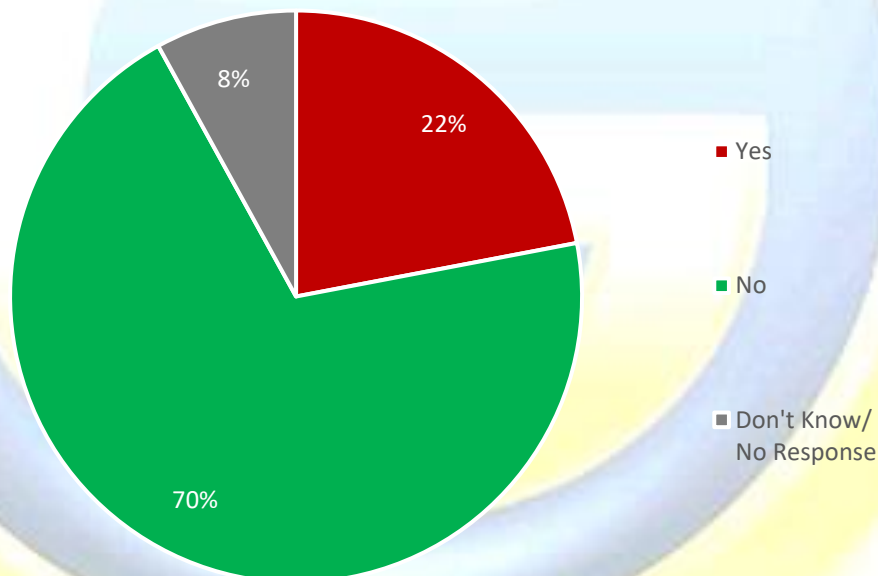
Less than a quarter of Pakistanis (22%) report having had the habit of writing on walls during their childhood: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 4th June, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, less than a quarter of Pakistanis (22%) report having had the habit of writing on walls during their childhood.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Thinking back to your childhood, did you have the habit of writing on the walls or did you ever draw on the wall at school or at home?” In response, 22% said ‘Yes’, 70% said ‘No’, and 8% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2,161 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 18th- 25th March 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
