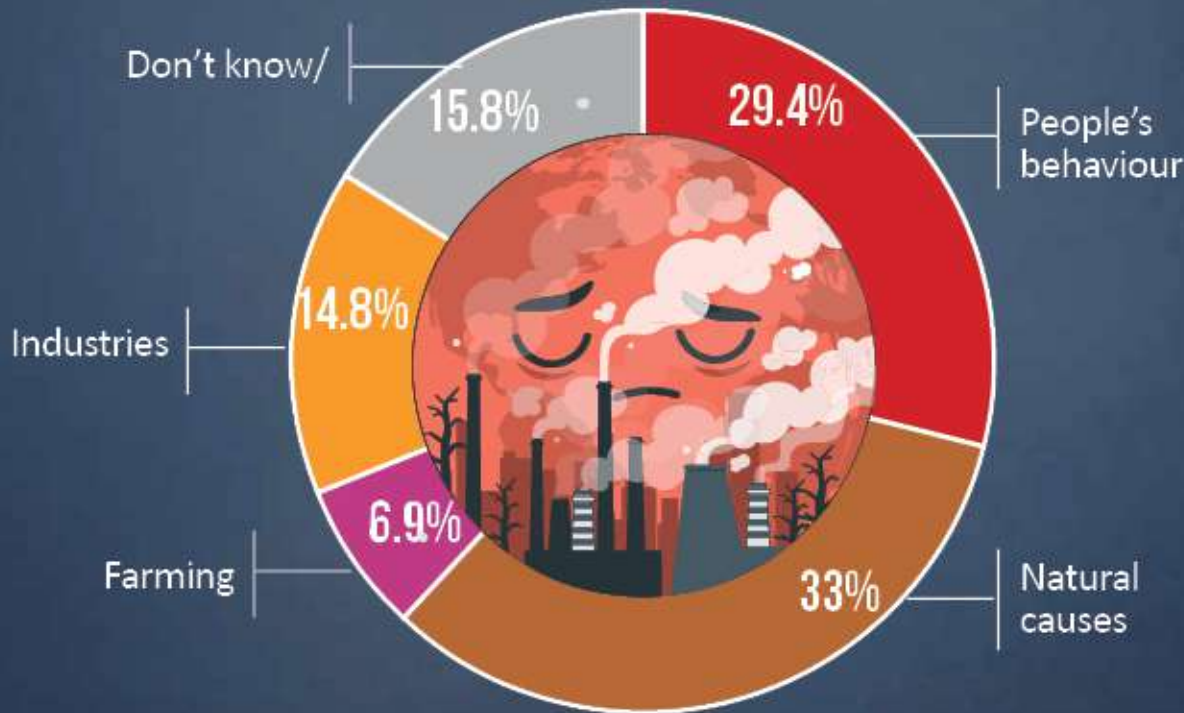

1 IN 3 PAKISTANIS (33%) CONSIDER NATURAL CAUSES TO BE THE MAJOR DRIVER FOR GLOBAL WARMING, ONLY 15% BLAME INDUSTRIES, AND 30% BLAME HUMAN ACTIVITY, RESULTS SIGNIFICANTLY VARY FROM GLOBAL AVERAGES: GALLUP PAKISTAN & WIN WORLD SURVEY 2024

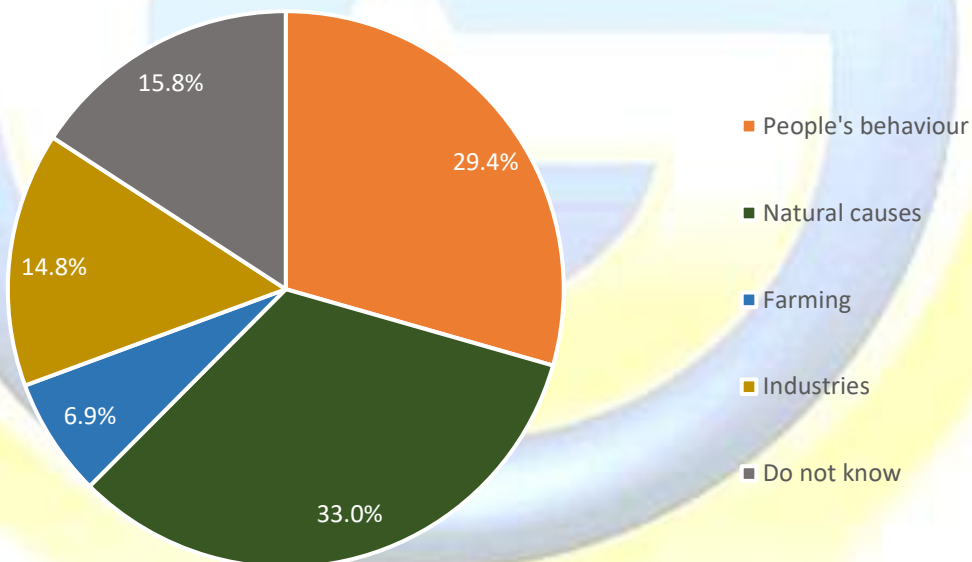

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 3 Pakistanis (33%) consider natural causes to be the major driver for global warming, only 15% blame industries, and 30% blame human activity, results significantly vary from global averages.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “What do you think is global warming caused by most?” In response, 29.4% said “People’s behaviour”, 33% said “Natural causes”, 6.9% said “Farming”, 14.8% said “Industries”, and 15.8% said that they did not know.

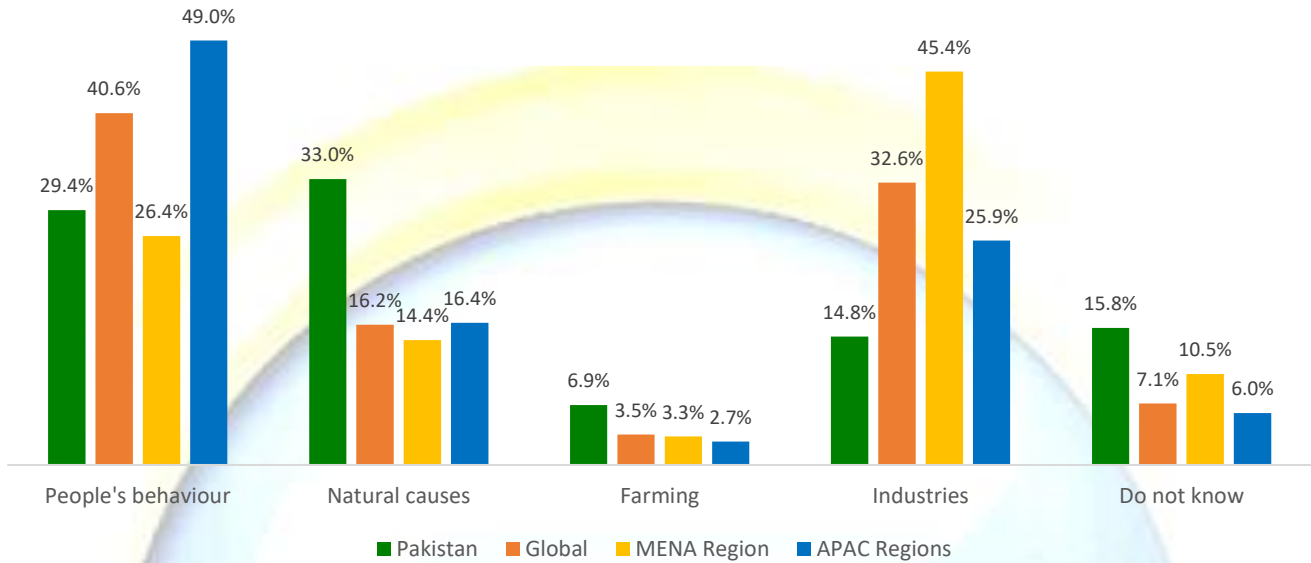
Question: What do you think is global warming caused by most?

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 3rd – 17th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Global comparison: Over twice as many Pakistanis (33%) compared to the Global (16.2%) and regional averages for MENA (14.4%) and APAC (16.4%) consider “Natural causes” to be the leading cause for global warming.
