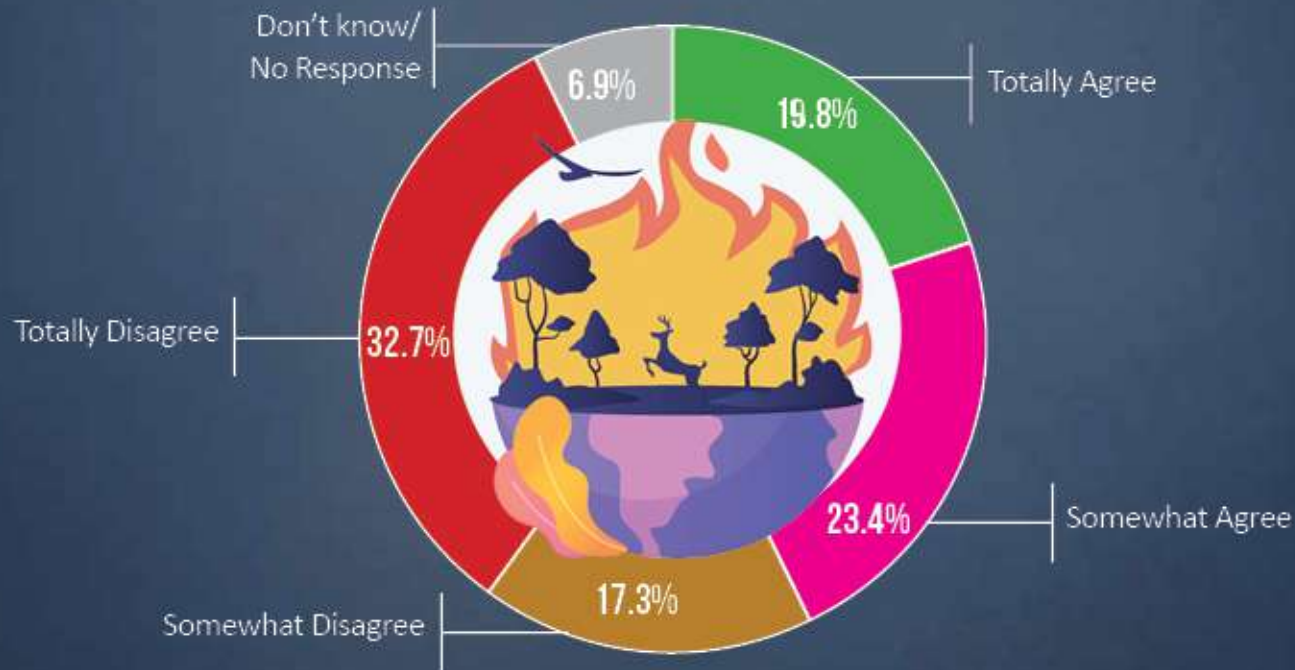

1 IN 2 PAKISTANIS (50%) SOMEWHAT OR COMPLETELY DISAGREE THAT THE GOVERNMENT IS TAKING THE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO TAKE CARE OF THE ENVIRONMENT, SIMILAR TO THE GLOBAL AVERAGE (49.8%): GALLUP PAKISTAN & WIN WORLD SURVEY 2024

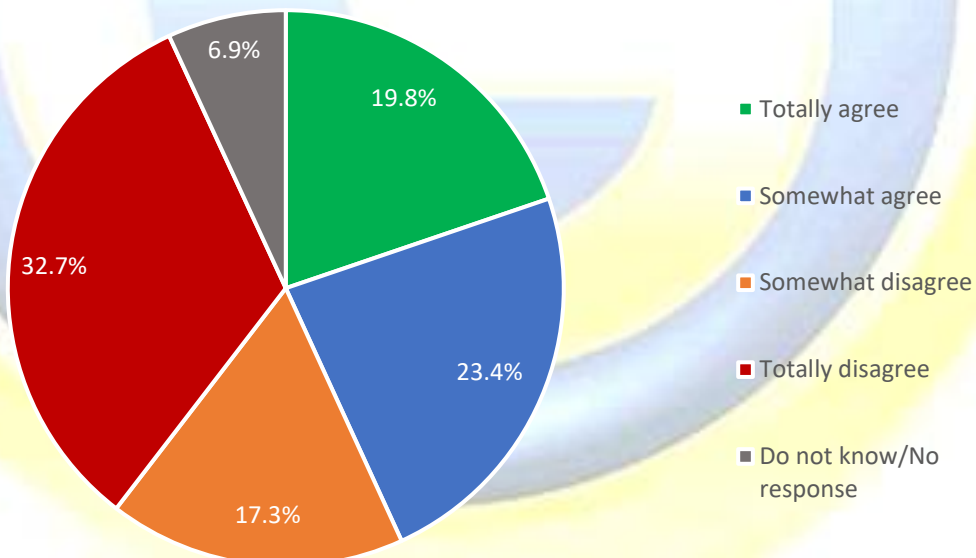
1 in 2 Pakistanis (50%) somewhat or completely disagree that the government is taking the necessary actions to take care of the environment, similar to the global average (49.8%): Gallup Pakistan & WIN World Survey 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 2 Pakistanis (50%) somewhat or completely disagree that the government is taking the necessary actions to take care of the environment, similar to the global average (49.8%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “To what extent do you agree or disagree with the statement ‘Governments are taking the necessary actions to take care of the environment’?” In response, 19.8% said “Totally agree”, 23.4% said “Somewhat agree”, 17.3% said “Somewhat disagree”, 32.7% said “Totally disagree”, and 6.9% said that they did not know.

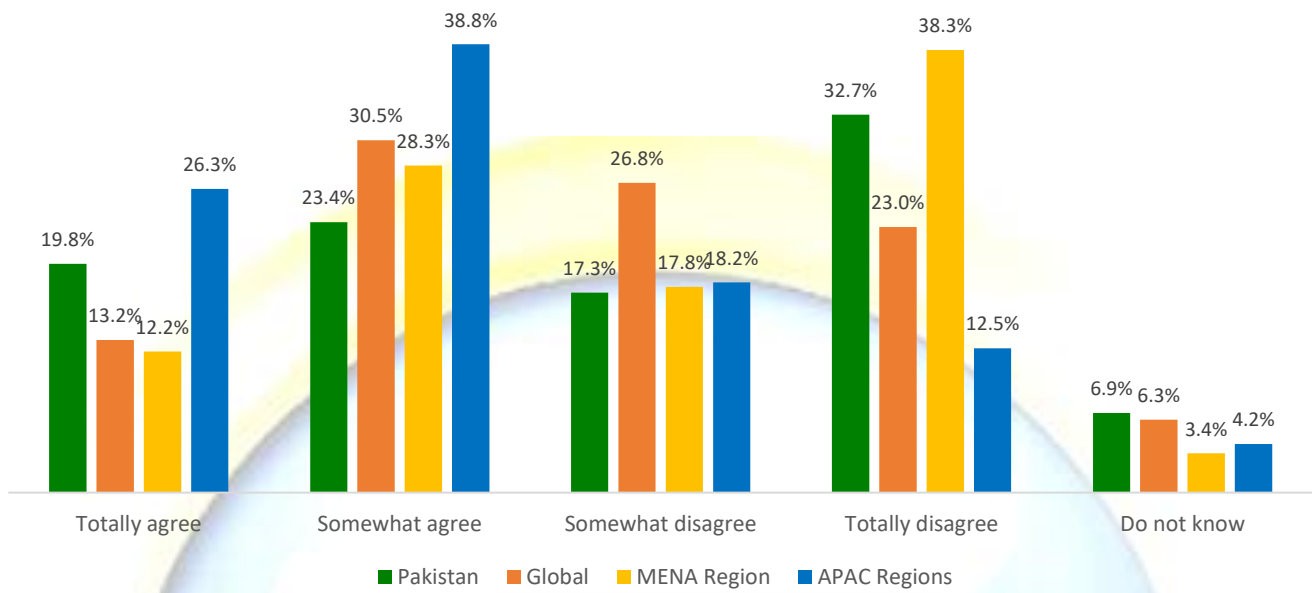
Question: To what extent do you agree or disagree with the statement “Governments are taking the necessary actions to take care of the environment”?

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 3rd – 17th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Global comparison: A similar proportion of Pakistanis (50%) completely or somewhat disagree that governments are taking the necessary actions to take care of the environment, as the global average (49.8%).
