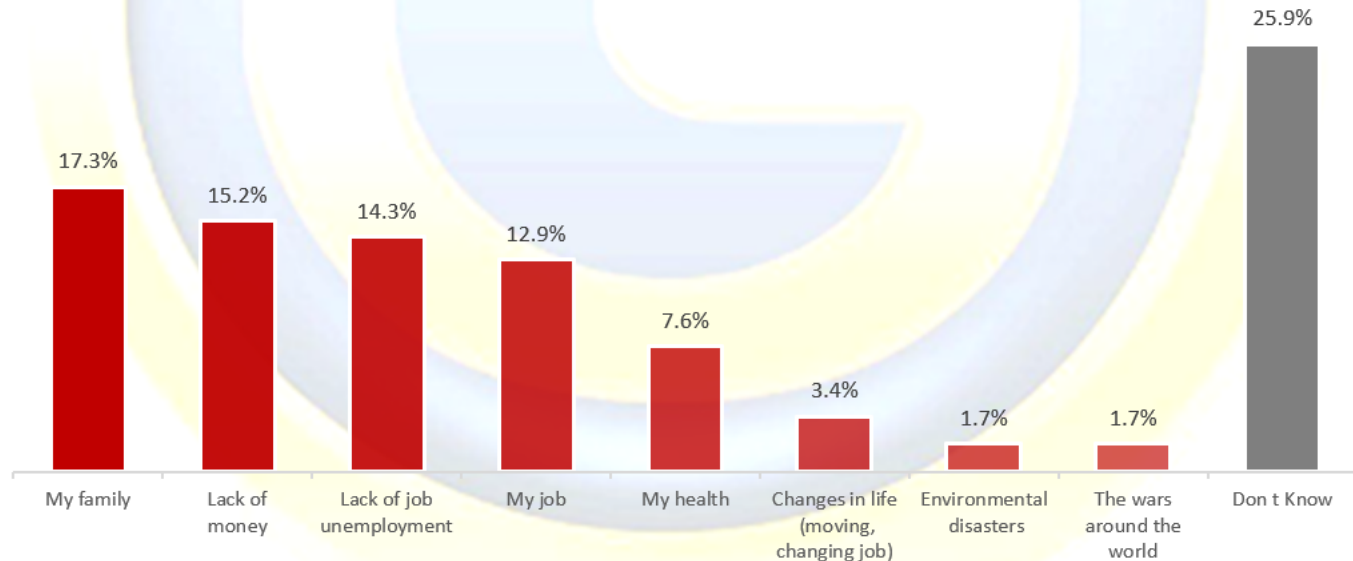


Question: Thinking about the last time you were really stressed, what was it that made you stressed?

Pakistanis report their families to be the leading cause for stress (17.3%), while lack of money was the second most common reason (15.2%): Gallup Pakistan & WIN World Survey 2024

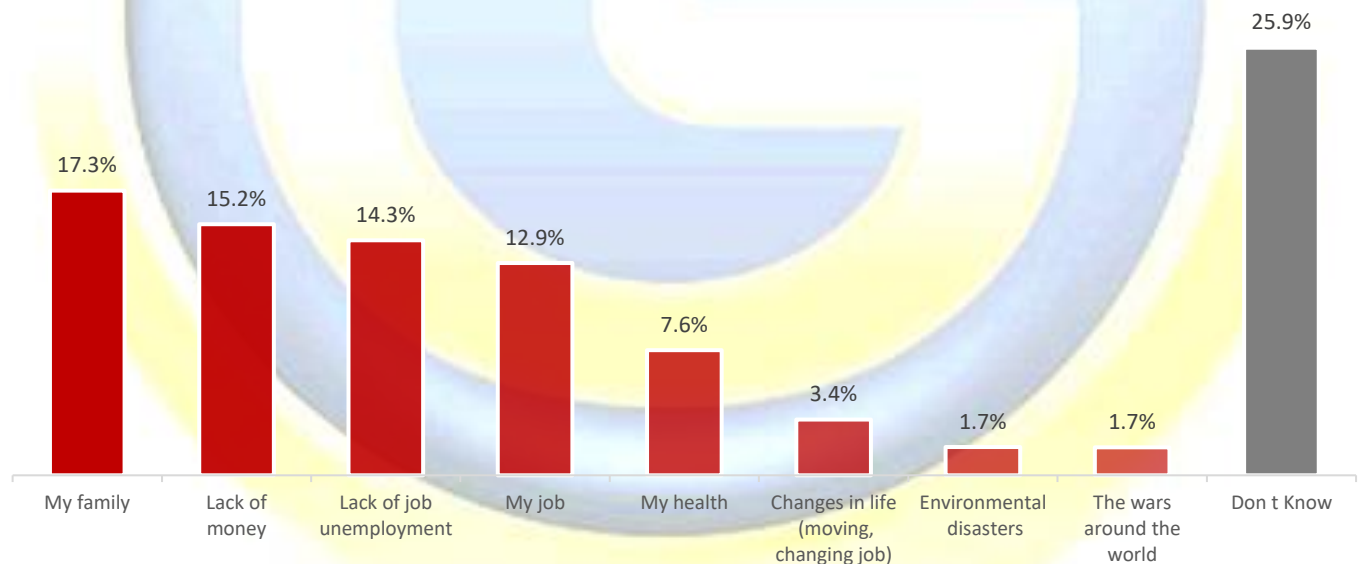

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, Pakistanis report their families to be the leading cause for stress (17.3%), while lack of money was the second most common reason (15.2%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Thinking about the last time you were really stressed, what was it that made you stressed?” In response, 17.3% said “My family”, 15.2% said “Lack of money”, 14.3% said “Lack of job unemployment”, 12.9% “My job”, 7.6% said “My health”, 3.4% “Changes in life (moving, changing job etc.)”, 1.7% “Environmental disasters”, 1.7% said “The wars around the world”, and 25.9% said that they did not know.

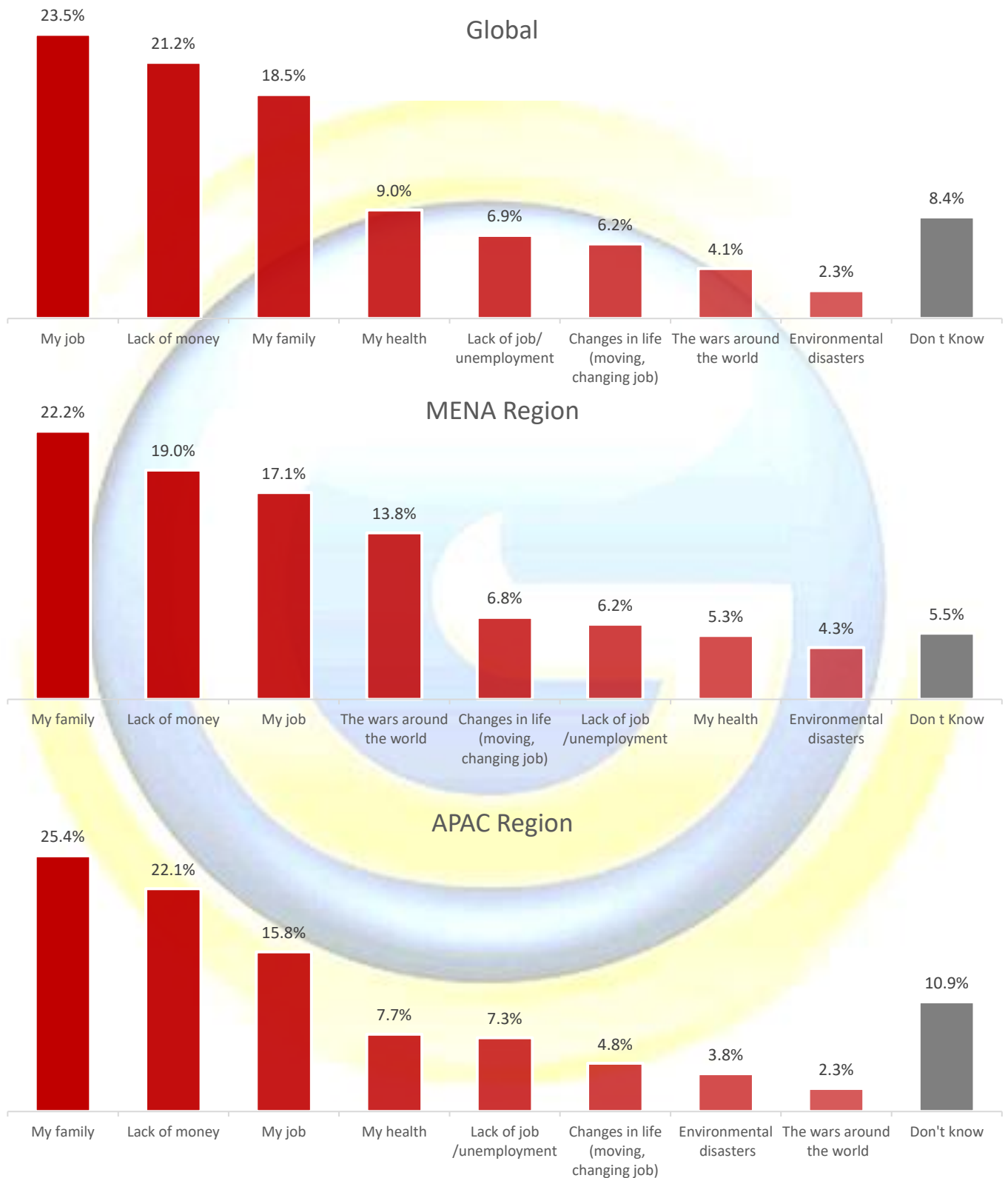

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 3rd – 17th January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Global comparison: People's jobs, lack of money, and their families, come out as the top three causes for stress among individuals across the globe, as well the MENA and APAC regions.
