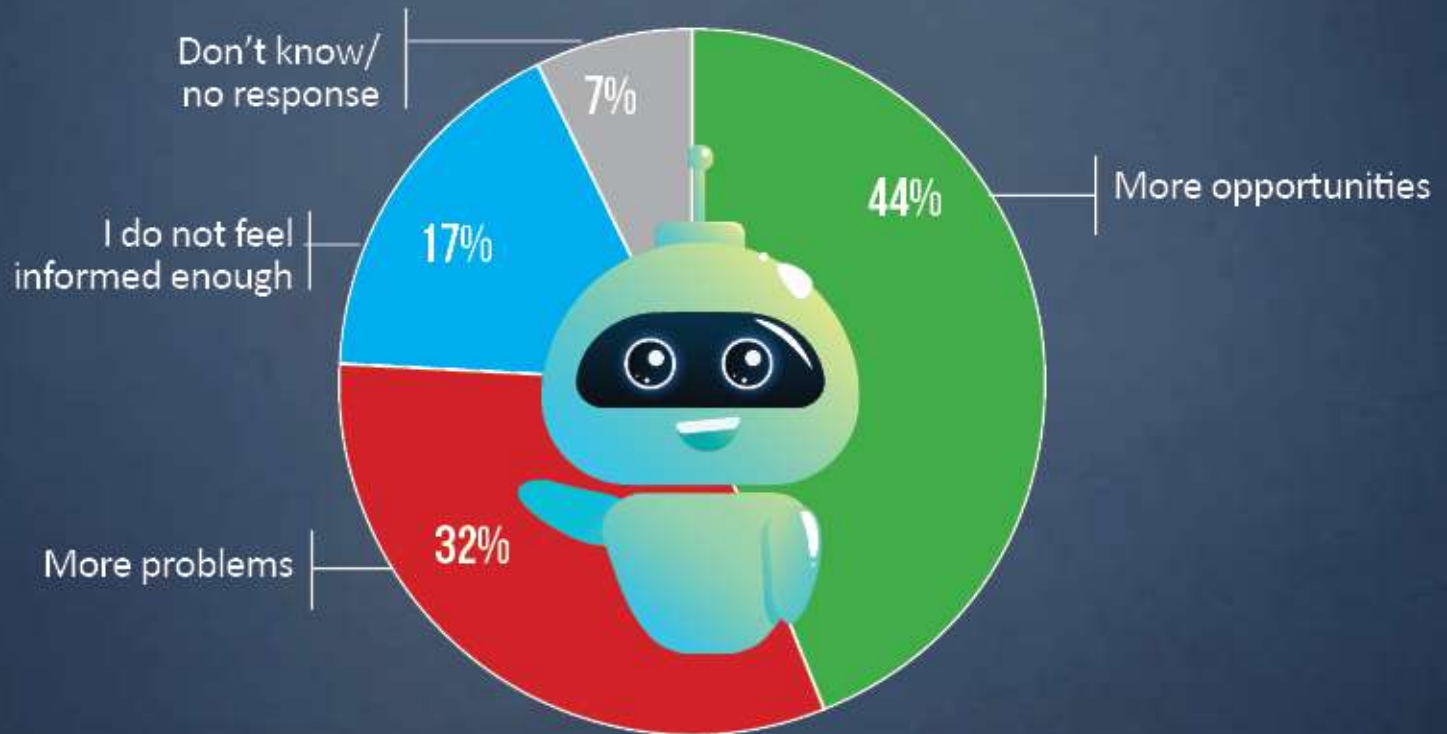

A greater proportion of Pakistanis believe that AI will bring more opportunities (44%) to the world, than it would more problems (34%): Gallup Pakistan and GIA

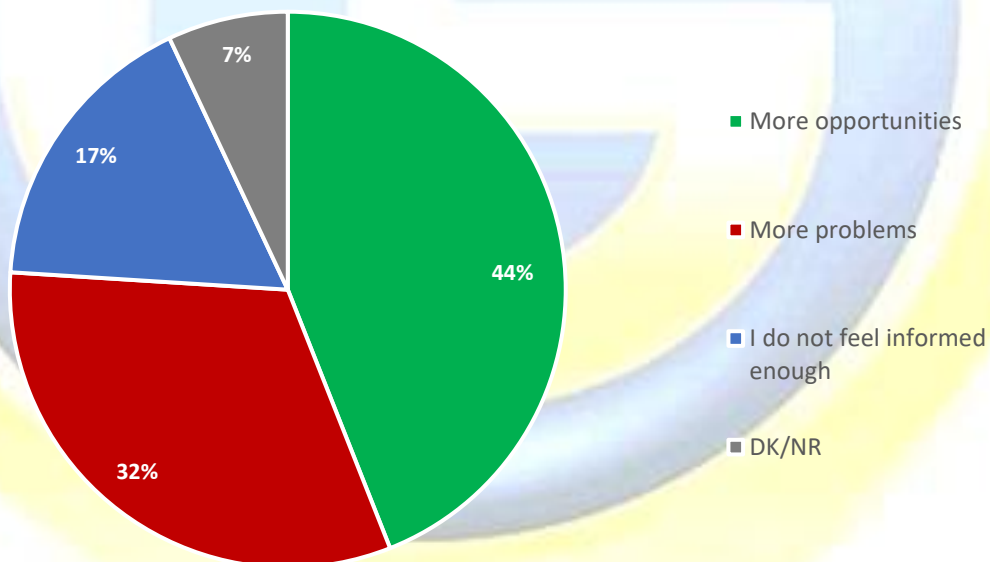

According to a survey conducted by Gallup Pakistan and Gallup International Association (GIA), a greater proportion of Pakistanis believe that AI will bring more opportunities (44%) to the world, than it would more problems (34%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Do you expect artificial intelligence to bring more opportunities or more problems to the world?” In response, 44% said “More opportunities”, 32% said “More problems”, 17% said “I do not feel informed enough”, and 7% said that they did not know or did not respond.

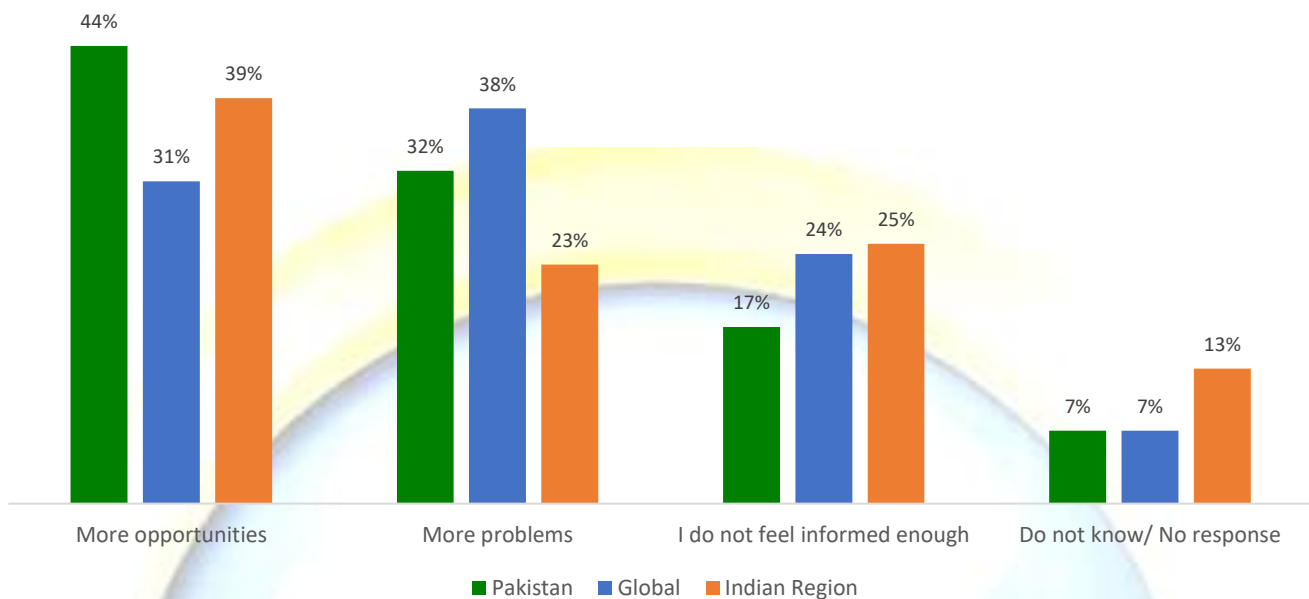

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 4th – 16th October 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
