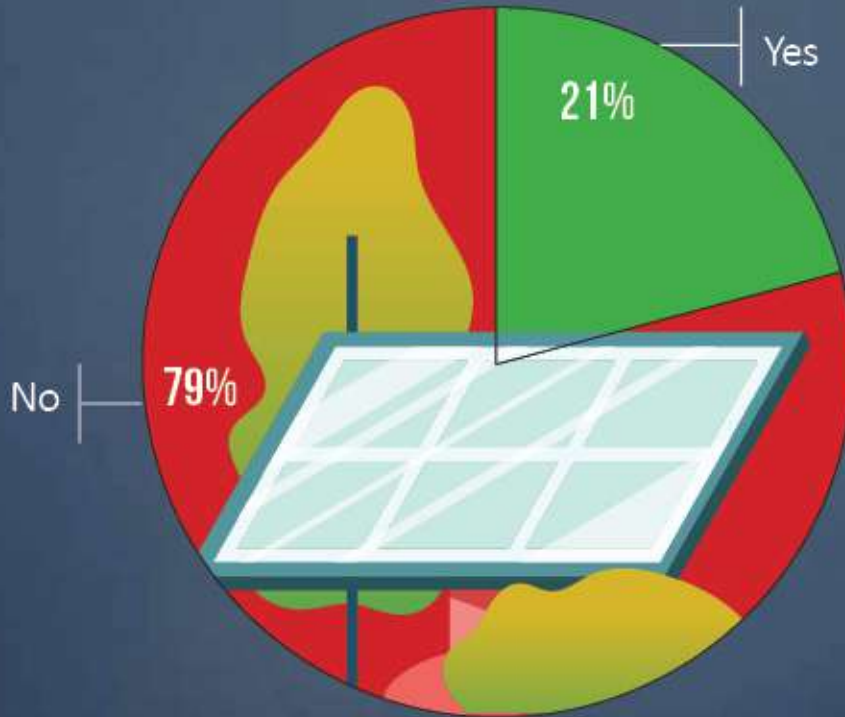

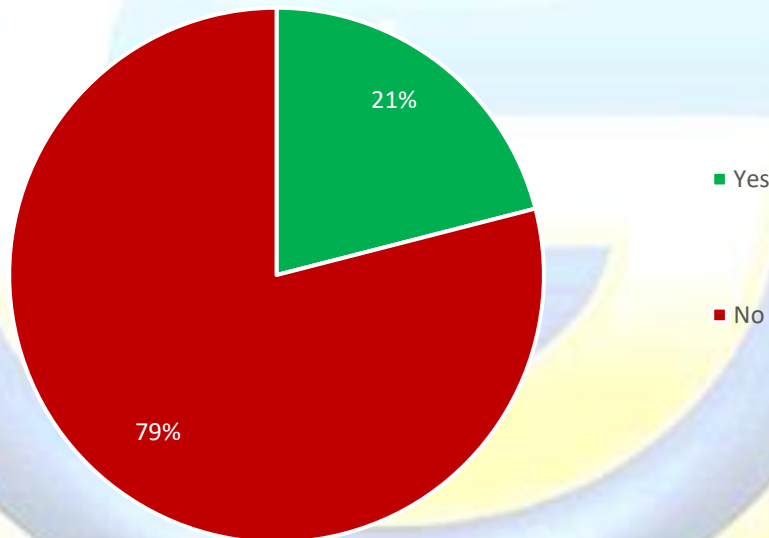
1 in 5 Pakistanis (21%) in 2024 report having solar panels in their homes in: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 31st July, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 5 Pakistanis (21%) in 2024 report having solar panels in their homes.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell if your house has solar panels, even if there is only one plate?” In response, 21% said ‘Yes’, and 79% said ‘No’.

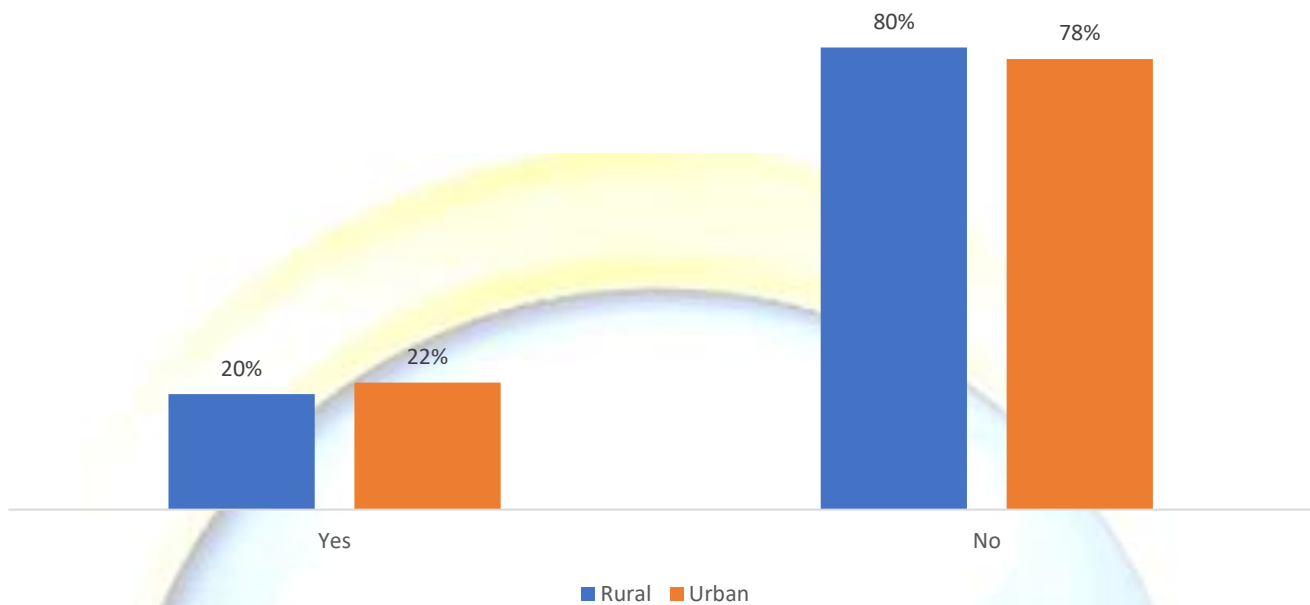
Question: Please tell if your house has solar panels, even if there is only one plate?

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 769 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 28th June - 10th July 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across rurality: Households in urban areas (22%) in Pakistan were only slightly more likely to have solar panels compared to rural areas (20%) in Pakistan.
