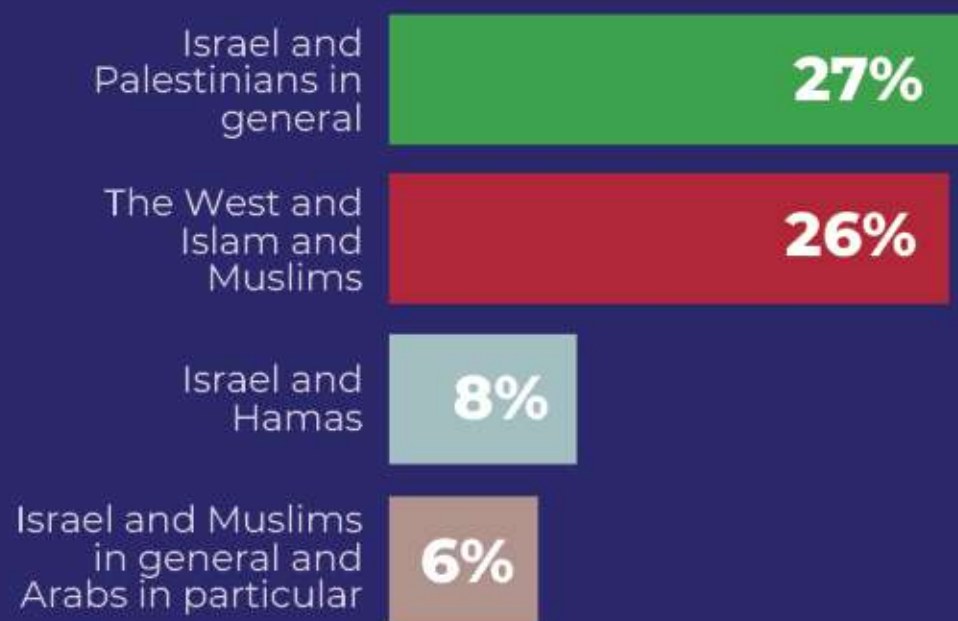


## 27% of Pakistanis view the Gaza conflict as primarily between Israel and the Palestinians in general

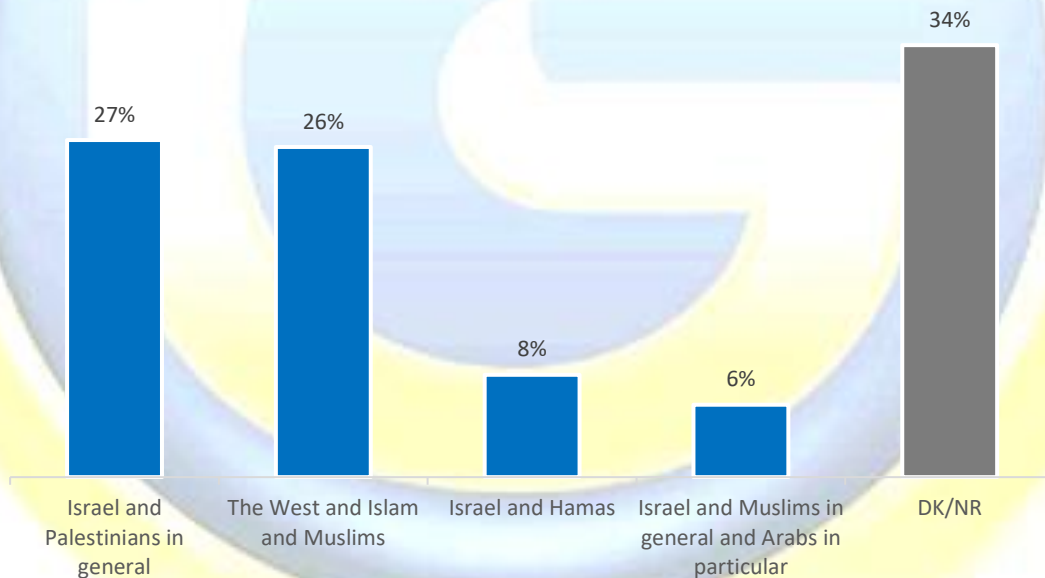
## **27% of Pakistanis view the Gaza conflict as primarily between Israel and the Palestinians in general, a perspective shared by a similar proportion (28%) in other Muslim-majority countries: Gallup Pakistan & WAPOR WANA Survey 2024**

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 27% of Pakistanis view the Gaza conflict as primarily between Israel and the Palestinian people, a perspective that is shared by a similar proportion (28%) in other Muslim-majority countries.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Do you believe that the current conflict in Gaza is primarily between...?” In response, 27% said ‘Israel and Palestinians in general’, 26% said ‘The West and Islam and Muslims’, 8% said ‘Israel and Hamas’, 6% said ‘Israel and Muslims in general and Arabs in particular’, and 34% said they did not know or gave no response.

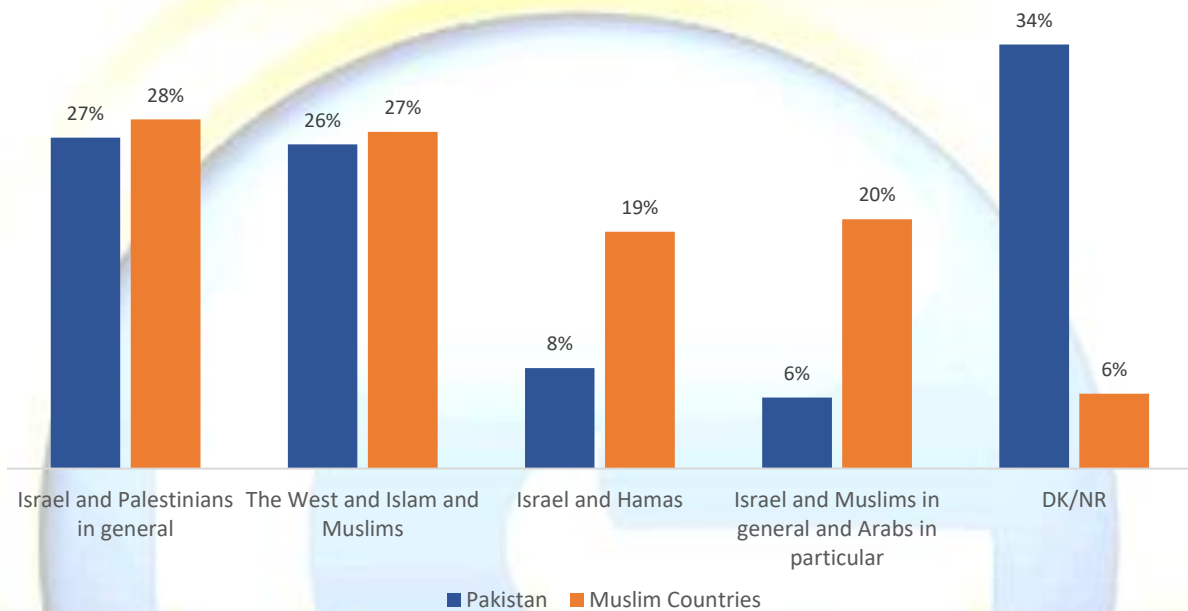
**Question: Do you believe that the current conflict in Gaza is primarily between...?**

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 12<sup>th</sup> September – 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

**Comparison with other Muslim countries:** The top two options chosen by respondents both in Pakistan and in other Muslim countries when prompted about the identity of the primary actors in Gaza's conflict were 'Israel and Palestinians in general' and 'the West and Islam and Muslims'. There was an insignificant difference of 1% between the proportion of Pakistanis and Muslims from other countries who chose these options. Meanwhile, only 8% of Pakistanis viewed Israel and Hamas as the primary actors in the Gaza conflict, compared to 19% who thought the same in other Muslim countries. Further, only 6% of Pakistanis considered 'Israel and Muslims in general and Arabs in particular' to be the main groups involved, significantly lower than the 20% average among other Muslim nations. Pakistan also had a very high 'Don't Know/No Response' percentage of 34%.
