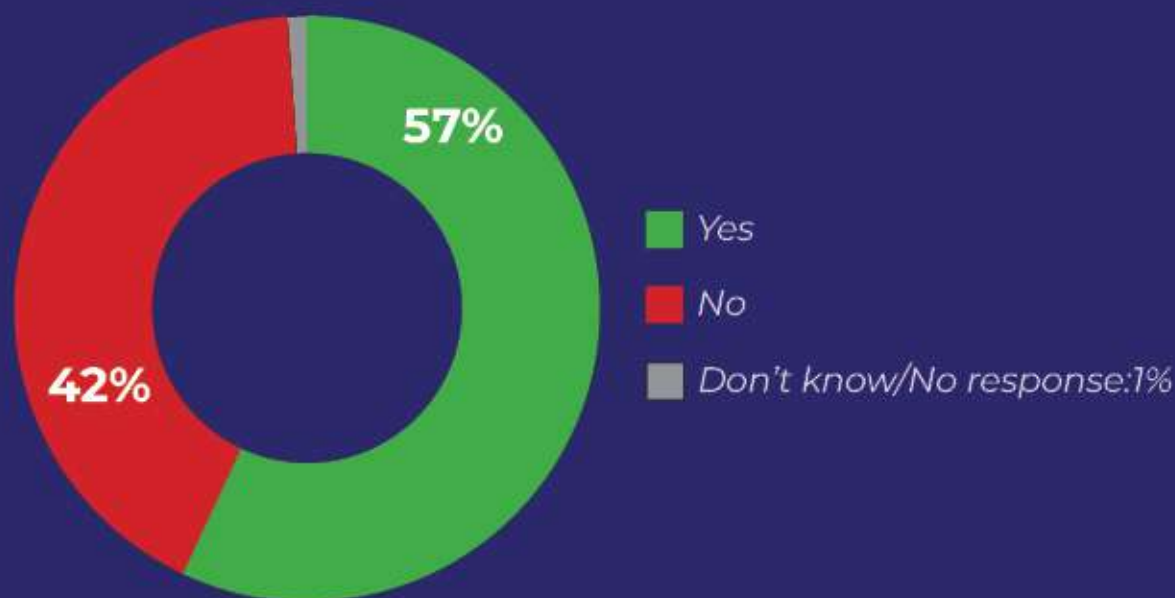

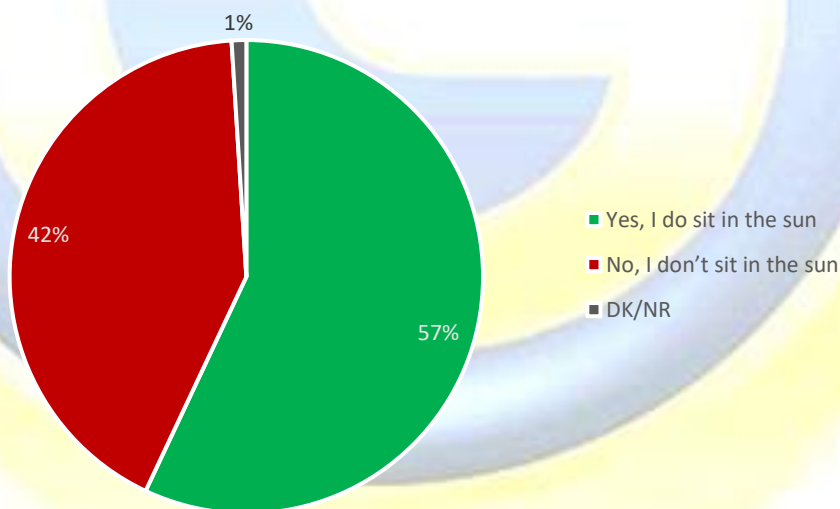
Health risk: 42% Pakistanis feel they have limited sun exposure and spend limited time outdoors, women significantly more likely to say they have limited outdoor and sun exposure: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 42% Pakistanis feel they have limited sun exposure and spend limited time outdoors. Survey findings show that women have 16% less sun exposure than men.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “In today's age where problems like Vitamin D deficiency are increasing day by day, and most people spend most of their time in their rooms or indoors where there is no sunlight at all. In this situation, there are some people who take time out of their busy schedules to sit in the sun in order to complete their vitamin D deficiency. Please tell me if you sit in the sun.” In response, 57% said ‘Yes’, 42% said ‘No’, 1% responded they don’t know or gave no response.

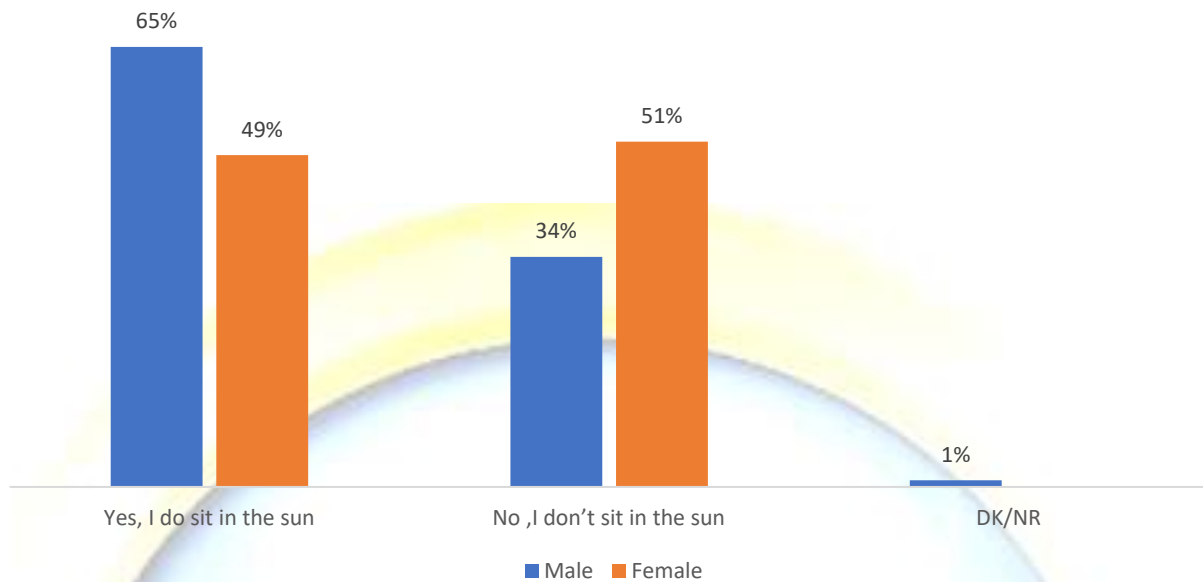

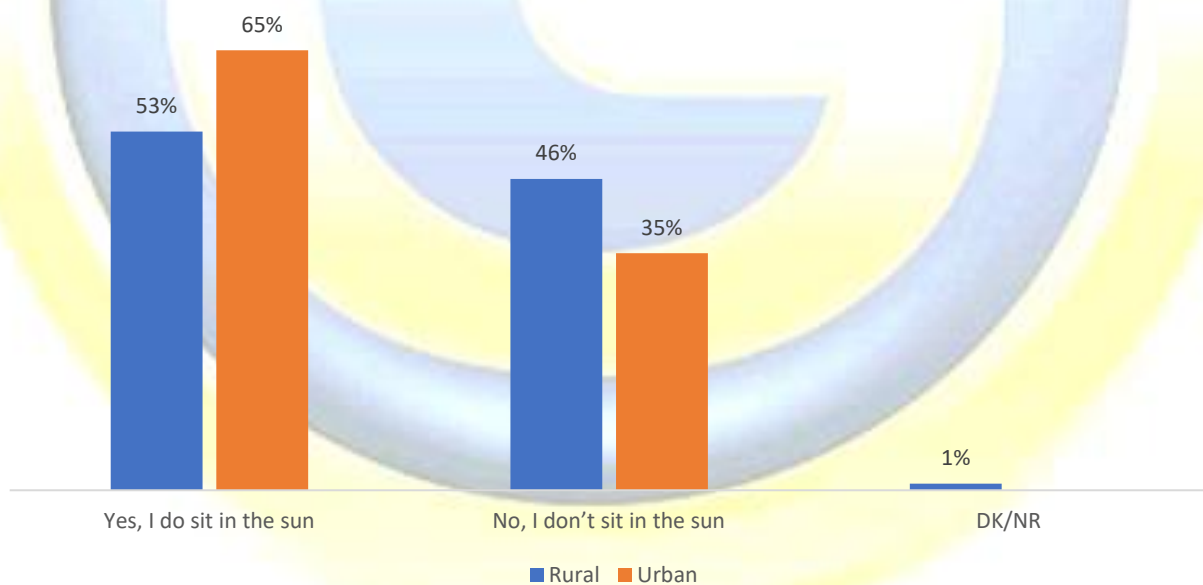
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1089 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 12th September- 11th October 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across gender: Men were more likely than women to get sun exposure, with 65% of men reporting they sit in the sun compared to 49% of women.

Across rurality: Urban residents were more inclined 65% to have sun exposure compared to rural residents 53%.
