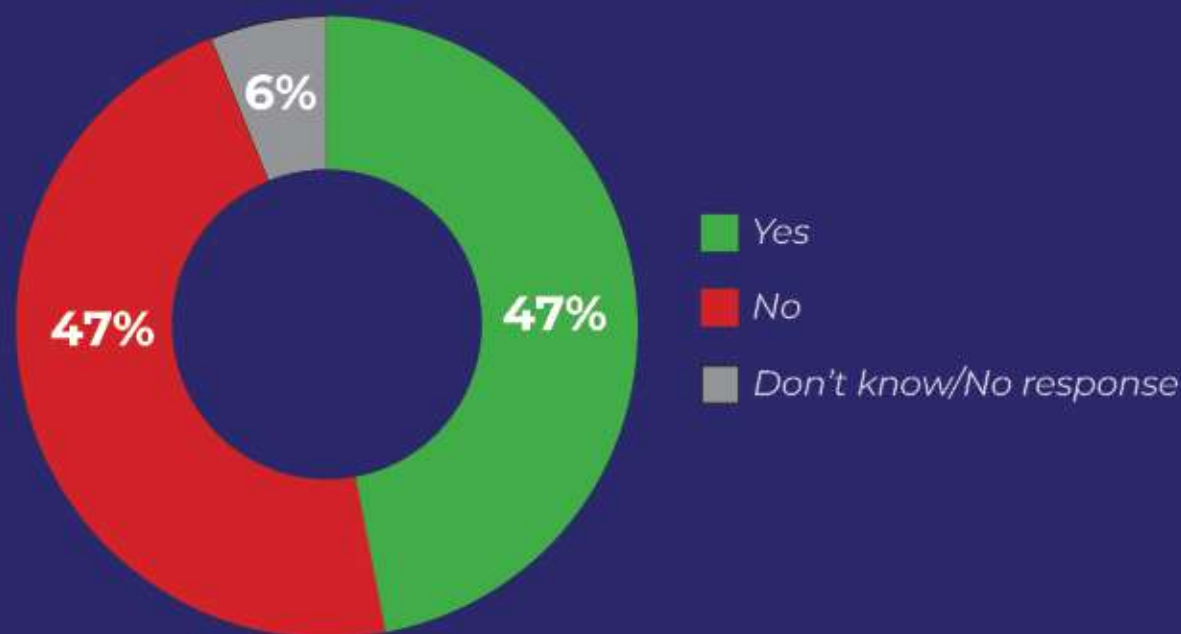


Nearly 1 in 2 (47%) Pakistanis have travelled by train

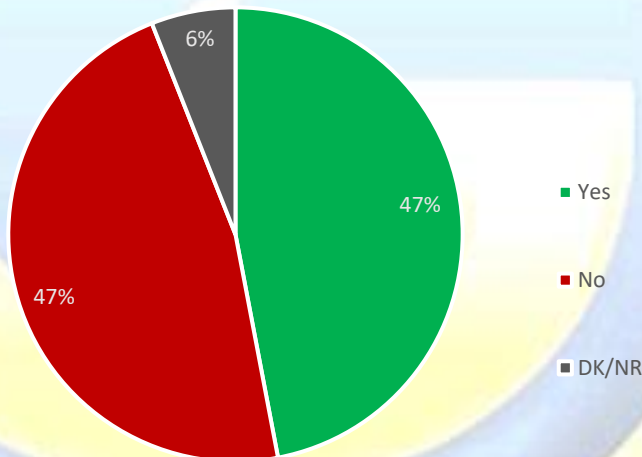
Nearly 1 in 2 (47%) Pakistanis have travelled by train, with men and urban residents more likely to do so: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 22nd November, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 1 in 2 Pakistanis have travelled by train. Survey findings reveal that 11% more men and 12% more urban residents have travelled by train compared to women and rural residents, respectively.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “For each of the following modes of transportation, please state whether or not you have ever had the chance to use them? - Train” In response, 47% said ‘Yes’, 47% said ‘No’, 6% responded they don’t know or gave no response.

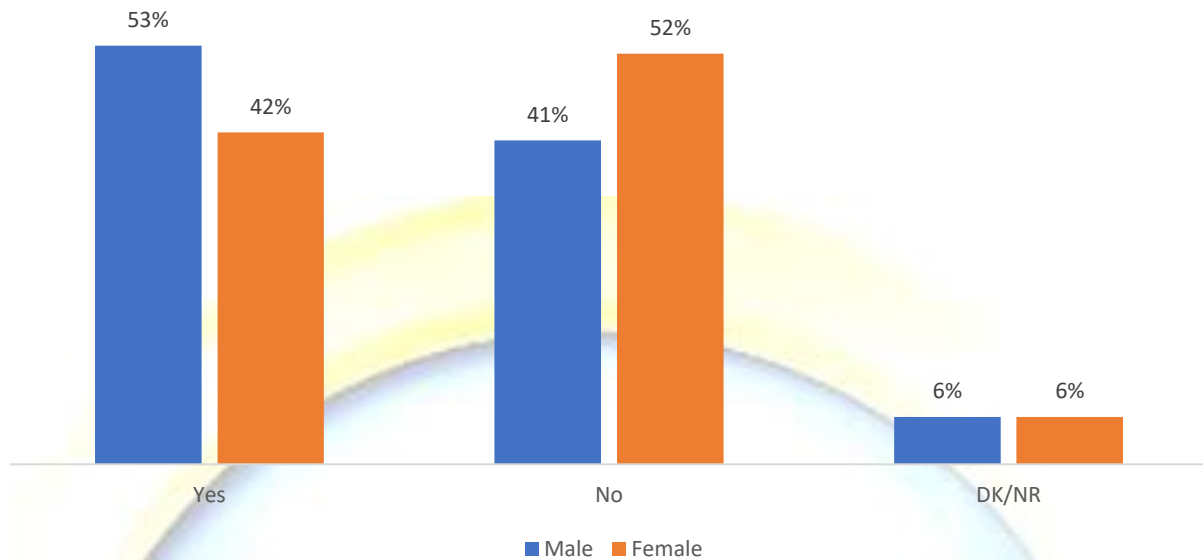
Question: For each of the following modes of transportation, please state whether or not you have ever had the chance to use them? - Train

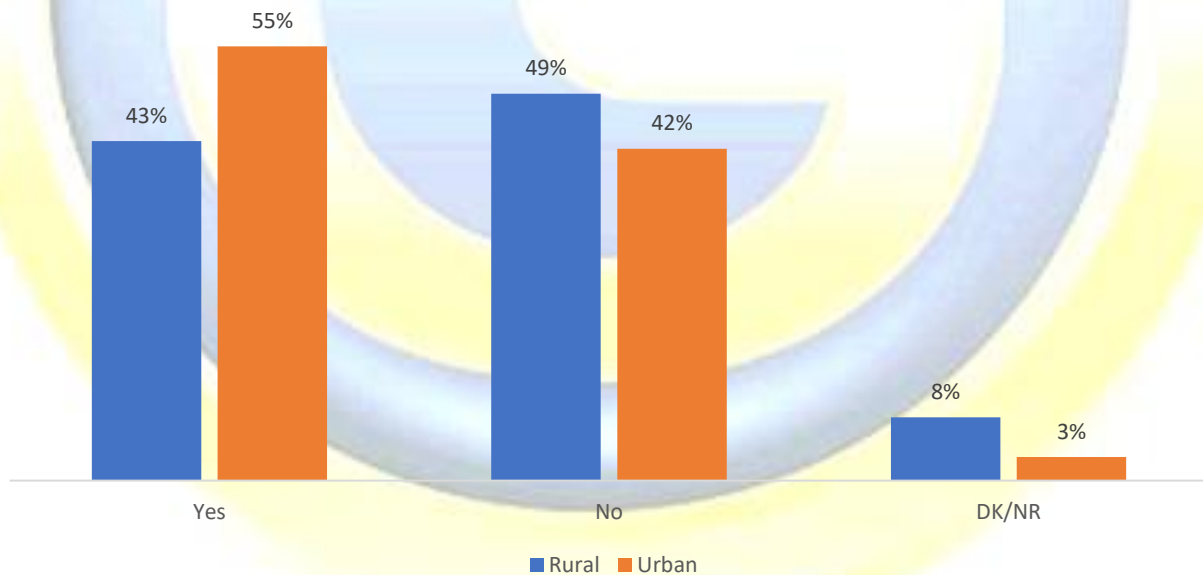
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1089 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 12th September – 11th October 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across gender: 53% men have commuted by trains, compared to only 42% of women.

Across rurality: 55% of urban residents reported using trains, while only 43% of rural residents had done so.
