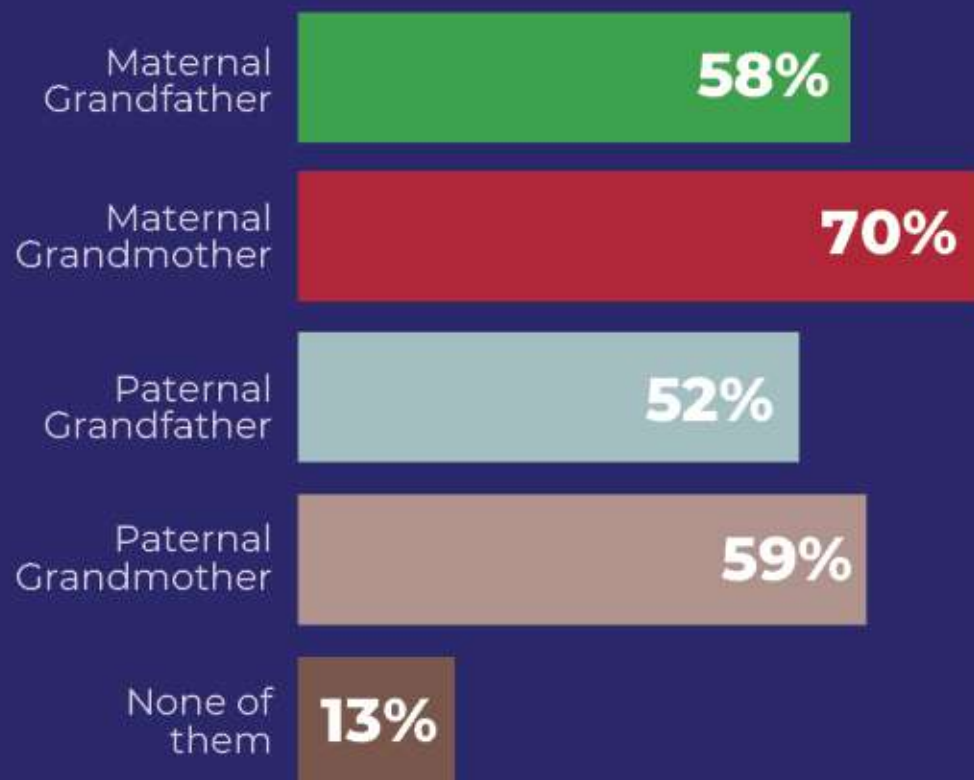


13% Pakistanis have not had the pleasure of being with their grandparents

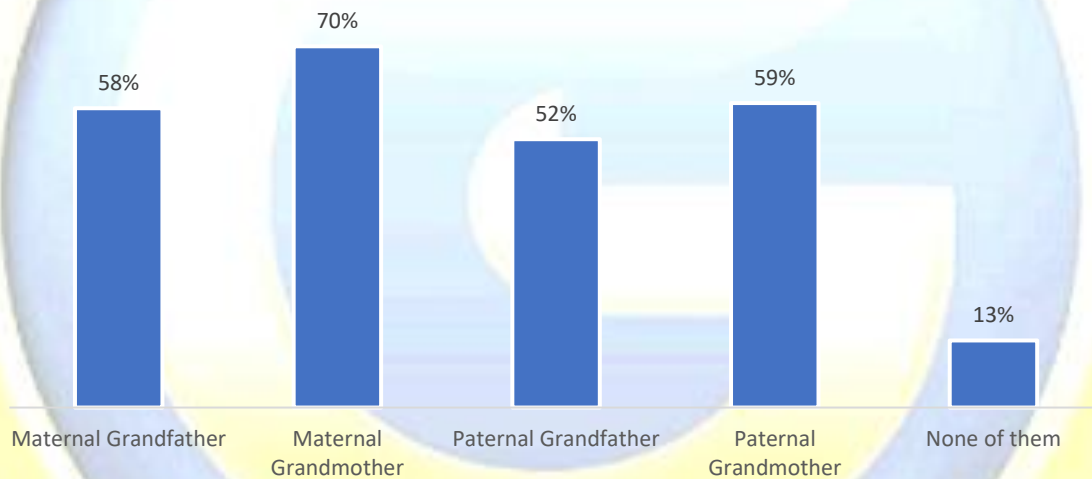
13% Pakistanis have not had the pleasure of being with their grandparents: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 5th November 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 13% Pakistanis have not had the pleasure of being with their grandparents.

A nationally representative sample of married adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell me which of your grandparents have you seen in your life?” In response, 58% said ‘Maternal Grandfather’, 70% said ‘Maternal Grandmother’, 52% responded ‘Paternal Grandfather’, 59% answered ‘Paternal Grandmother’, and 13% said ‘None of them’.

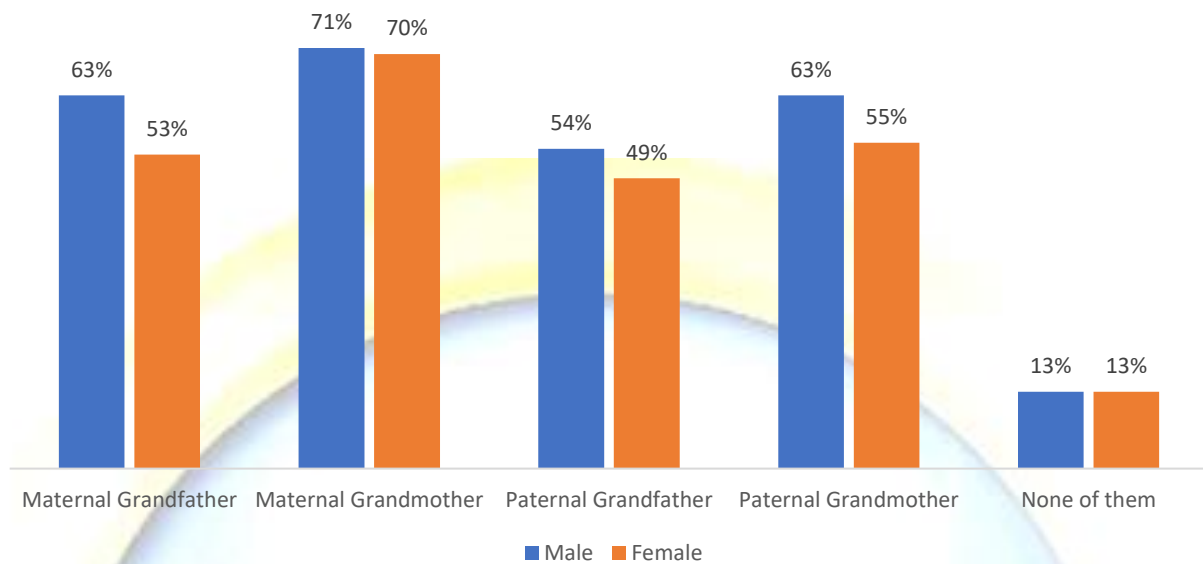
Question: Please tell me which of your grandparents have you seen in your life?

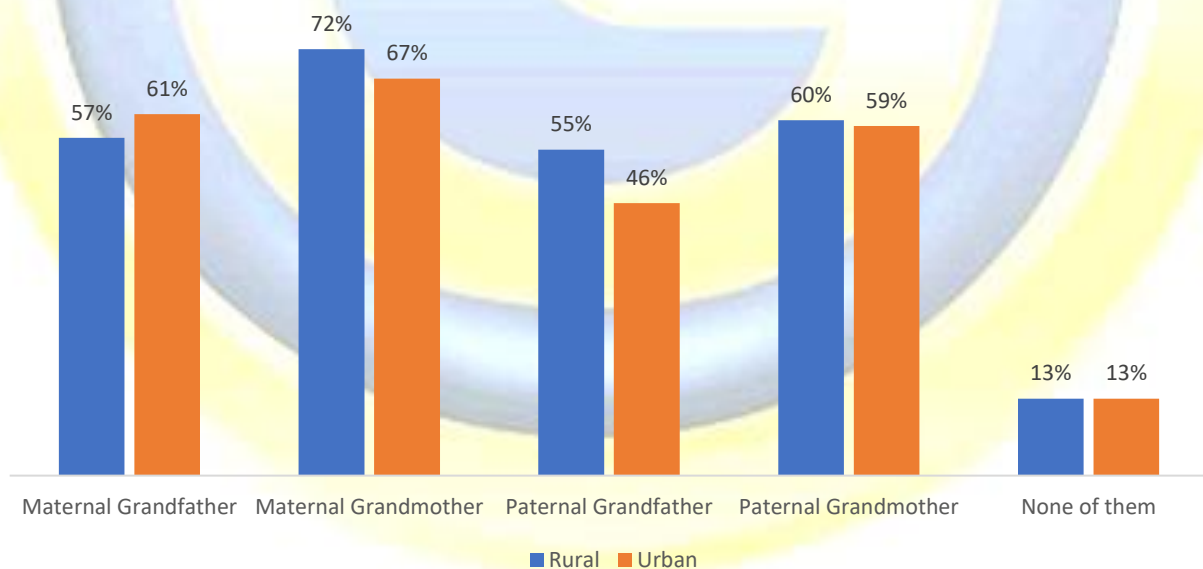
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1089 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 6th August - 9th September 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across gender: Both men and women demonstrated that they have not seen their grandparents in equal proportions, with 13% reporting this.
