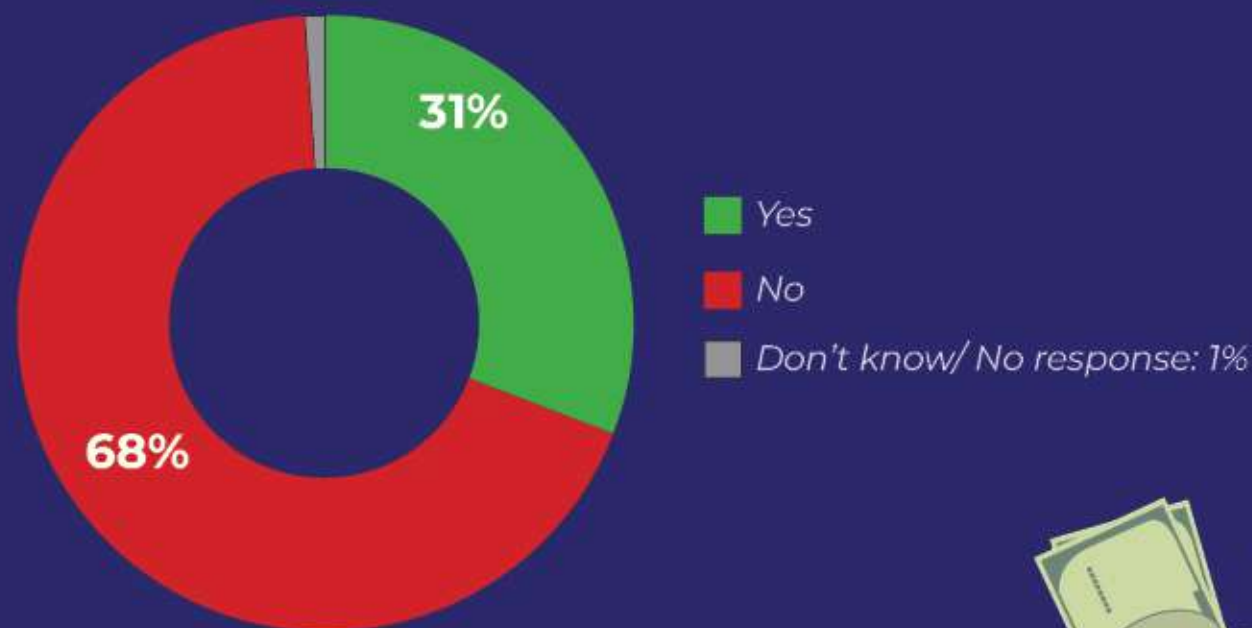


Nearly 1 in 3 Pakistanis report participating in a committee

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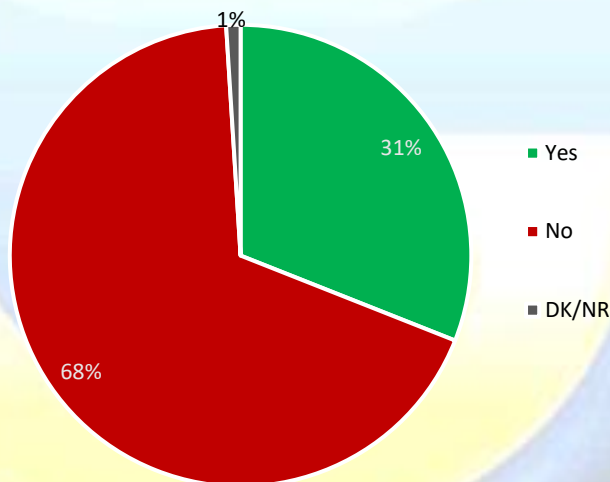
Nearly 1 in 3 Pakistanis report participating in a committee, urban residents showing higher involvement (36%): Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 1 in 3 Pakistanis report participating in a committee, urban residents showing higher involvement (36%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Have you ever partaken/given money in a committee?” In response, 31% said ‘Yes’, 68% said ‘No’, 1% responded they don’t know or gave no response.

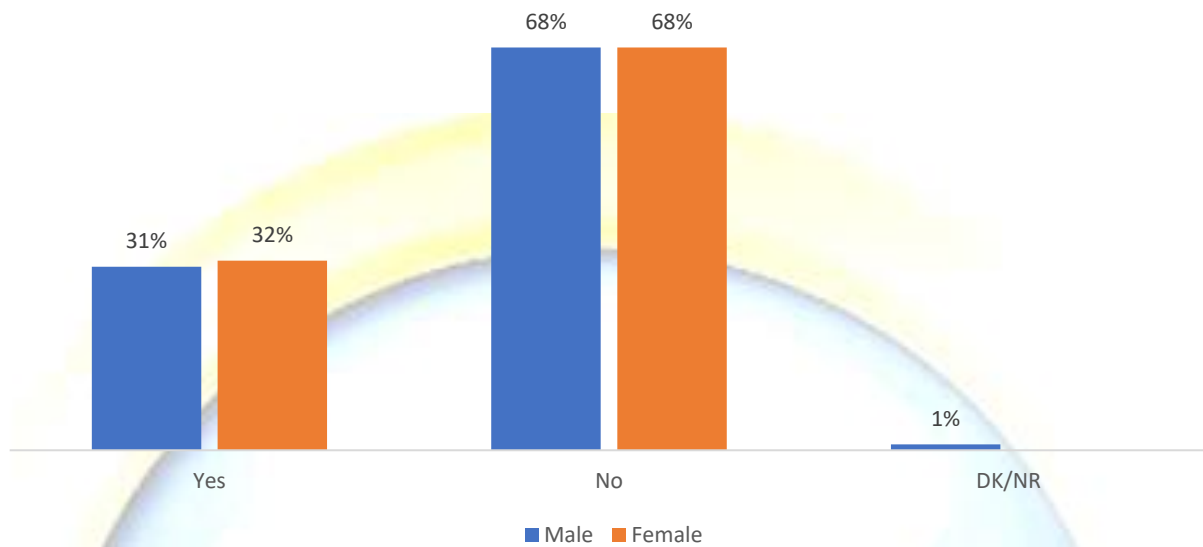
Question: Have you ever partaken/given money in a committee?

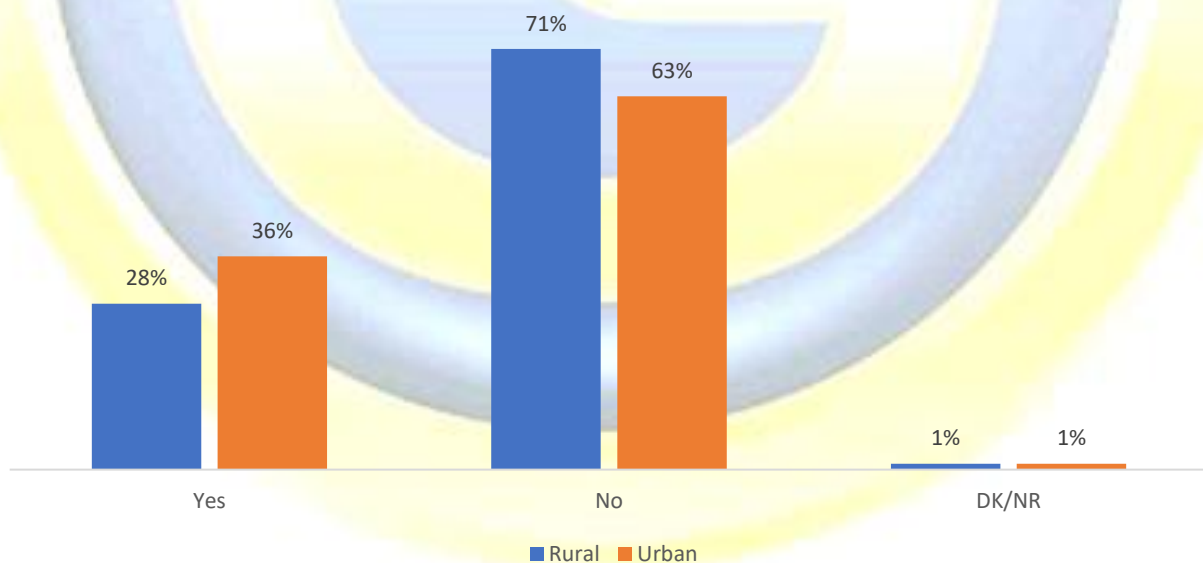
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1024 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 23rd October – 17th November 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across gender: Both men and women participate equally in committees, with nearly 1 in 3 involved.

Across rurality: Urban residents were more likely to report financial engagement with committees (36%) compared to their rural counterparts (28%).
