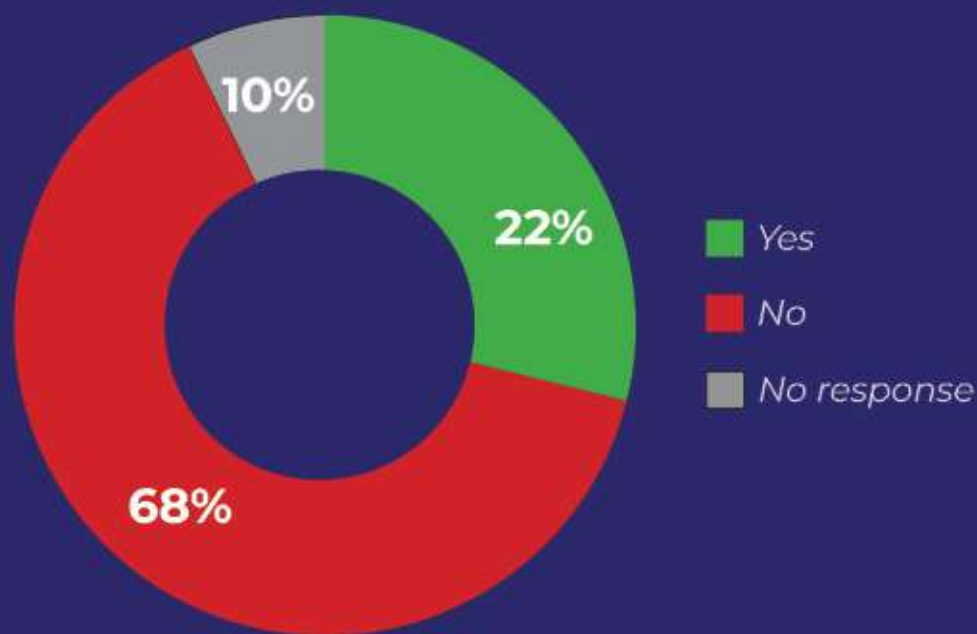


Health check: Illness keeps one in five Pakistanis bedridden for hours in recent month

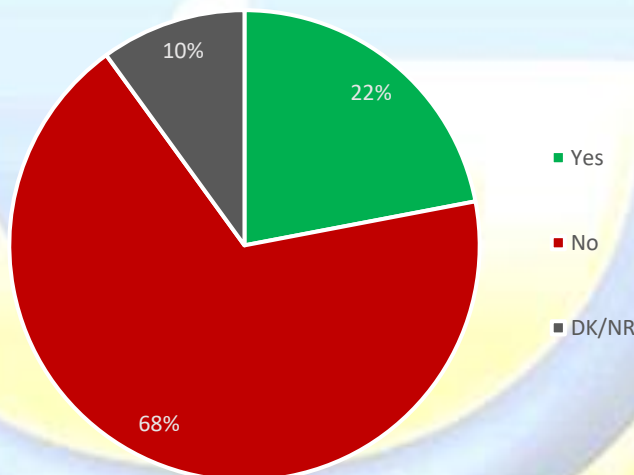
Health check: Illness keeps one in five Pakistanis bedridden for hours in recent month, women showing higher incidence: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 3rd December, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, illness keeps one in five Pakistanis bedridden in recent month. Survey findings indicate that women are 6% more likely than men to be affected by illness and become bedridden.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell me in retrospect if you ever gotten so sick that you had to stay in bed for hours? - In the previous one month” In response, 22% said ‘Yes’, 68% said ‘No’, 10% responded they don’t know or gave no response.

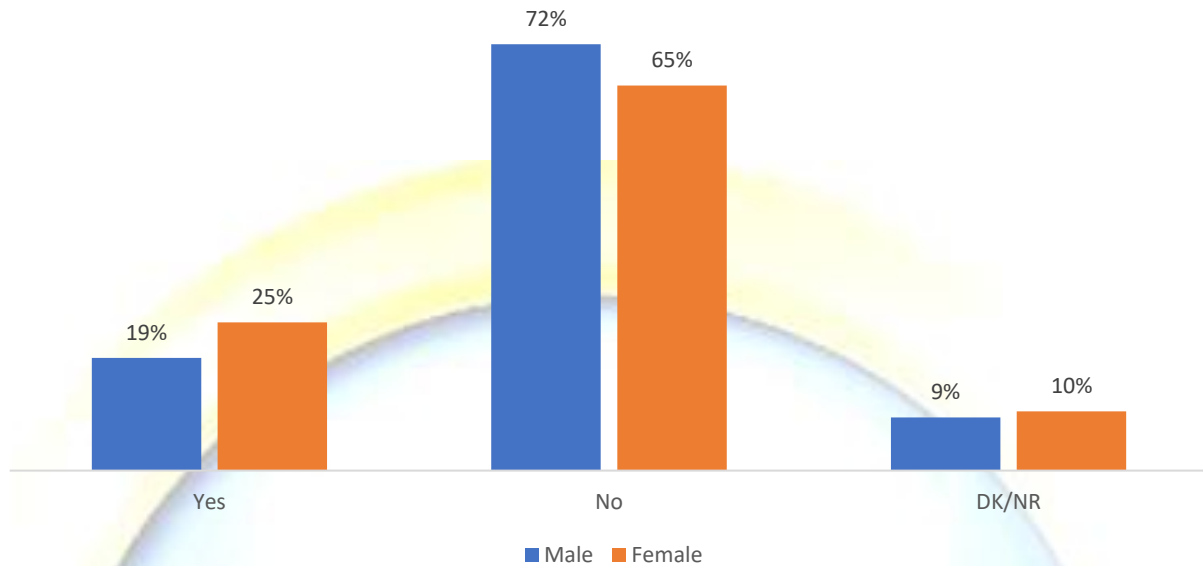
Question: Please tell me in retrospect if you ever gotten so sick that you had to stay in bed for hours? - In the previous one month

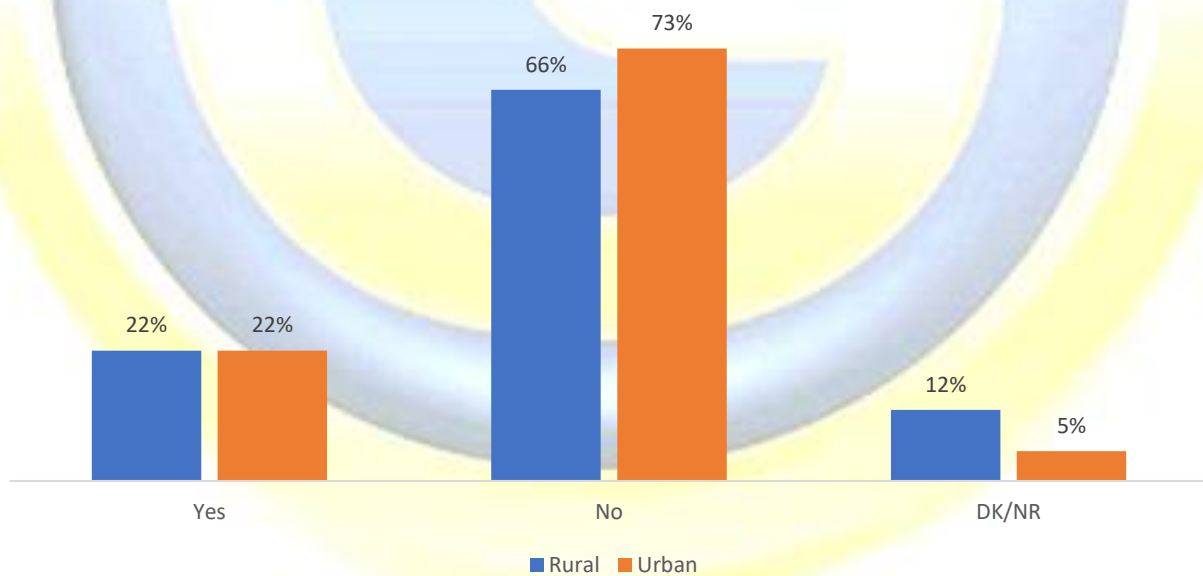
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1089 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 12th September – 11th October 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across gender: Slightly higher proportion of women (25%) compared to men (19%) reported being bedridden due to illness.

Across rurality: The same percentage (22%) of urban and rural residents have been bedridden due to illness in the past month.
