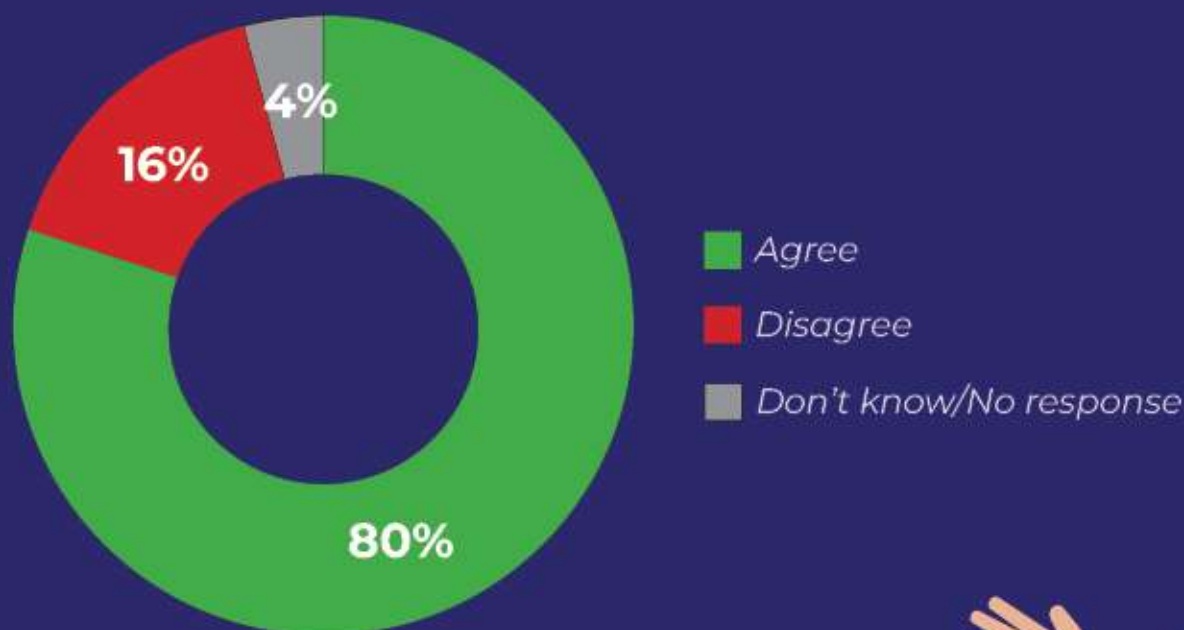


Good manners or too self-assured? 80% people agree Pakistanis are well-mannered,

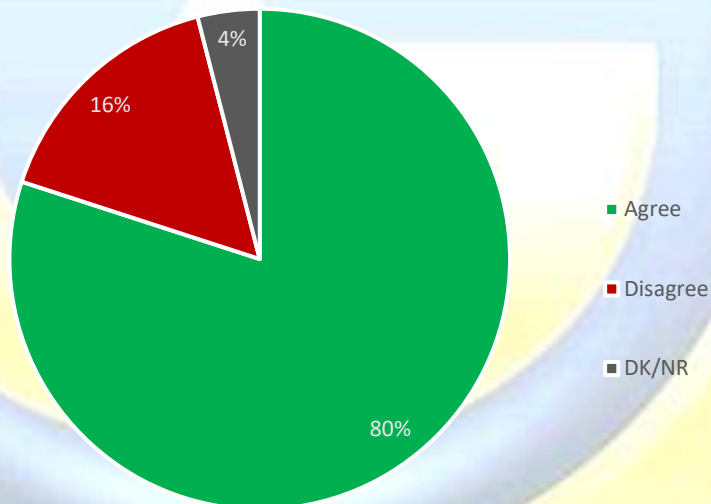
Good manners or too self-assured? 80% people agree Pakistanis are well-mannered, rural residents and those with FA and higher qualification strongly agree: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 6th December, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 80% people agree Pakistanis are well-mannered. Survey findings reveal that the proportion of rural residents agreeing that Pakistani people are well-mannered is 2% higher than urban residents, and the proportion of those with FA and higher qualifications agreeing is 3% higher than those with less than FA.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, "Please state whether you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Pakistani people are good mannered.?" In response, 80% agreed, 16% said disagreed, 4% responded they don't know or gave no response.

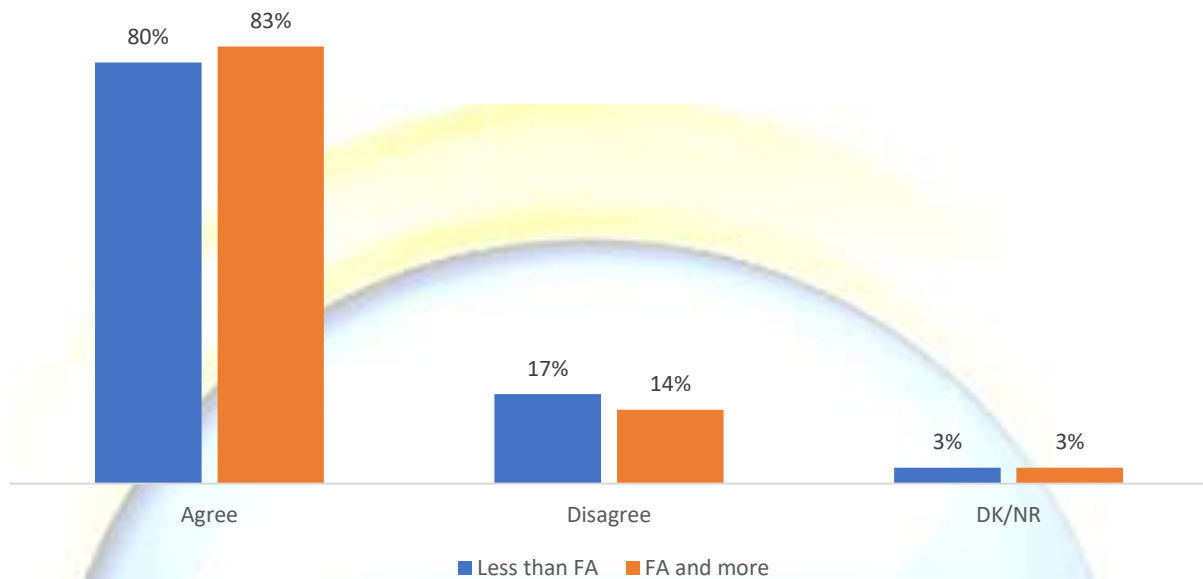
Question: Please state whether you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Pakistani people are good mannered.

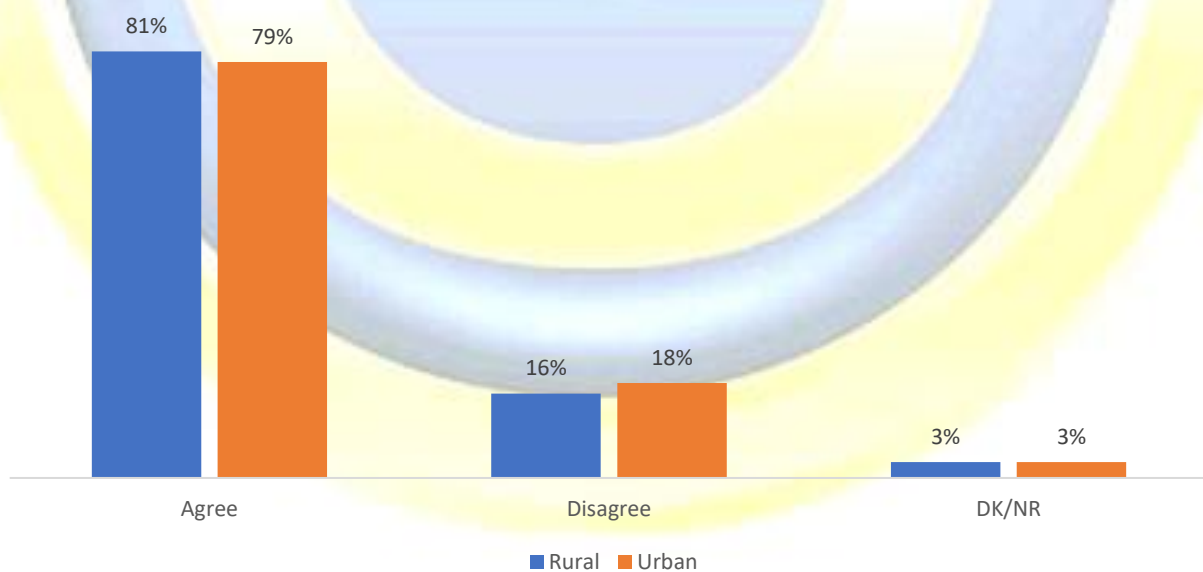
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1089 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 12th September – 11th October 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across Education: The percentage of those agreeing that Pakistanis are well-mannered is 3% higher among individuals with FA and higher qualification (83%) compared to those with less than FA (80%).

Across rurality: Rural residents (81%) were slightly more likely than urban residents (79%) to agree that Pakistanis are well-mannered
