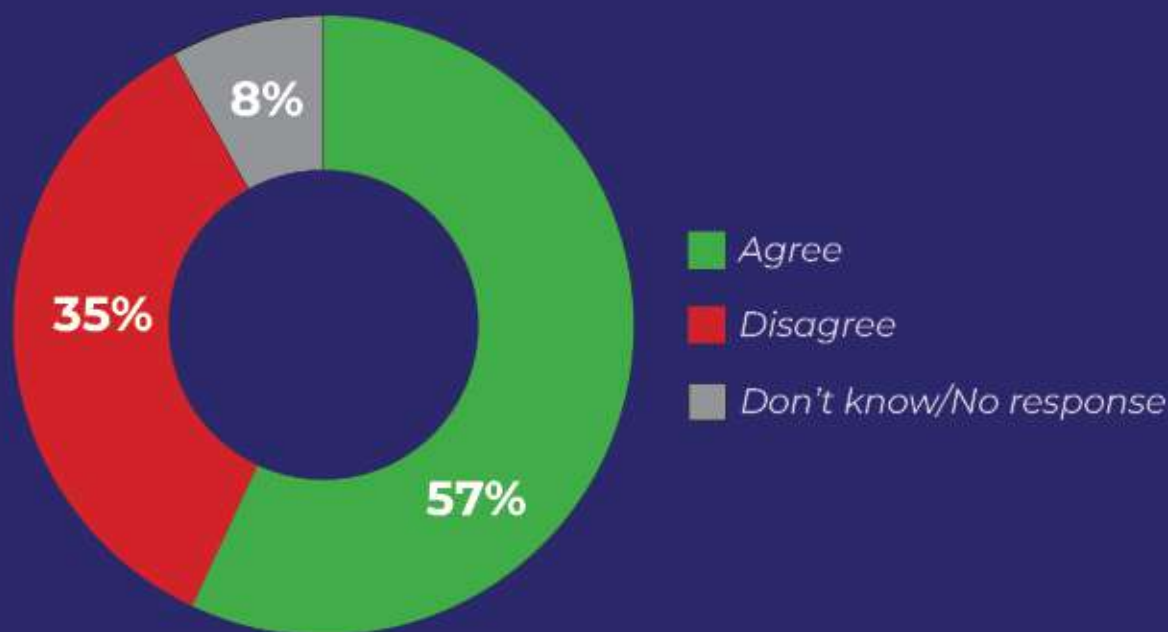


More than half of Pakistanis (57%) believe in the honesty of fellow Pakistanis,

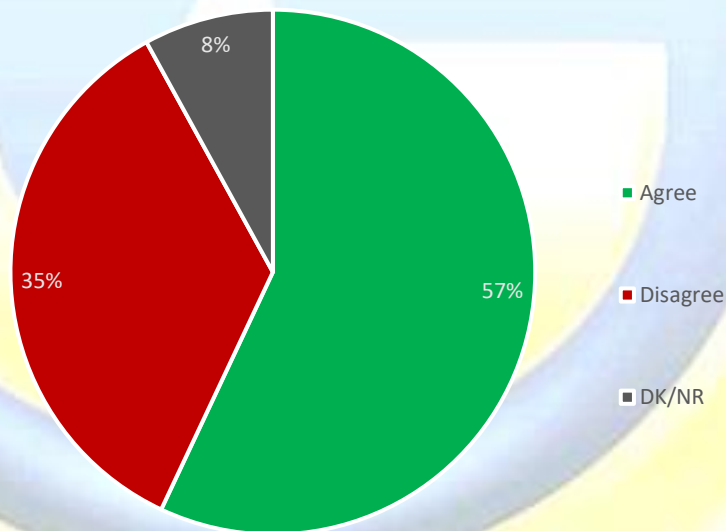
More than half of Pakistanis (57%) believe in the honesty of fellow Pakistanis, with stronger trust observed among those with less than an FA qualification and rural residents: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 9th December, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half of Pakistanis (57%) believe in the honesty of fellow Pakistanis. Survey findings reveal that 16% more individuals with less than FA qualifications believe Pakistani people are honest compared to those with FA or higher qualifications, while 6% more rural residents trust the honesty of citizens than their urban counterparts.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, "Please state whether you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Pakistani people are honest." In response, 57% agreed, 35% disagreed, and 8% responded they don't know or gave no response.

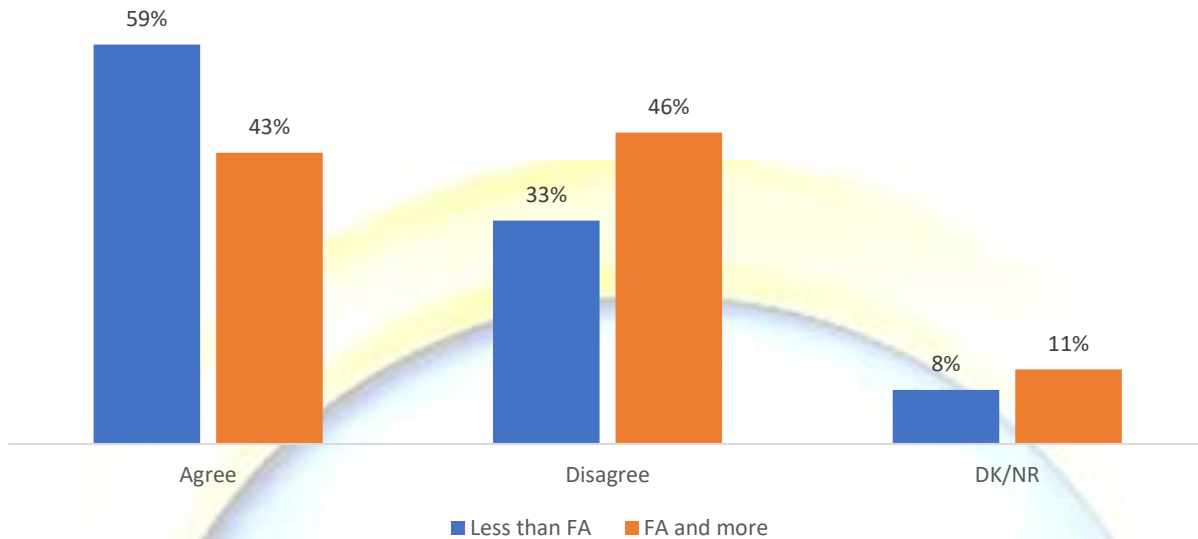
Question: Please state whether you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Pakistani people are honest.

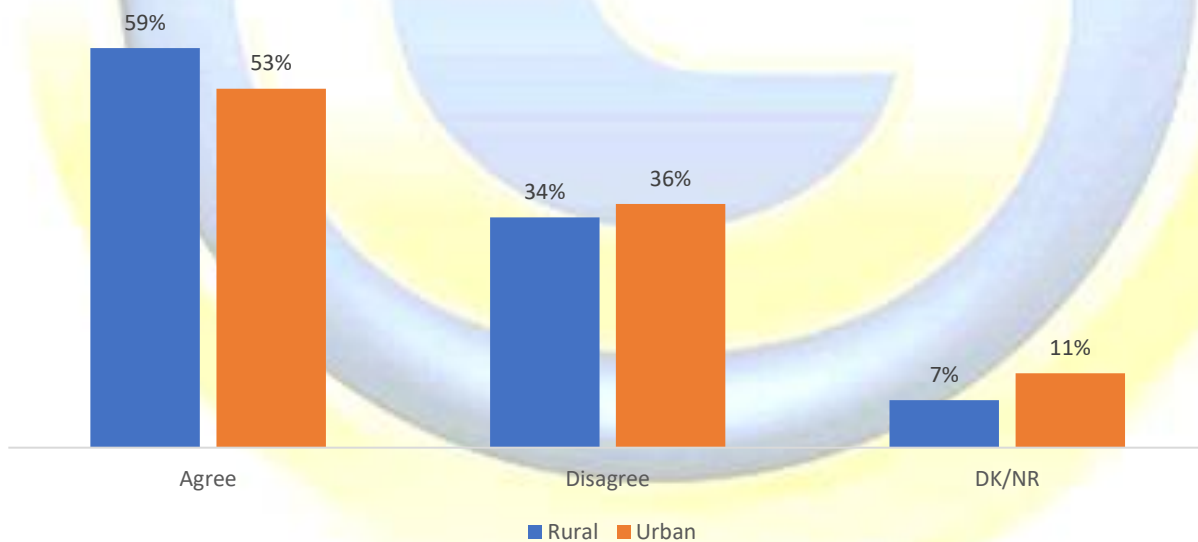
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1089 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 12th September – 11th October 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across education: A higher percentage of individuals with less than FA qualifications (59%) believe that Pakistani people are honest, 16% more than those with FA or higher qualifications (43%).

Across rurality: Rural residents exhibited a stronger belief in the honesty of Pakistani people (59%) compared to their urban counterparts (53%).
