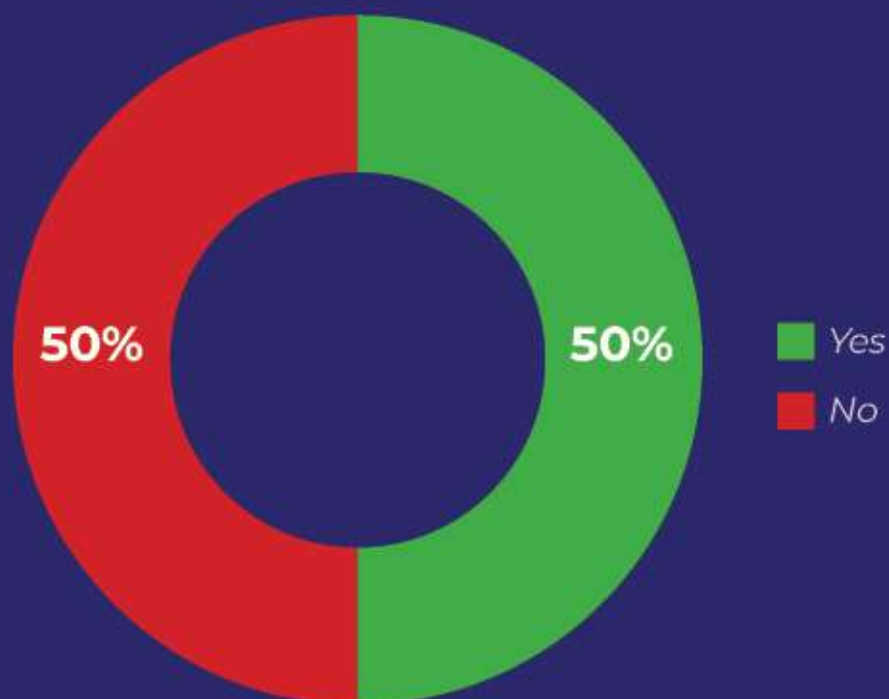


74% Pakistanis below the age of 30 claim to use internet, major age divide found with 68% of those above age 50 not using internet compared to only 26% of respondents aged under 30

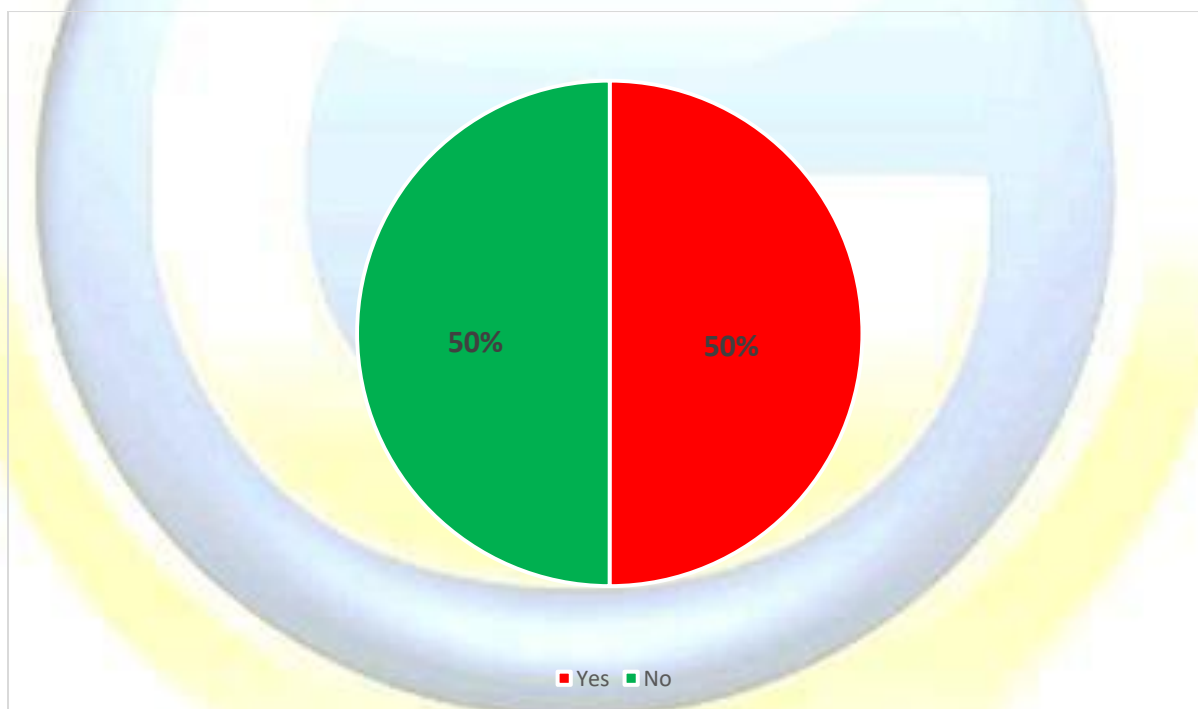

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell me if you use internet?” In response, 50% said ‘Yes and 50% said ‘No.’

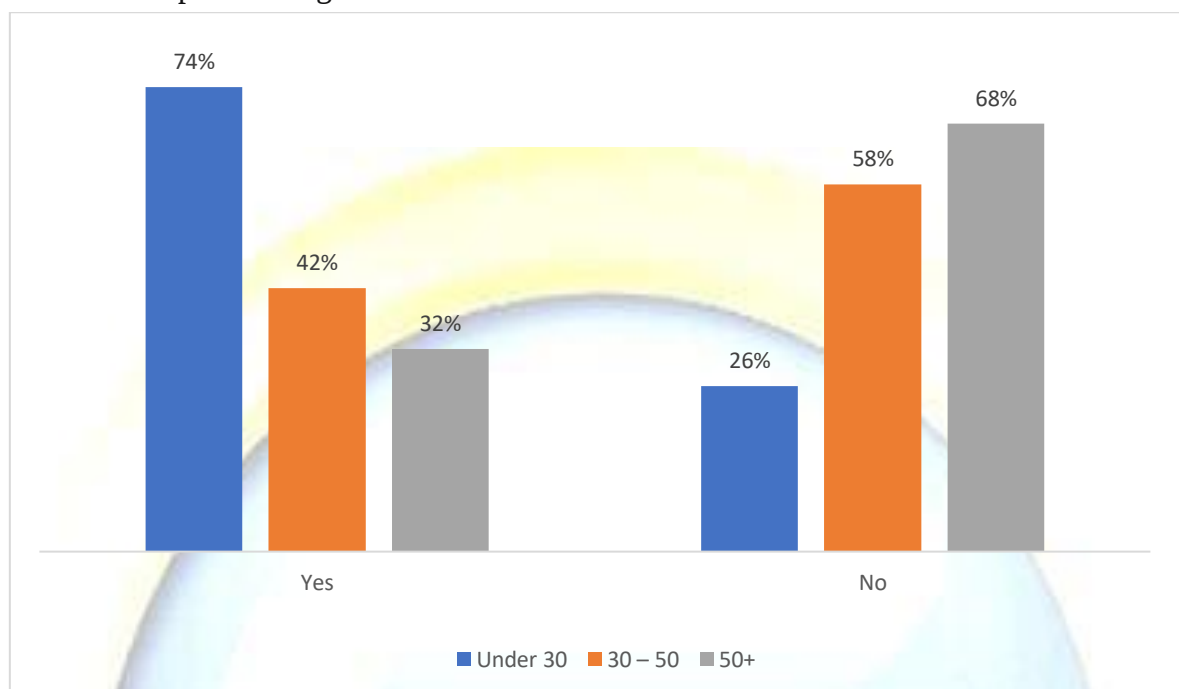

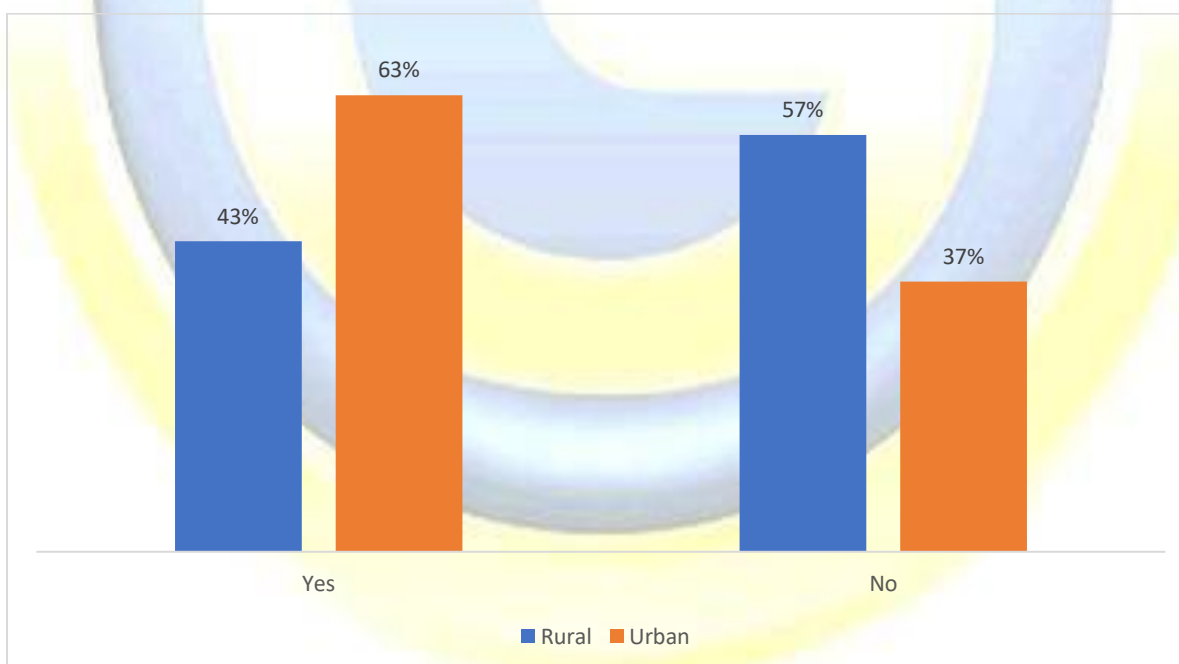
The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1042 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 7th January – 12th January 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across age: 74% of respondents aged under 30 used the internet compared to 42% of respondents aged 30-50 and 32% of respondents aged 50+.

Rural-Urban Divide: Those living in urban areas were 20% more likely to use the internet. 63% of urban residents said they used the internet compared to 43% of rural residents.
