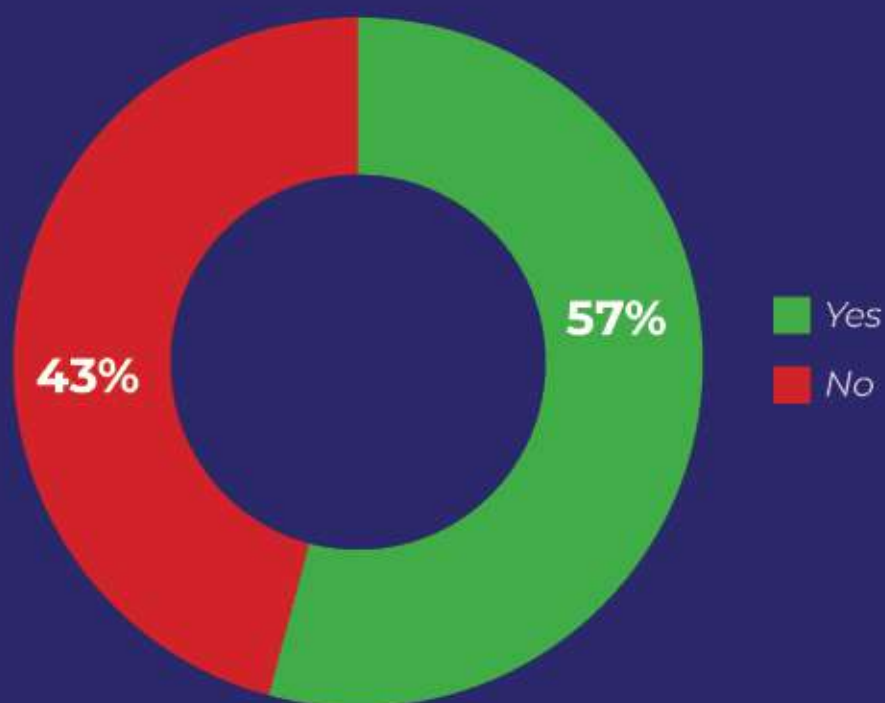


More than half the country (57%) prefers not to go out at night for security reasons

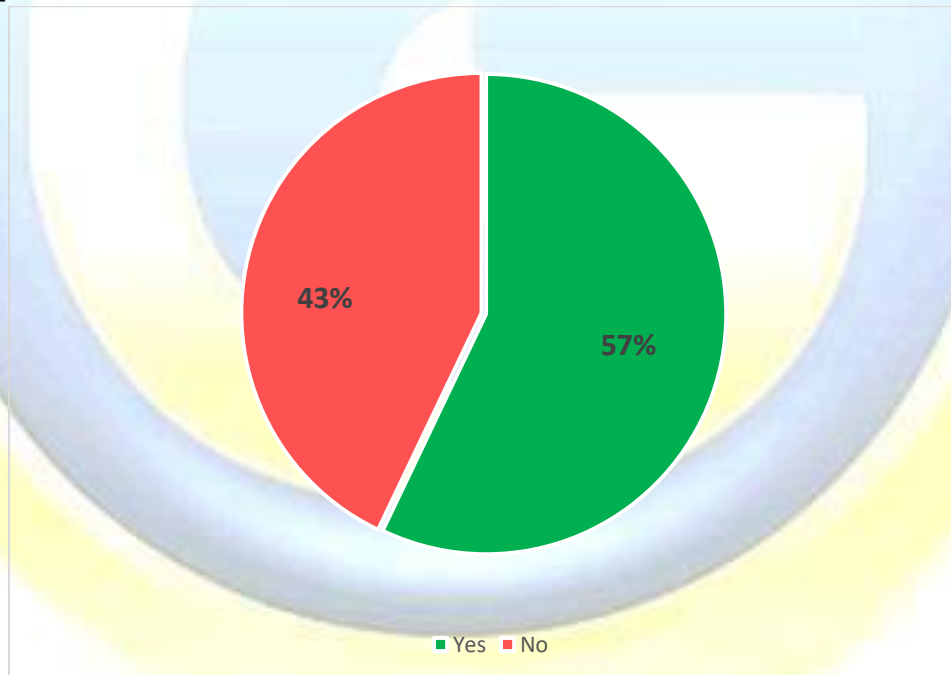

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half the country (57%) prefers not to go out at night for security reasons, with urban residents slightly more likely (58%) to feel unsafe than rural residents (56%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Which of the following things have you done for reasons of security [preferred not to go out at night]?” In response, 57% said ‘Yes,’ and 43% said ‘No.’

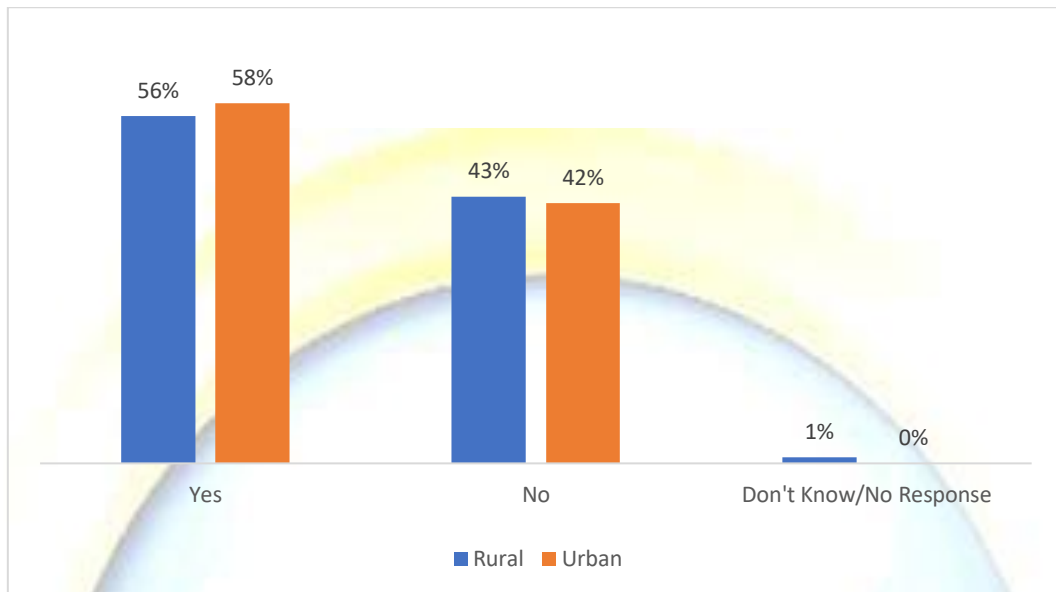
Question: Which of the following things have you done for reasons of security [preferred not to go out at night]?

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1042 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 7th January – 12th January 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Rural-Urban Divide: Those in urban areas were slightly more likely to report that they did not feel safe going out at night (58%) compared to respondents in rural areas (56%).
