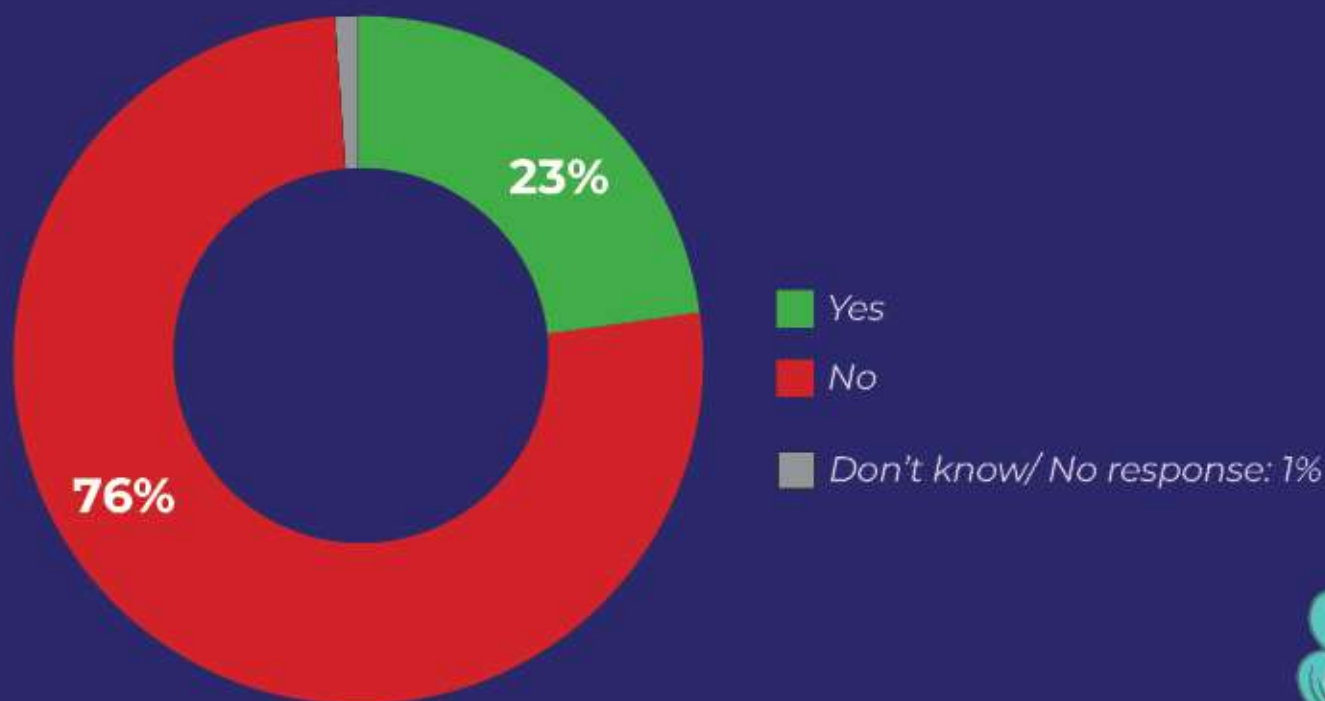


Almost 1 in 4 Pakistanis (23%) have had an injection within the past year, including 25% of women

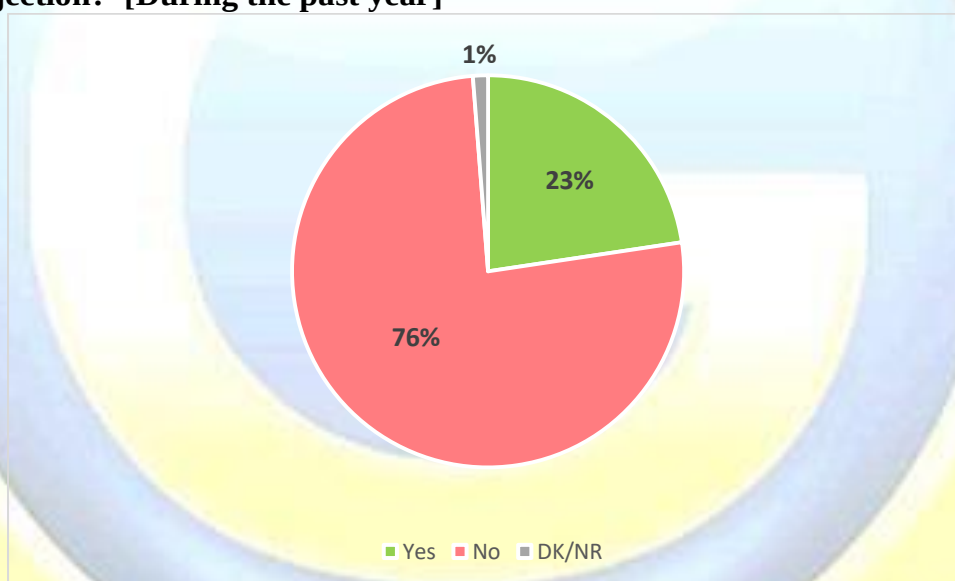
Almost 1 in 4 Pakistanis (23%) have had an injection within the past year, including 25% of women: Gallup and Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, almost 1 in 4 Pakistanis (23%) have had an injection within the past year, including 25% of women.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please think about the past week, month, six months, and year, and tell us if you have ever had an injection? [During the past year]?” In response, 23% said ‘Yes,’ 76% said ‘No’ and 1% did not respond.

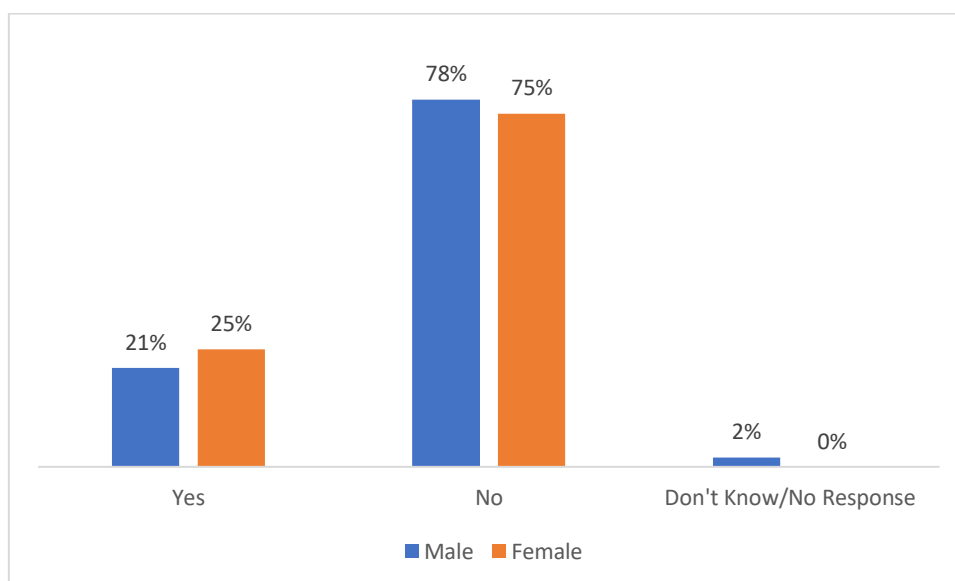
Question: Please think about the past week, month, six months, and year, and tell us if you have ever had an injection? [During the past year]

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1042 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 7th January – 12th January 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Across Gender: Women were 4% more likely to have received an injection in the past year compared to men (21%).
