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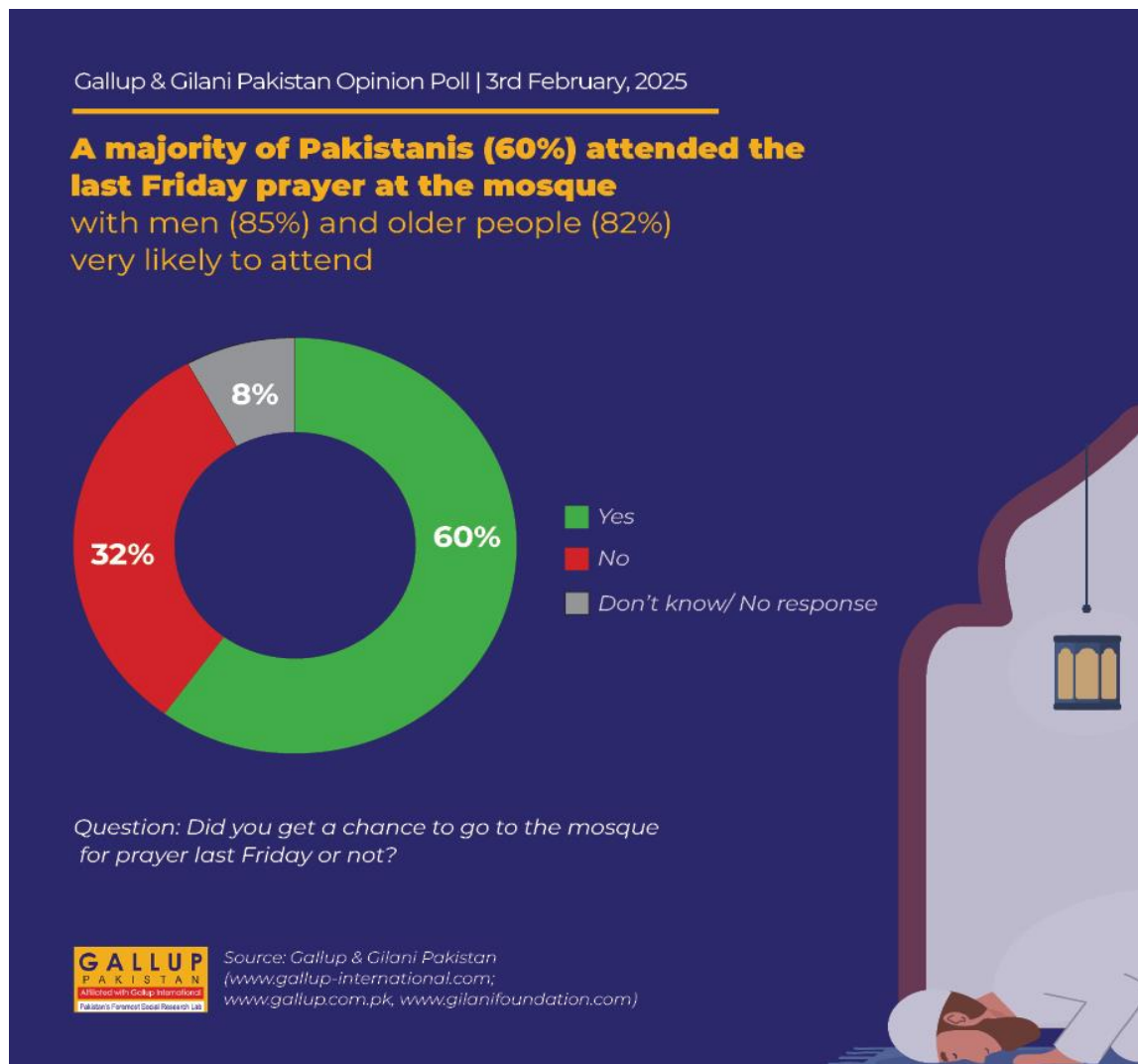

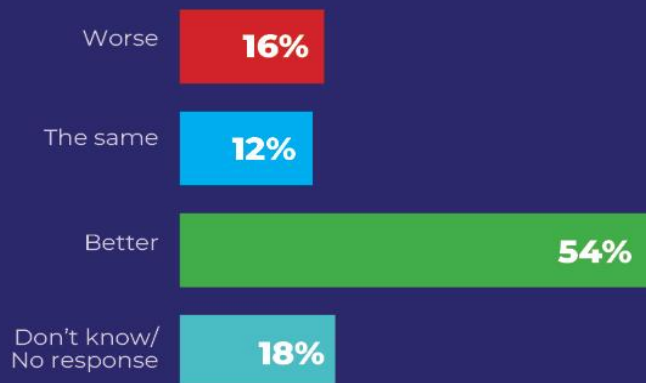
A majority of Pakistanis (60%) attended the last Friday prayer at the mosque, with men (85%) and older people (82%) very likely to attend:
