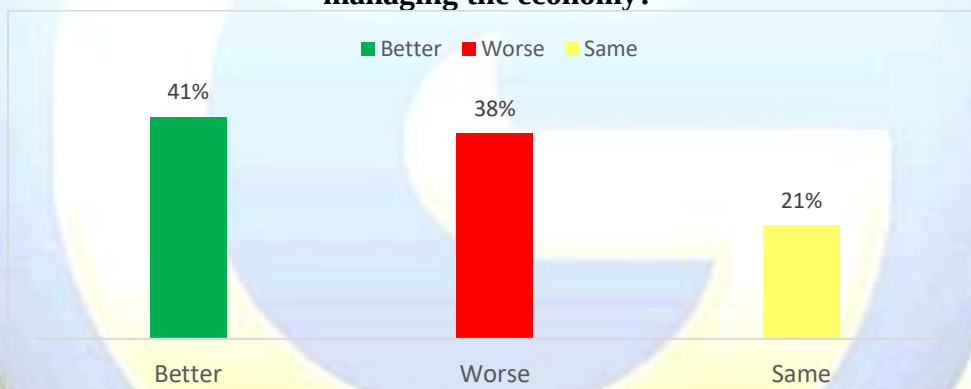

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 38% of Businesses claim that the PMLN government is worse than the previous government at managing the economy while 41% claim it is better.

A nationally representative sample of businesses from across the country was asked the question “Do you think PMLN government is better worse or same as previous government in managing the economy” In response, 41% said ‘Better’, 38% said ‘Worse’ and 21% said ‘The Same.’

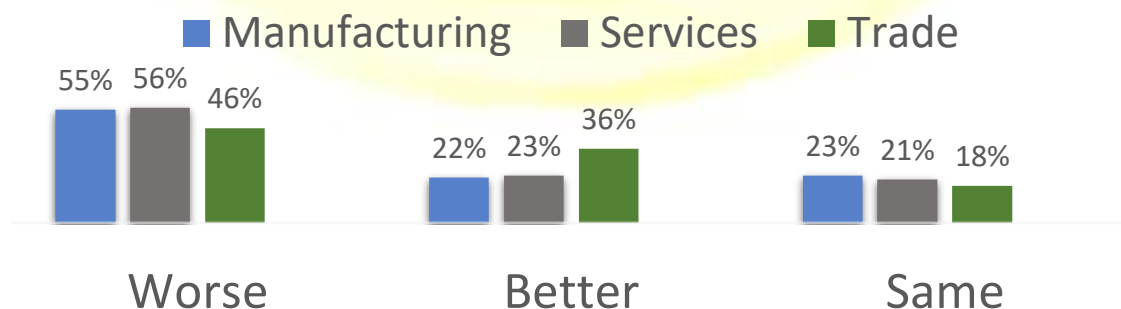
Question: Do you think PMLN government is better worse or same as previous government in managing the economy?

Traders were most likely to approve of the PMLN government’s management of the economy. 36% of traders said the PMLN government was better than the previous government compared to 23% of service providers and 22% of manufacturers.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 482 businesses across Pakistan, conducted from 21st January to 28th January 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm$ 2-3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
