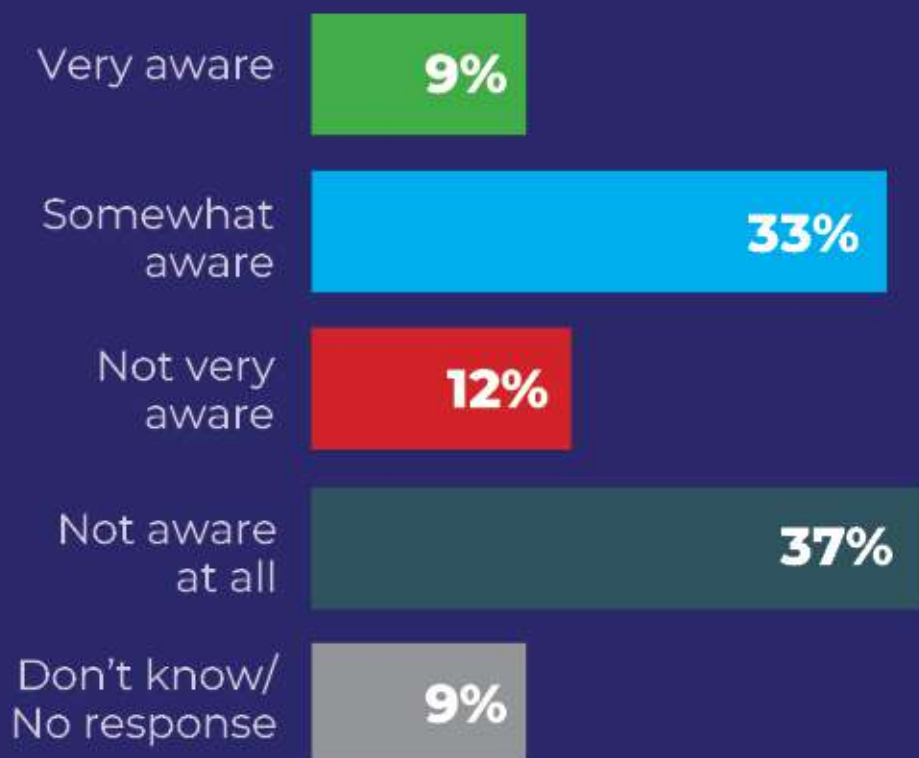


Nearly half of Pakistanis (49%) are somewhat or not at all aware of the legal process and concept of Khula

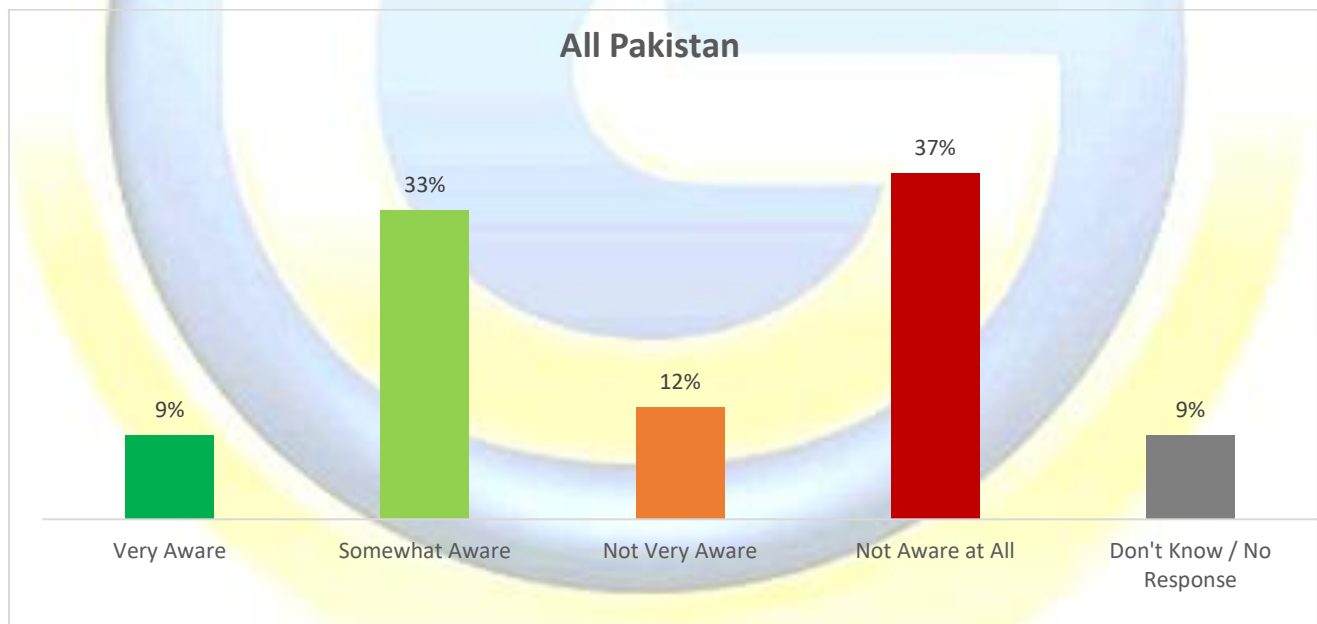
Nearly half of Pakistanis (49%) are somewhat or not at all aware of the legal process and concept of Khula (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

(Islamabad), 27th March 2025

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly half of Pakistanis (49%) are somewhat or not at all aware of the legal process and concept of Khula.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, ***“How aware are you of the concept and legal process of Khula in Pakistan?”***. In response, 9% said 'very aware', 33% said 'somewhat aware', 12% said 'not very aware', 37% said 'not aware at all', while 9% said they don't know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 785 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 17th January – 22nd January 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
