A significant majority of Pakistanis (67%) are not at all interested in politics or elections (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a significant majority of Pakistanis (67%) are not at all interested in politics or elections.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, ***“Some people actively participate in politics/election, while others have no interest in politics or voting. What is your level of participation in politics?”***. In response, 10% said they have been actively involved in politics/election, 13% said they have been somewhat involved in politics/election, 67% said they are not involved at all in politics/election, while 10% said that they didn’t know or didn’t respond.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 788 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 7th January – 12nd January 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
