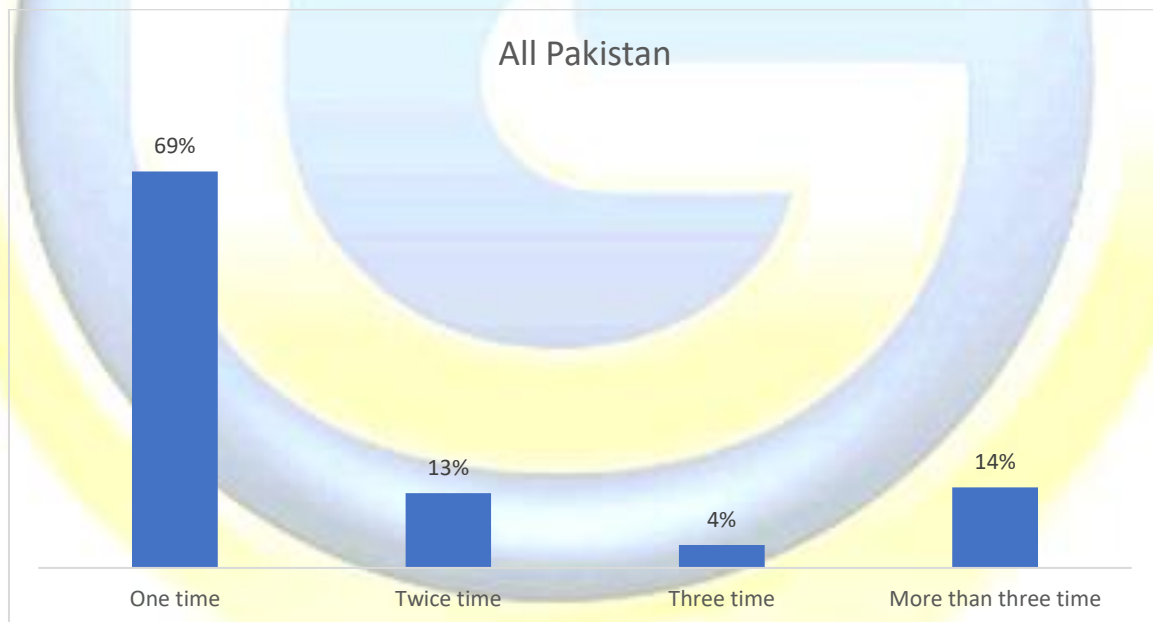
Among Pakistanis who faced accidents in the past six months, majority reported it just once or twice (82%) — average rate: 1 incident. (Gallup & Gilani Survey)

(Islamabad), 11 June 2025

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, among Pakistanis who faced accidents in the past six months, majority reported it just once or twice (82%) — average rate: 1 incident.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women who experienced an accident in the past six months from across the country was further asked the question, *“How many times have you experienced such accidents in the past six months?”*. In response to this question, 69% said ‘one time’, 13% said ‘twice time’, 4% said ‘three times’, while 14% said ‘more than three times’.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1038 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 11th April 2025 – 18th April 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
