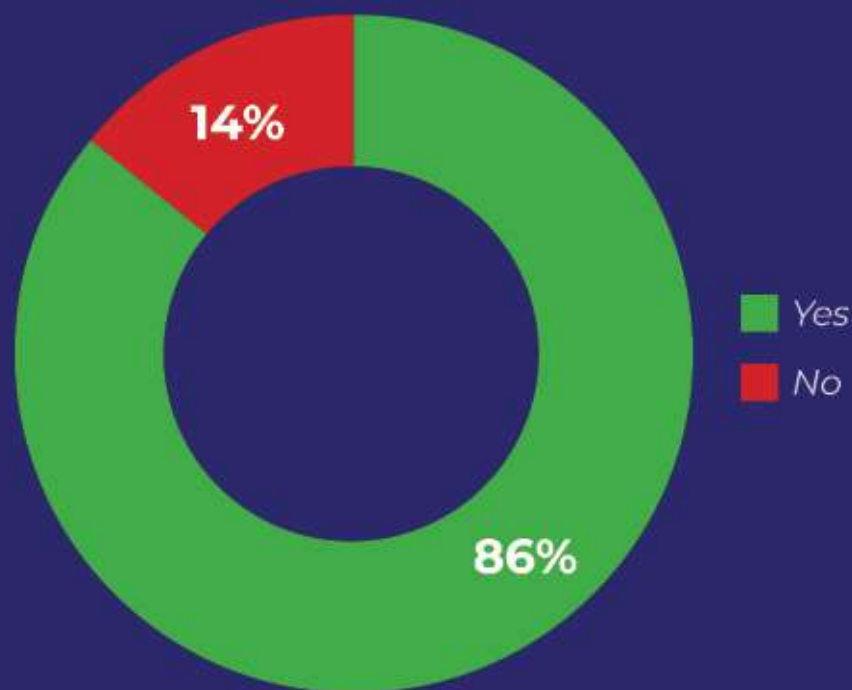


Among motorcycle-owning households, 86% say they personally drive it. Highest self-driving rates seen among ages 40–49 (94%).

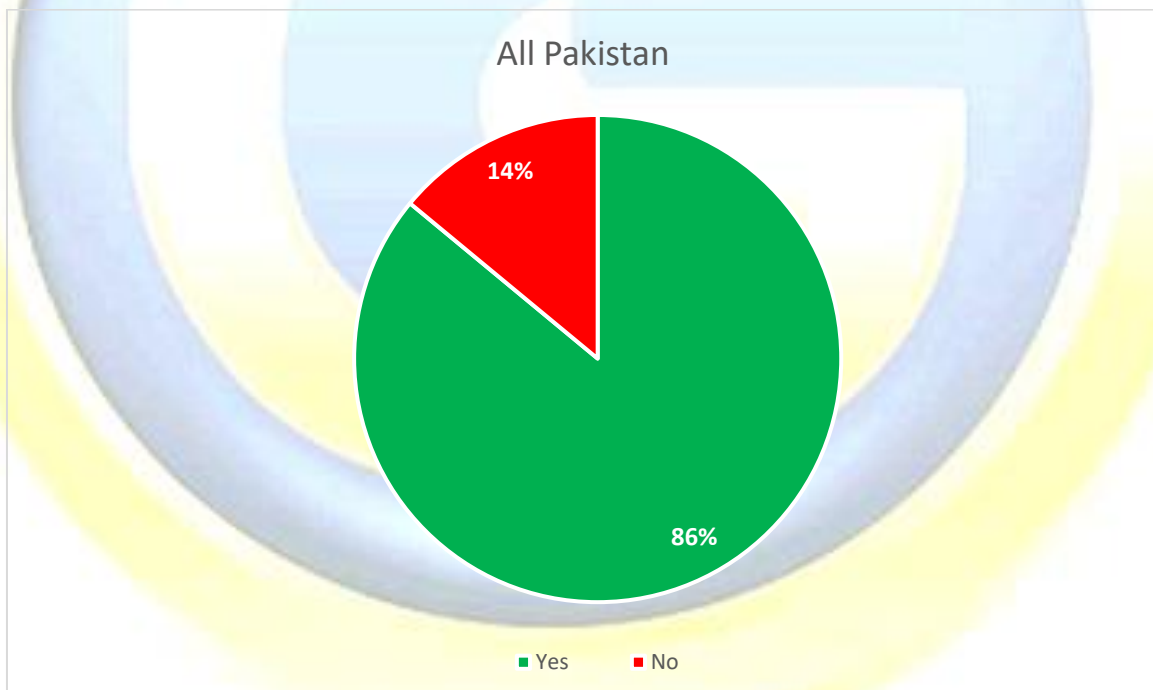

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, among motorcycle-owning households, 86% say they personally drive it. Highest self-driving rates seen among ages 40–49 (94%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women who reported household owning a motorcycle from across the country was further asked the question, ***“Do you personally drive the motorcycle?”***. In response to this question, 86% said ‘yes’, while 14% said ‘no’.

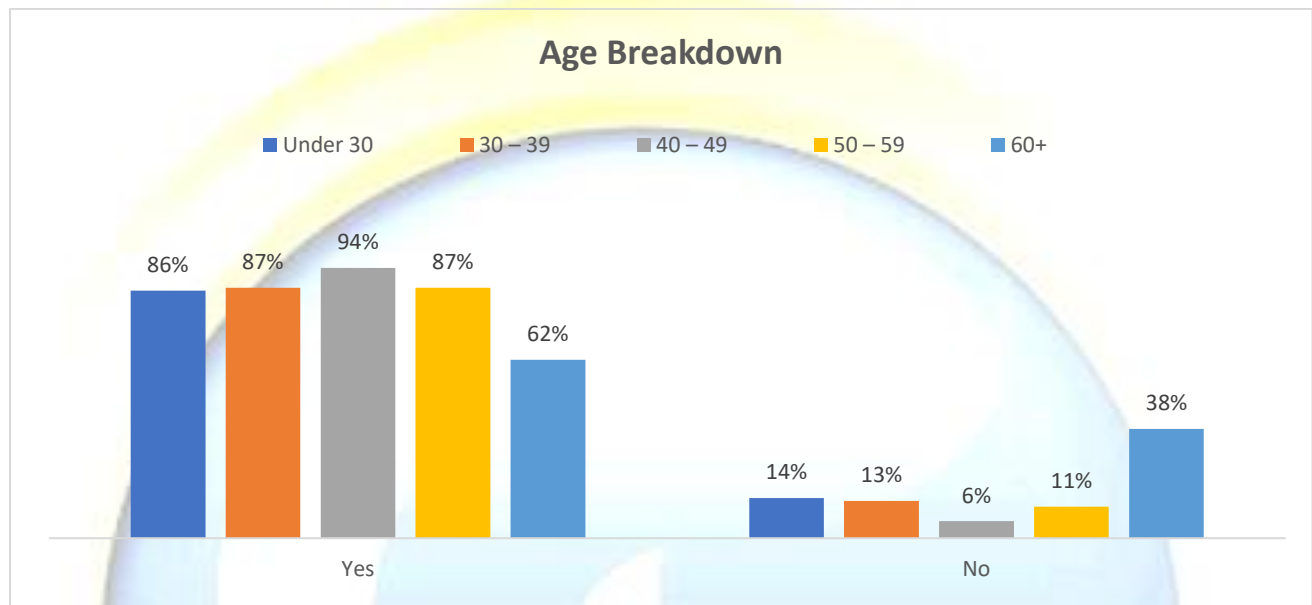
Question: Do you personally drive the motorcycle?

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 624 men and women (who reported motorcycle ownership) in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 11th April 2025 – 18th April 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

Age Breakdown: An age-wise analysis of personal motorcycle usage among owners reveals notable trends across different age groups. The highest rate of personal motorcycle operation was observed among individuals aged 40–49, where 94% reported driving the motorcycle themselves. High levels of usage were also reported among those aged 30–39 and 50–59, at 87% each. However, a notable decline is observed among those aged 60 and above, where only 62% reported personally driving the motorcycle.
