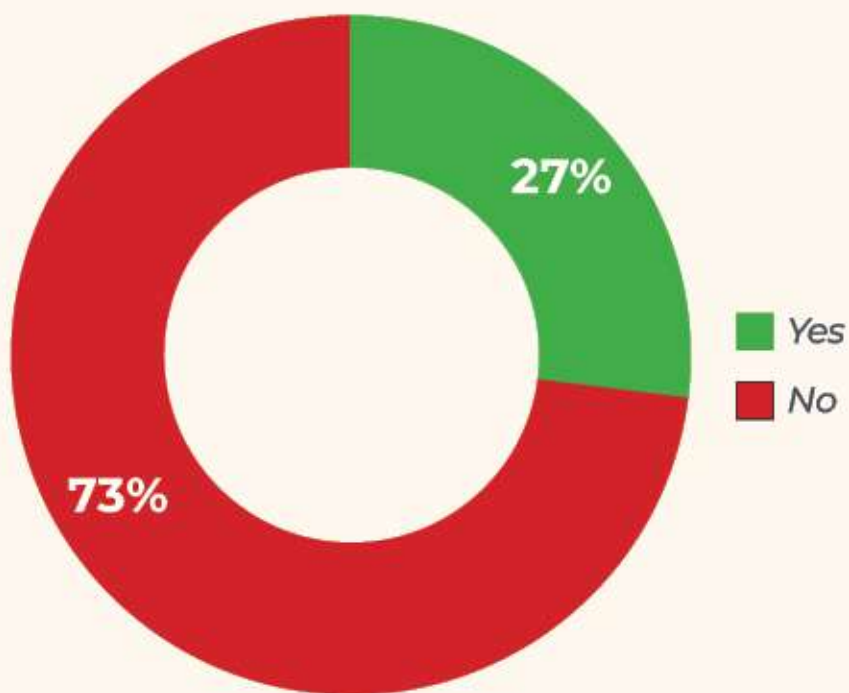


## 27% Pakistanis claimed to have watched the recent 'Super Blood Moon' eclipse directly.

#### **27% Pakistanis claimed to have watched the recent 'Super Blood Moon' eclipse directly. (Gallup & Gilani Survey)**

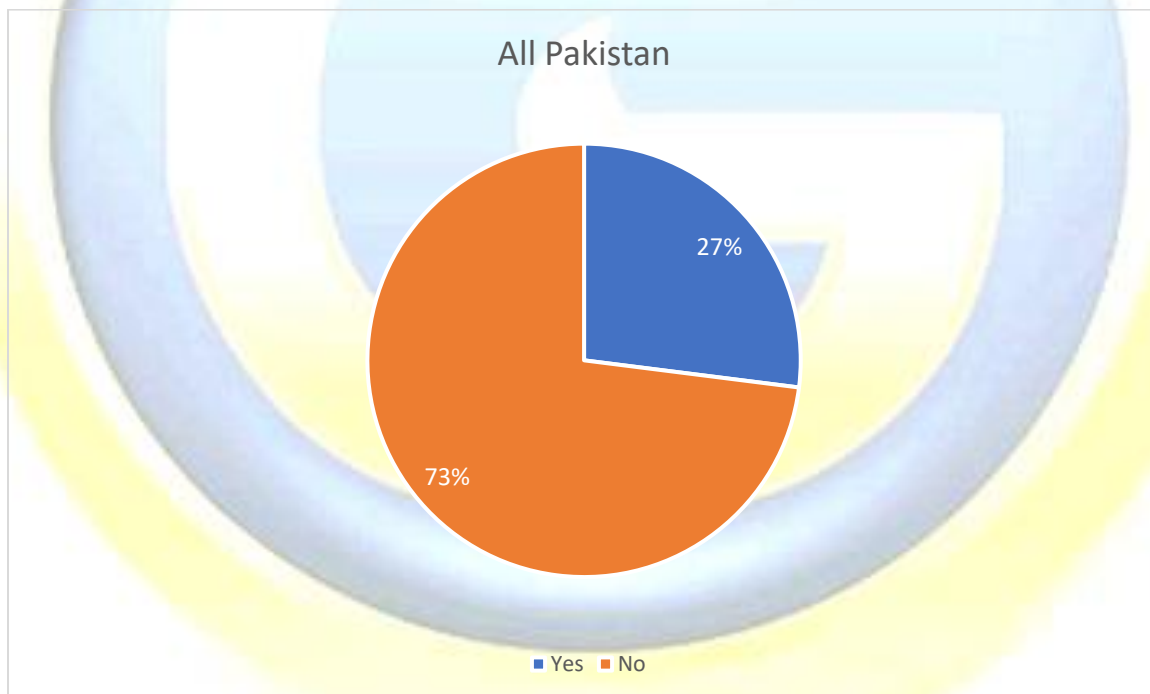

According to a Gallup & Gilani Pakistan survey, 27% Pakistanis claimed to have watched the recent 'Super Blood Moon' eclipse directly.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women across the country was asked the question, ***"Did you personally watch the recent total lunar eclipse (Super Blood Moon) directly?"***. In response, 27% of respondents said 'Yes', they personally watched the recent total lunar eclipse ("Super Blood Moon") directly, while 73% said they did not.

The findings indicate notable public engagement with the recent lunar eclipse, highlighting opportunities for broader science outreach during similar astronomical events in the future.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 753 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from September 12, 2025 to September 23, 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
