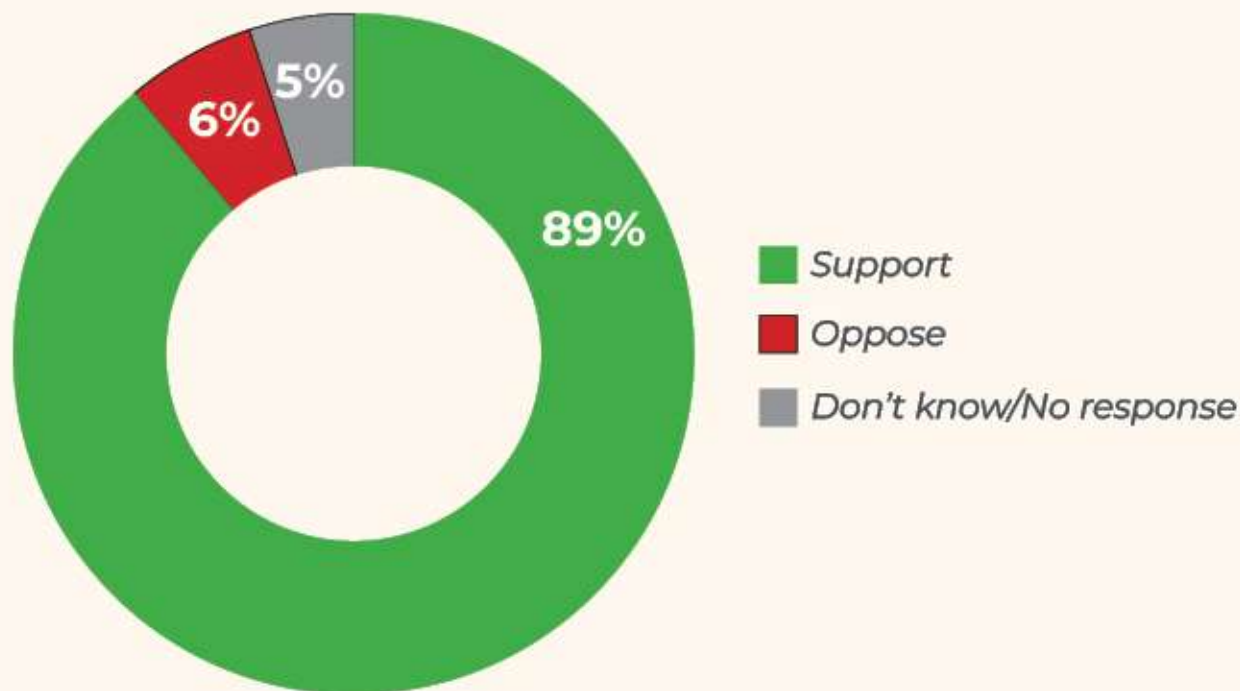


Nearly 9 in 10 (89%) Pakistanis Support the Government's Health Card Program, Revealing Near-Universal Backing Nationwide.

Nearly 9 in 10 (89%) Pakistanis Support the Government's Health Card Program, Revealing Near-Universal Backing Nationwide. (Gallup & Gilani Survey)

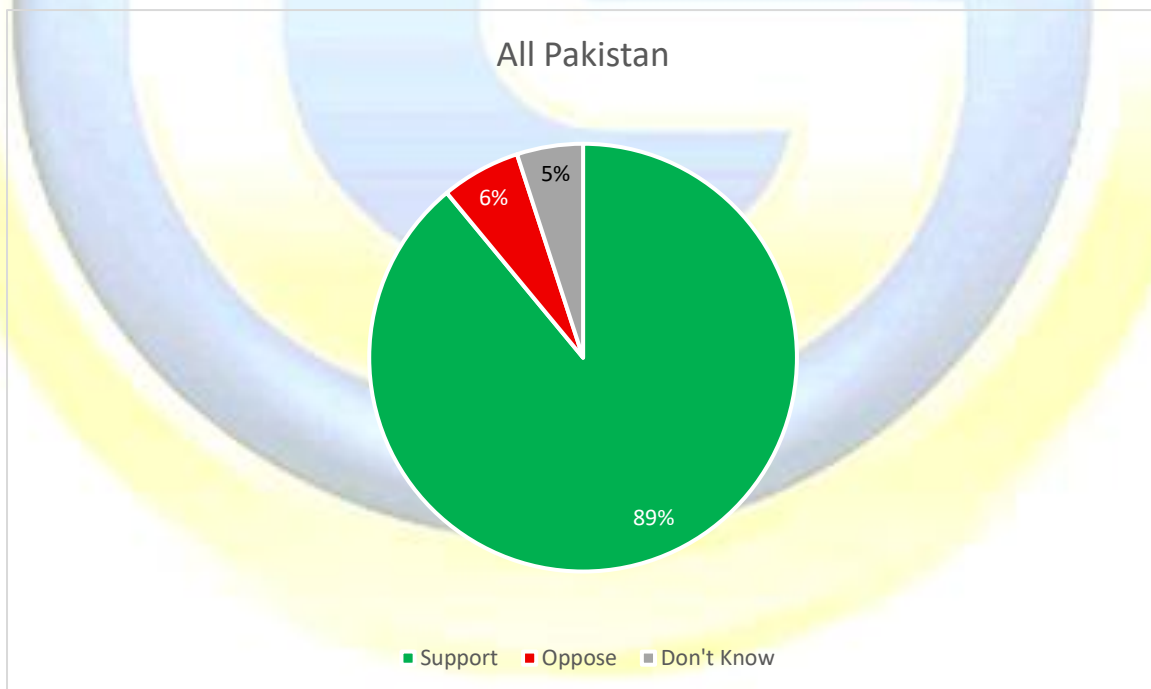

According to a Gallup & Gilani Pakistan survey, nearly 9 in 10 (89%) Pakistanis support the government's health card program, revealing near-universal backing nationwide.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women across the country was asked the question, ***“Some people support the government's health card program, believing it is a good program, while others oppose it, saying it is not good. Do you support or oppose the health card program?”***. In response, 89% of respondents nationwide expressed ‘support’, while only 6% ‘opposed’ the program. A further 5% said they did not know.

The findings demonstrate overwhelming public trust in the program, signaling strong political and social capital for health-related welfare initiatives.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1060 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from August 02, 2025 to August 21, 2025. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
