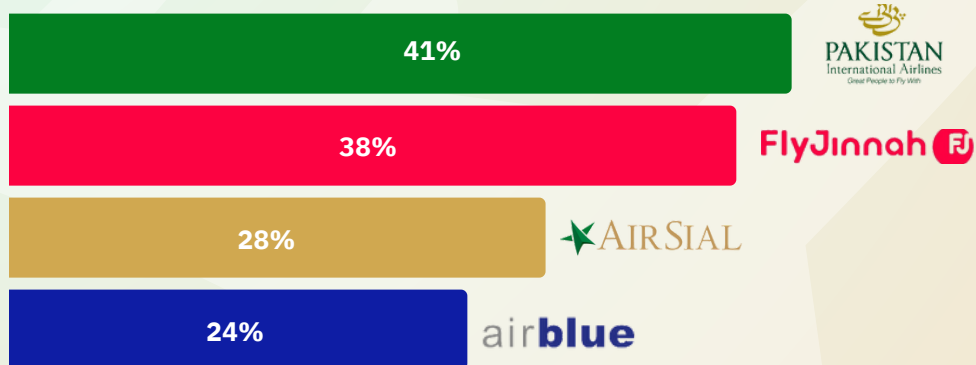

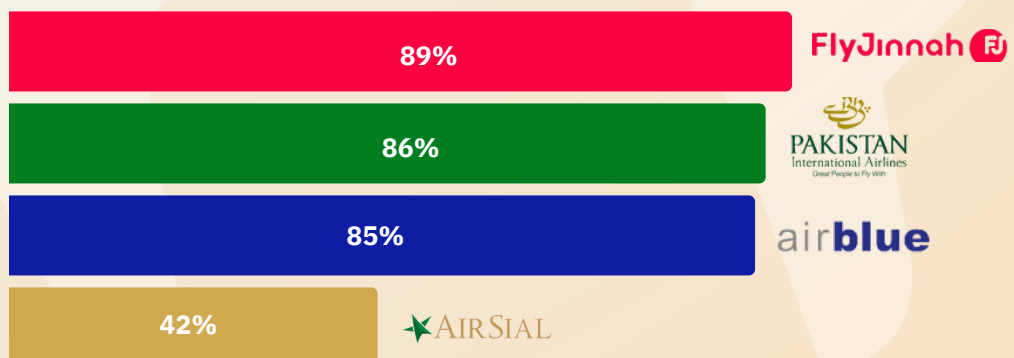
The top carrier in terms of domestic departure punctuality during the month of December 2025, was PIA, registering on average 41% departures within 15 minutes of scheduled time.

The top carrier in terms of domestic departure regularity during the month of December 2025, was Fly Jinnah, boasting a stellar 89% rate of flight operations.



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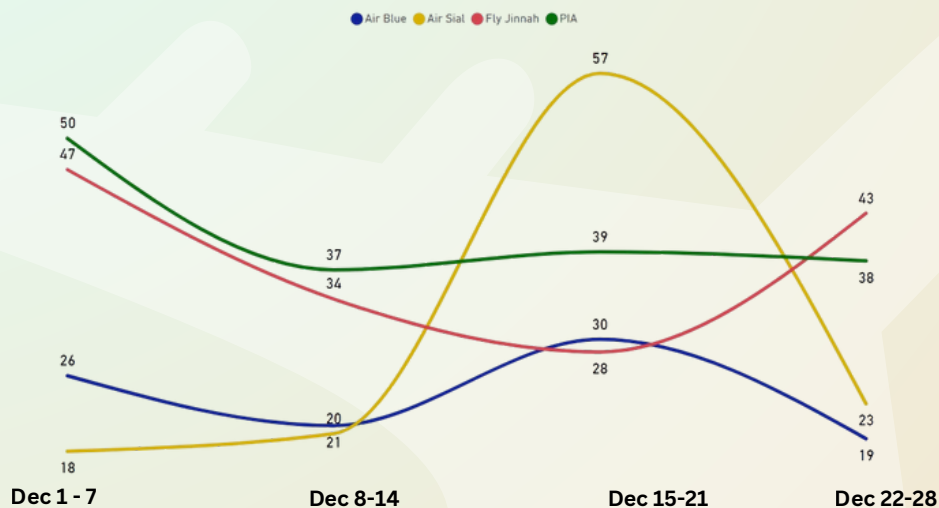

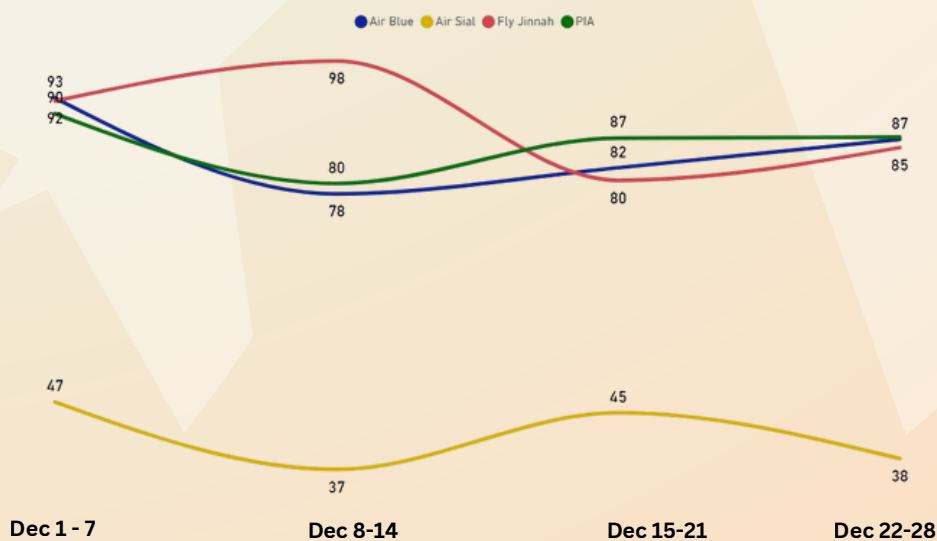
PIA led in domestic departure punctuality during the month of December 2025, maintaining its top position for the majority of the weekly punctuality trends.

Fly Jinnah led in domestic departure regularity during the month of December 2025, maintaining its top position for the majority of the weekly regularity trends.



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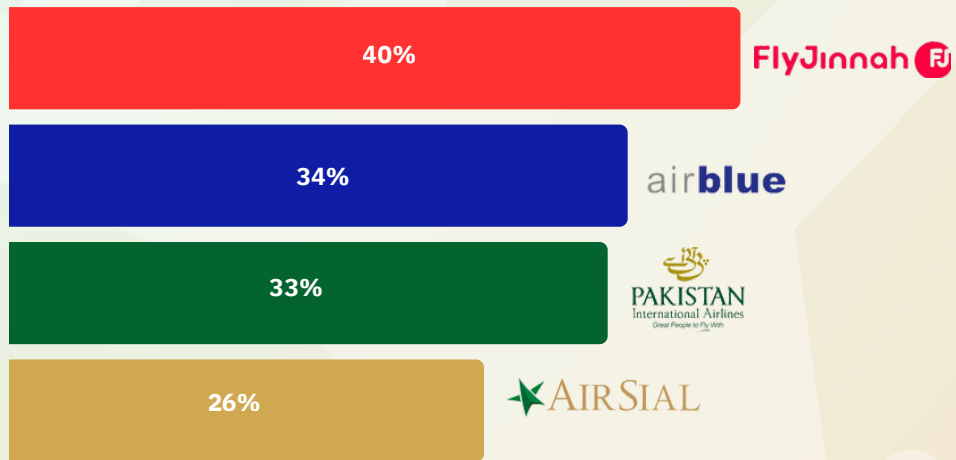

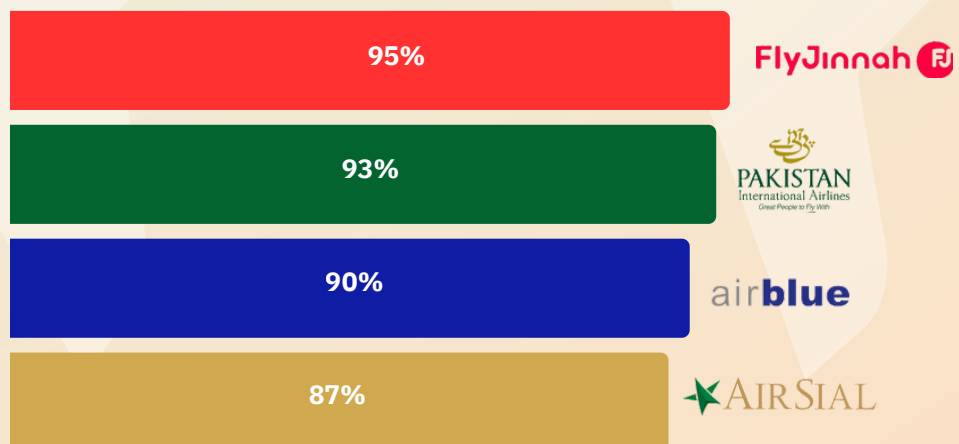
The top carrier in terms of International departure punctuality during the month of December 2025, was Fly Jinnah, registering on average 58% departures within 15 minutes of scheduled time.

The top carrier in terms of international departure regularity during the month of December 2025, was PIS, registering on average 95% departures within 15 minutes of scheduled time.



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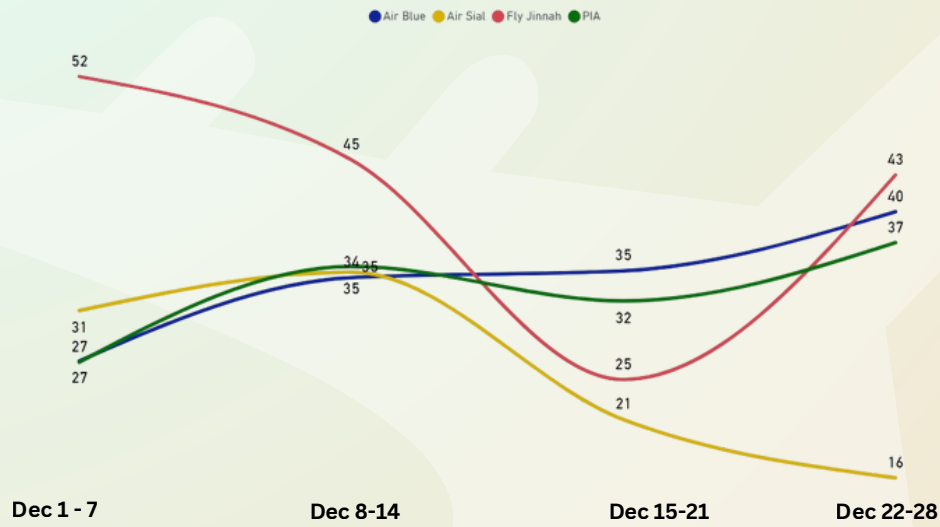

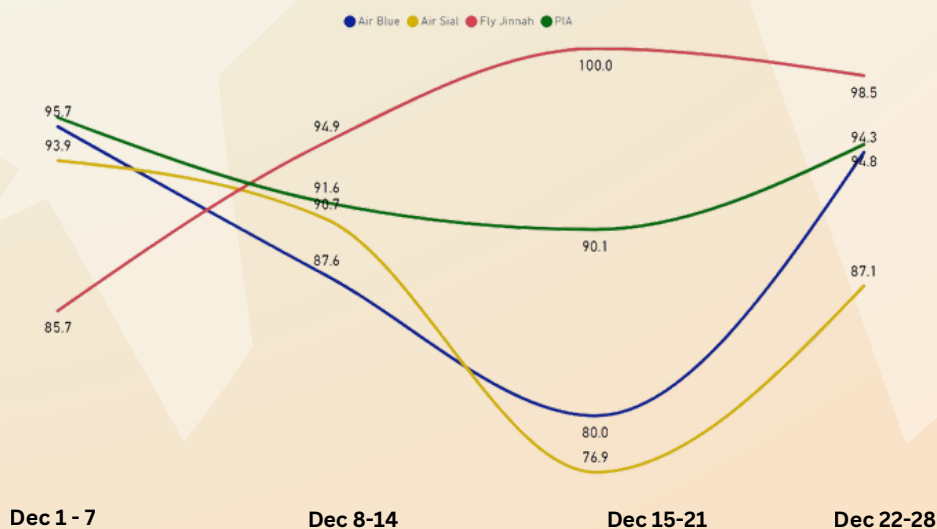
Fly Jinnah led in international departure punctuality during the month of December 2025, maintaining its top position for the weekly punctuality trends.

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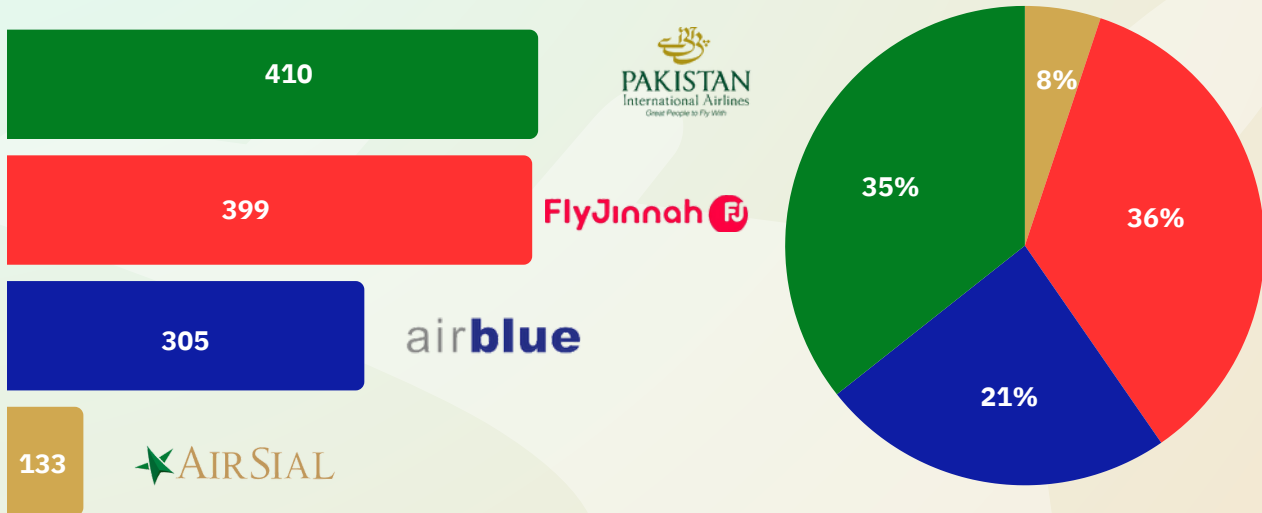


Operated Flights

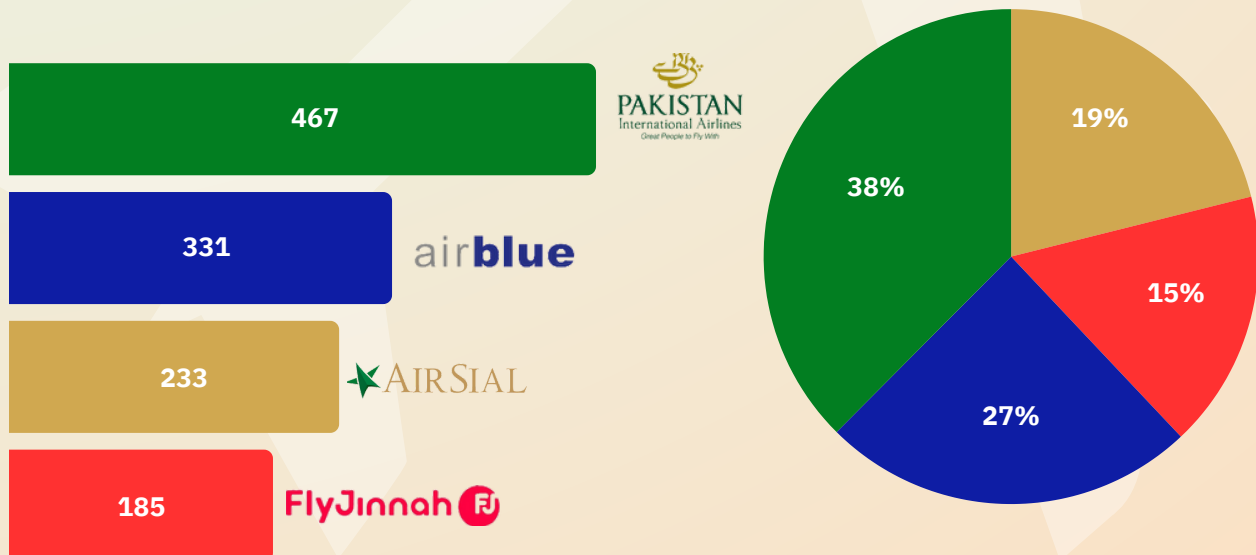

PIA secured the top spot in international flights during the month of December 2025, operating 467 flights (38%) to various destinations around the world.



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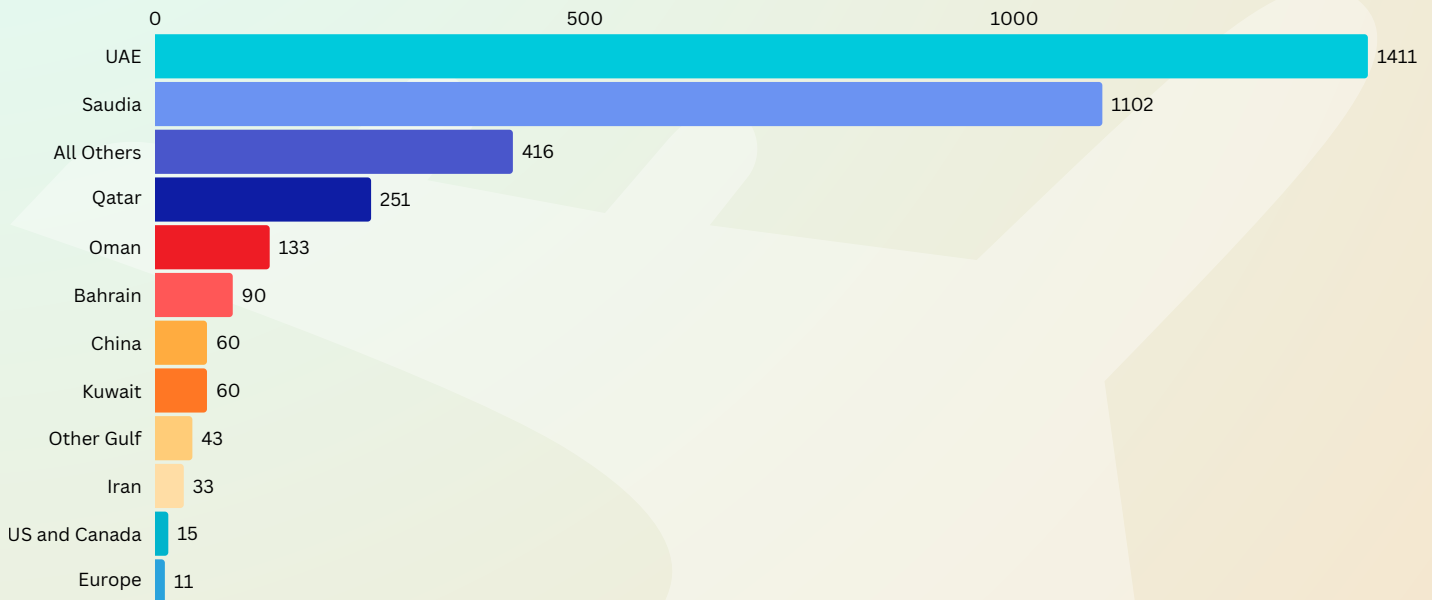

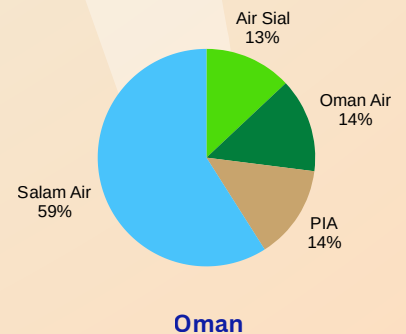
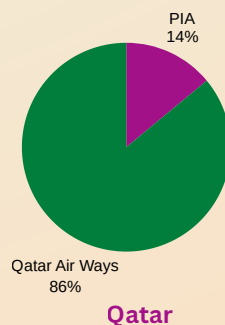
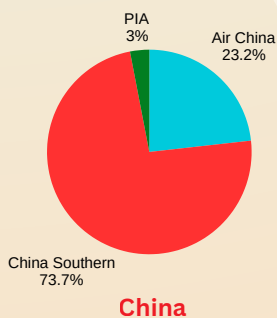
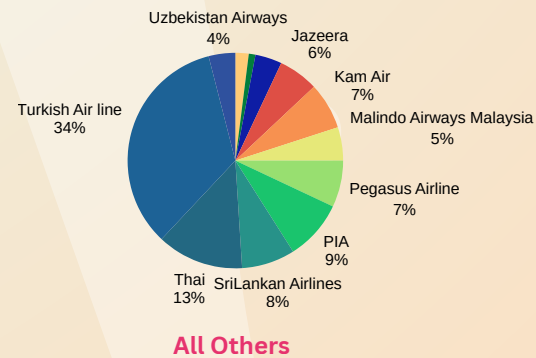
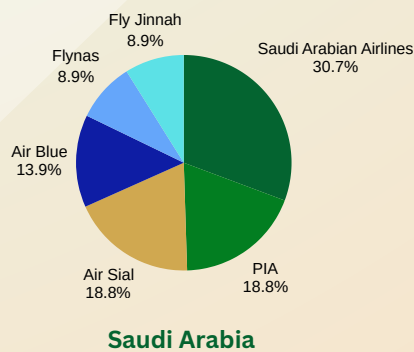
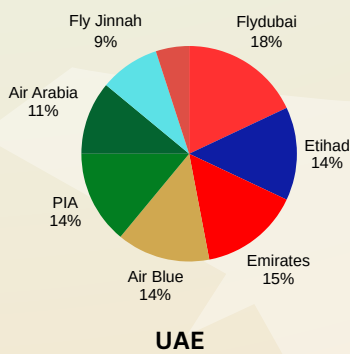
Flights Count

During the month of December 2025, Gulf countries remained a hub for flights from Pakistan, with notable arrivals including the UAE (1411), Saudi Arabia (1102), Qatar (251), and others.



Market Share

During the month of December 2025, PIA continued to serve as the primary local carrier for international flight operations, securing significant market shares: 14% for the UAE, 19% for Saudi Arabia, 3% for China, 14% for Qatar, and 14% for Oman.



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
