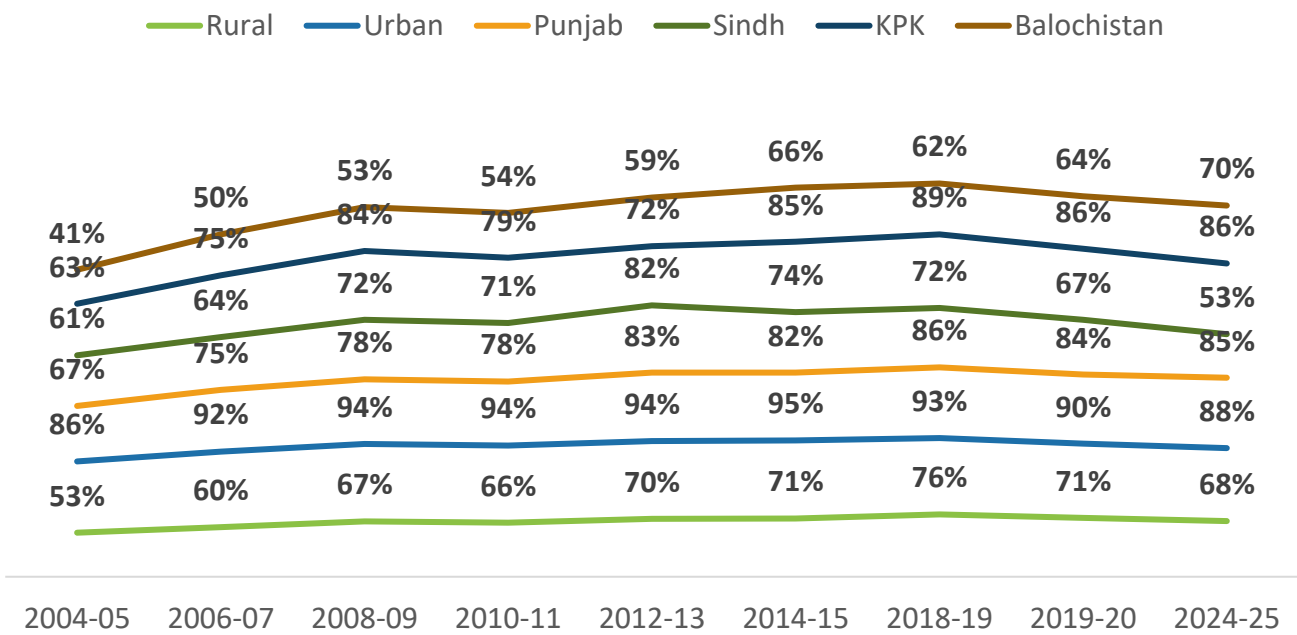
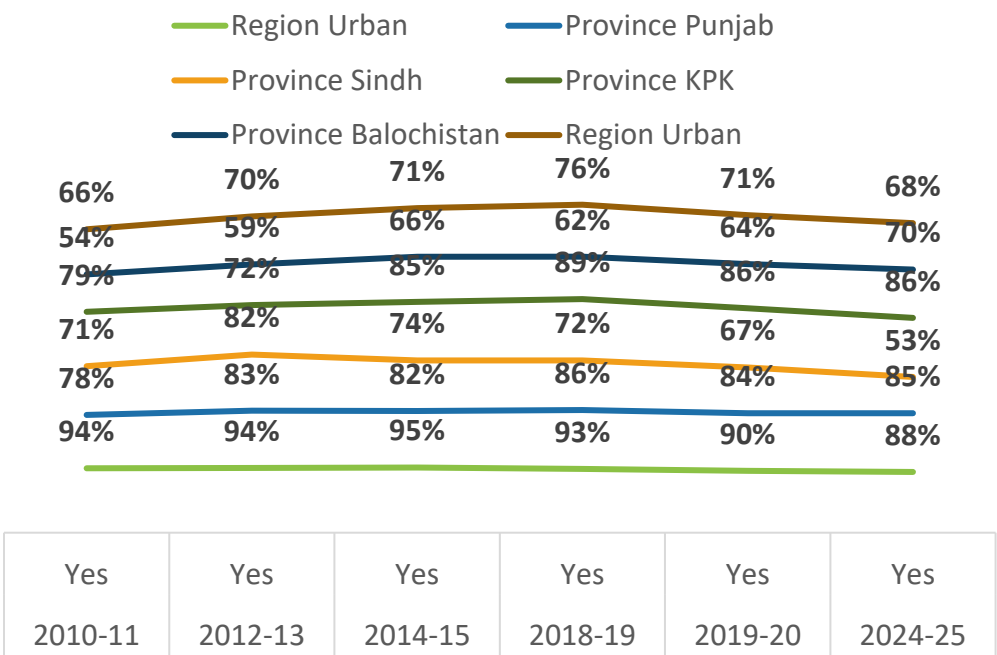
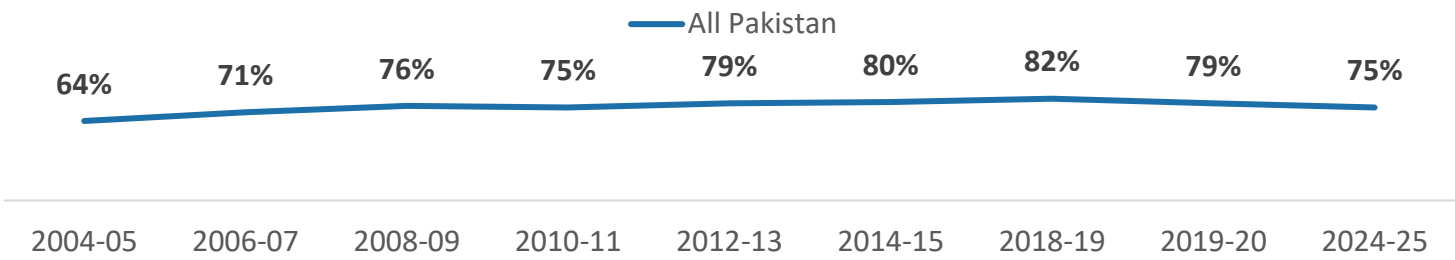


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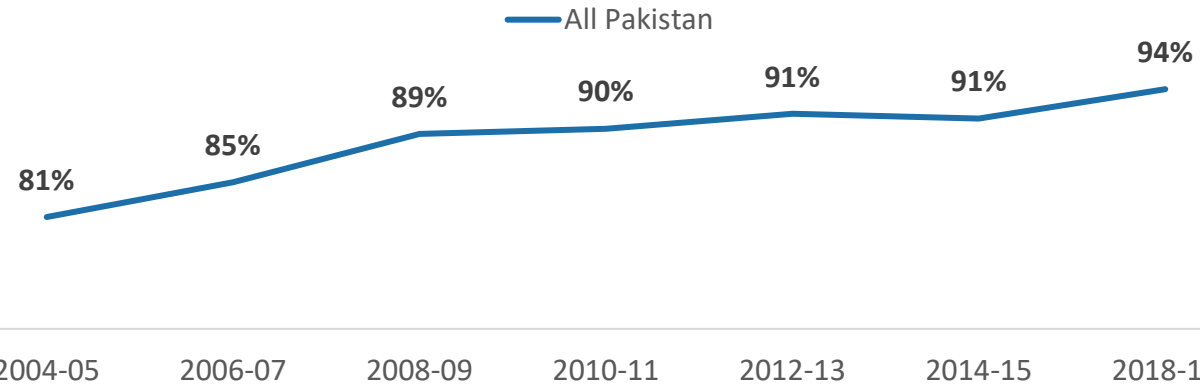


Between 2004 and 2019, 18% more Pakistanis households claim to own an iron and it decreased by 7% till 2025. Households from urban areas report higher ownership then those from rural areas. While KP households had the second lowest number of irons in 2004, had the highest in 2018.

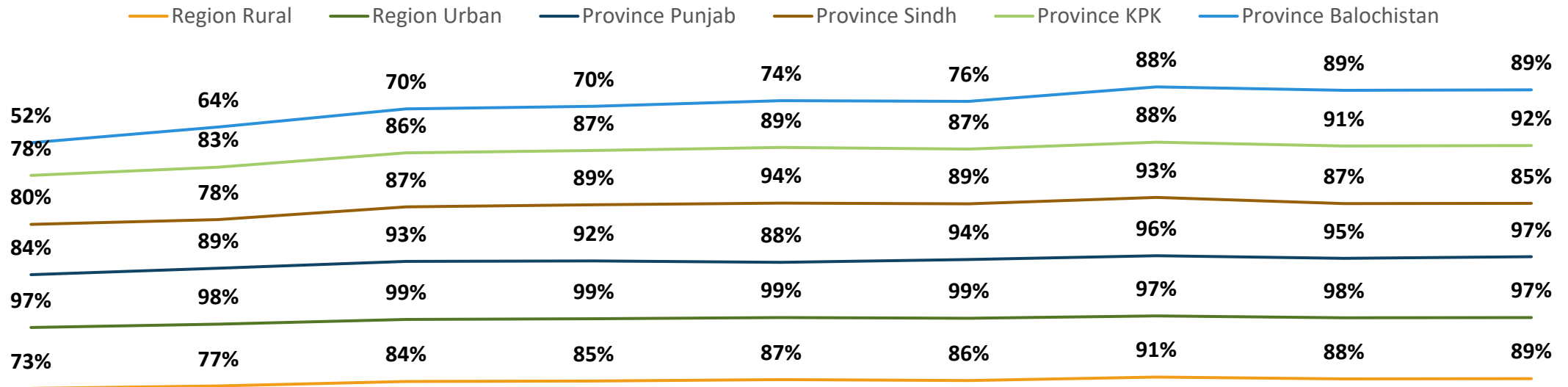

Do you own a fan?



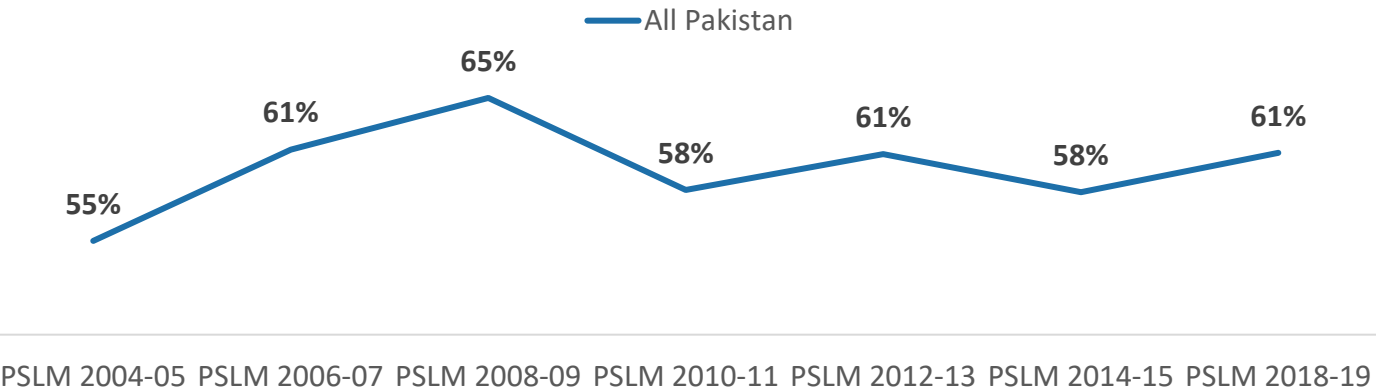
Between 2004 and 2019, the proportion of households owning a fan rose from 81% to 94%. Households in Balochistan saw the highest increase in fan ownership from 52% to 88%.



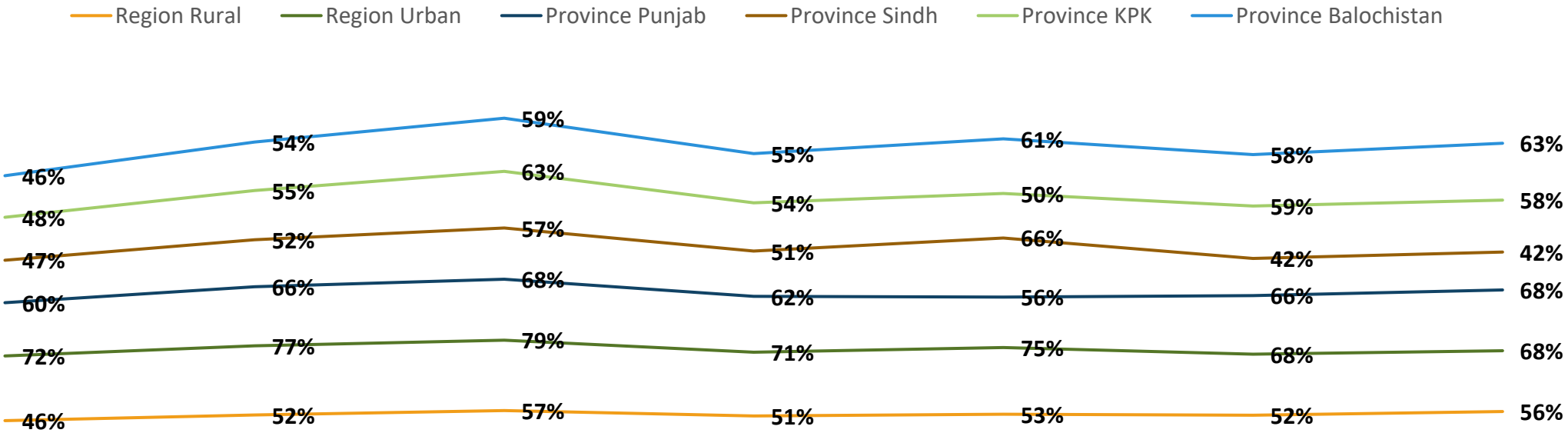

Do you own a Sewing Machine?



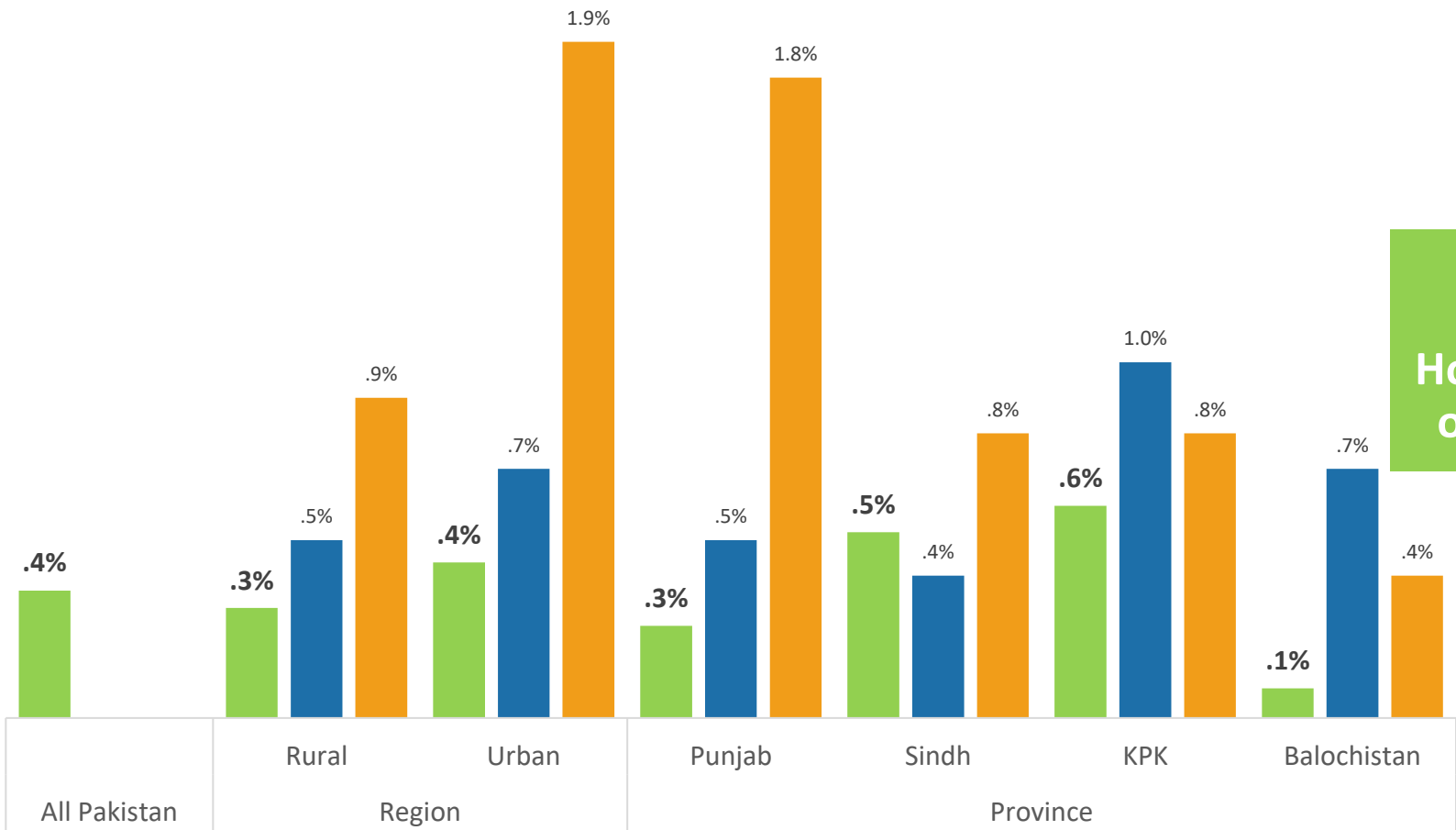
Pakistan saw a rise in the possession of sewing machines till 2006 followed by a drop. Provincial and regional numbers stayed stagnant except Balochistan which experienced a 17% increase.

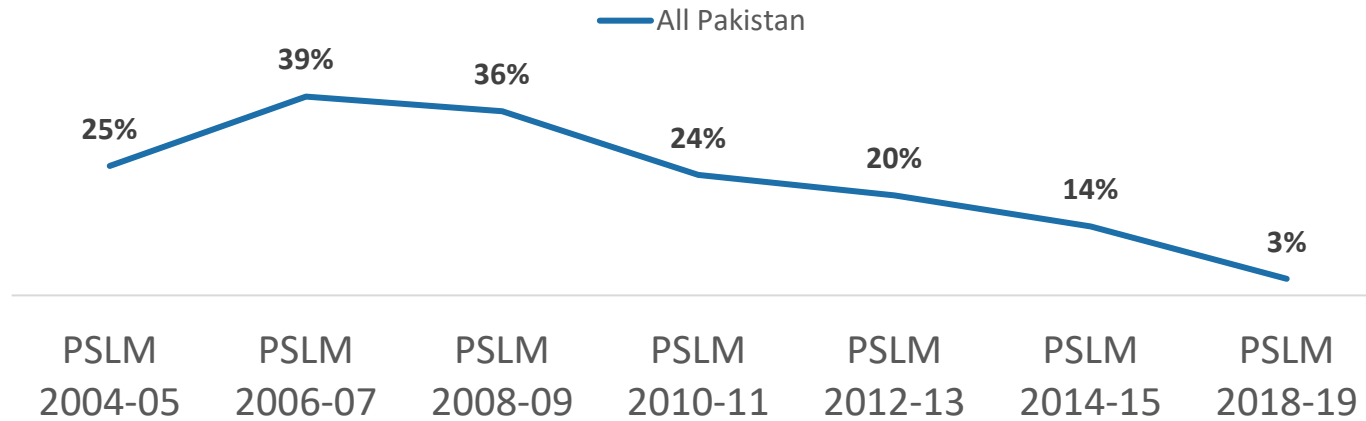

Do you have knitting?

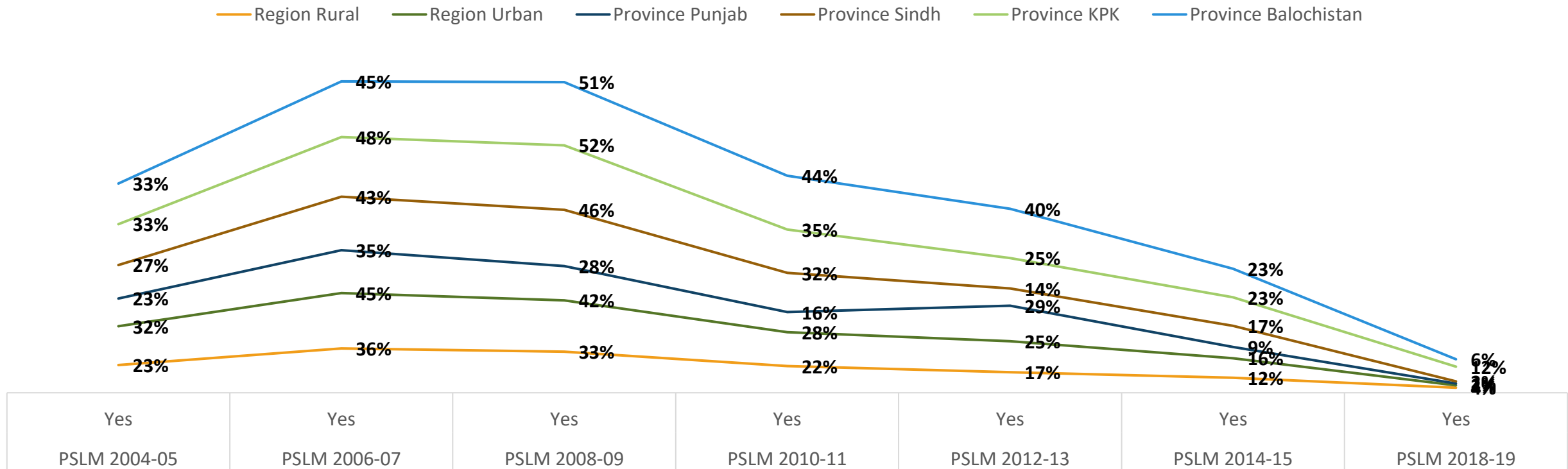


Negligible proportion of Pakistani households own knitting material. Households from Punjab report highest ownership at 1.8% between 2024-25.

Do you have Radio or cassette player?

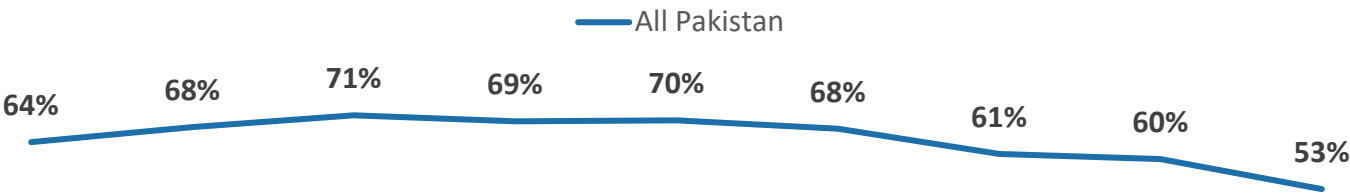


The ownership of cassette players and radio's declined as time passed. This trend is evident across regions and provinces which is mostly due to the invention of MP3 players.



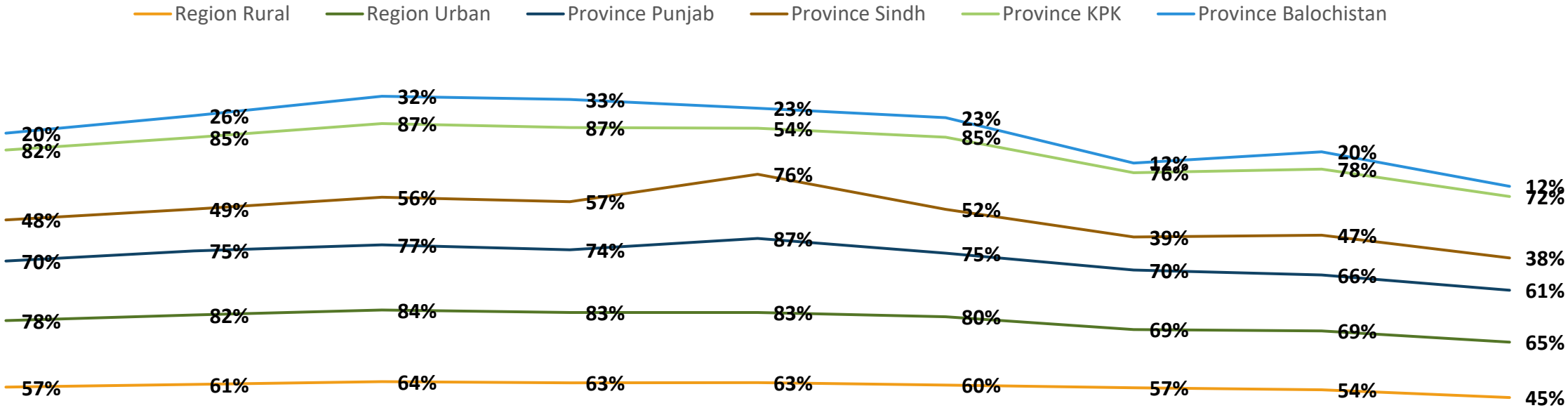

The possession of a table and chair rose from 2004 till 2008 and then fell to 61% in 2018. Balochistan has the lowest ownership from 20% to 12% in 2018. KPK has the highest number of tables and chairs at 76% in 2018.

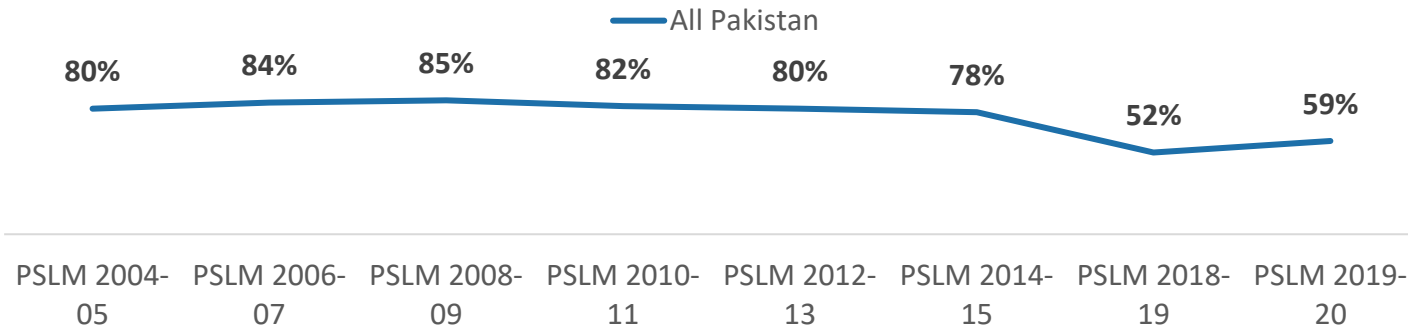

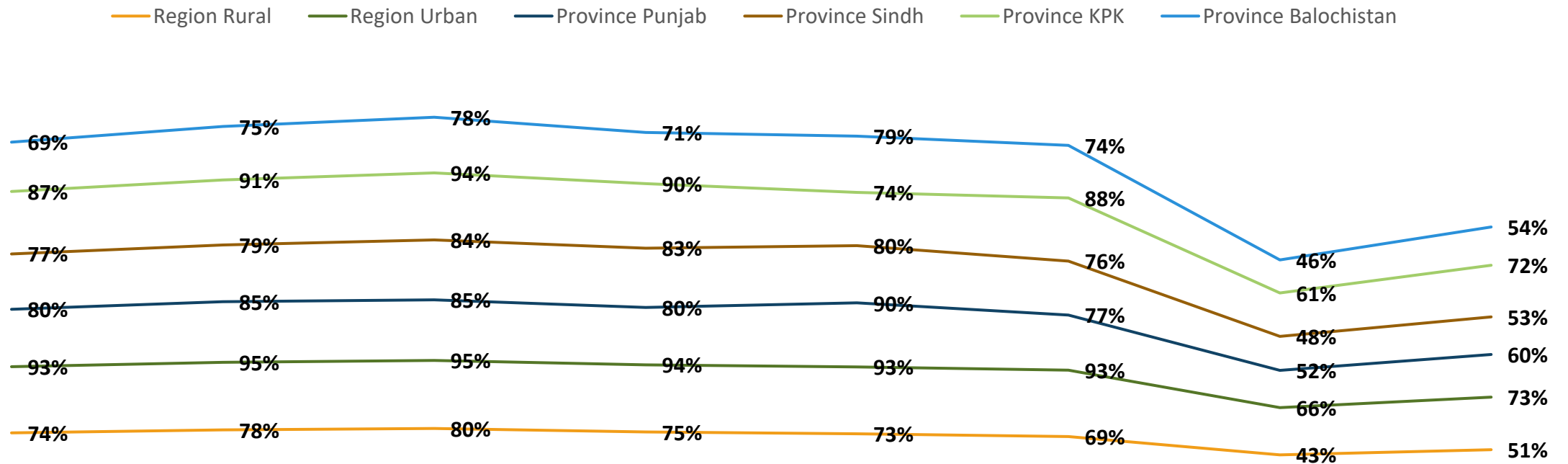

Do you own a Clock

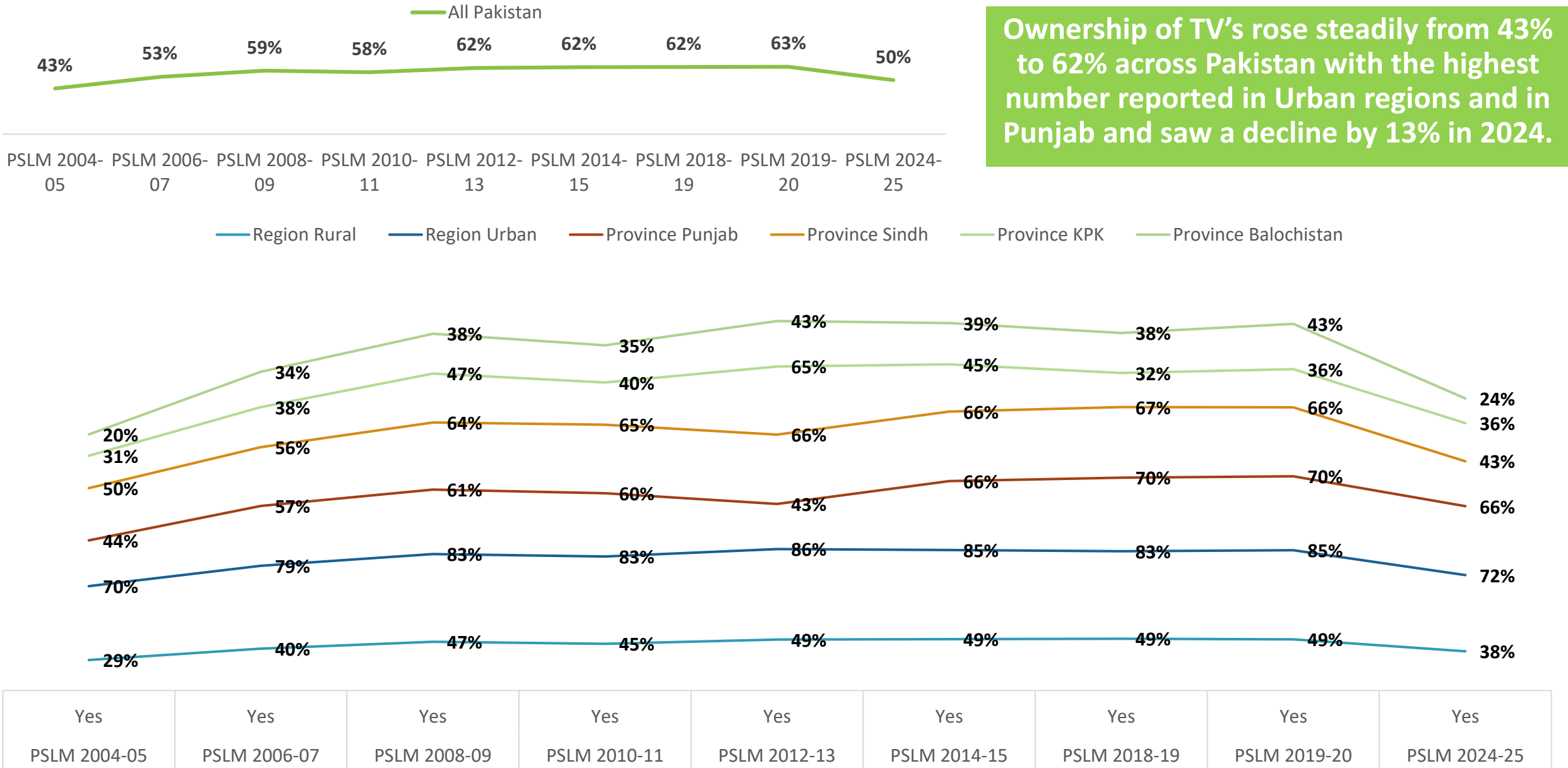

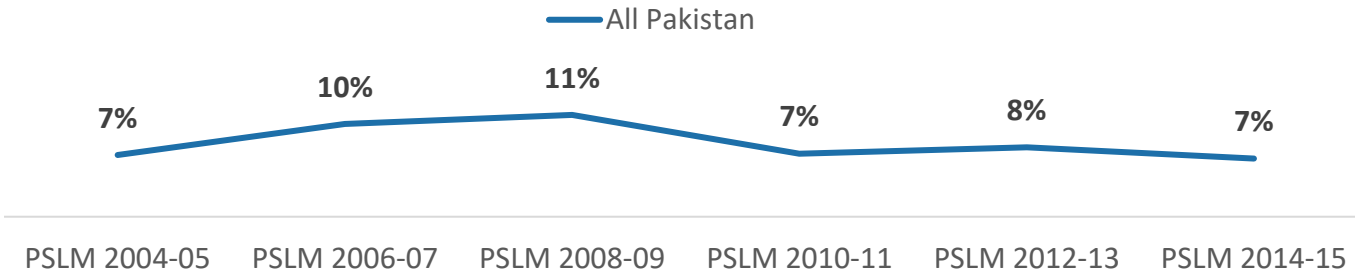

Do you own a TV (LCD or LED)?

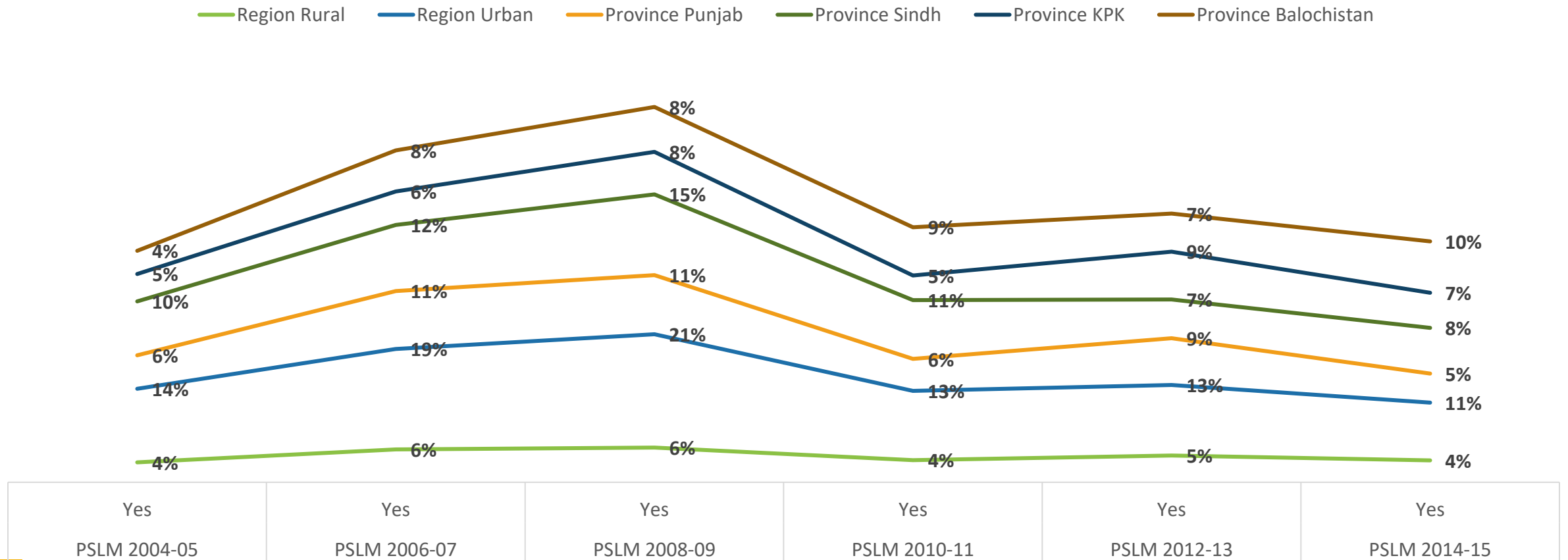

Do you have a VCR,VCP or a VCD Player?

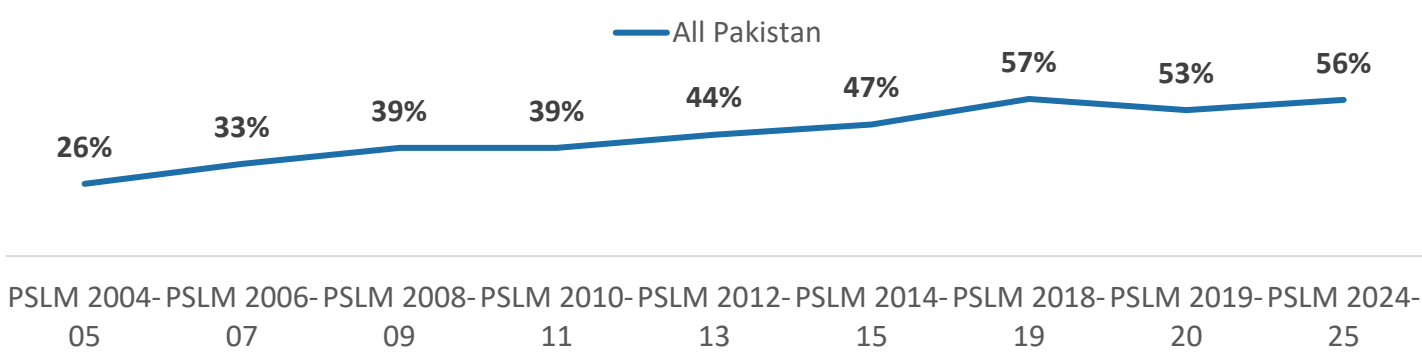


The ownership of VRs and VCD players rose till 2008 and then declined in 2015. Balochistan had the highest number of VCR players in 2014 at 10%.

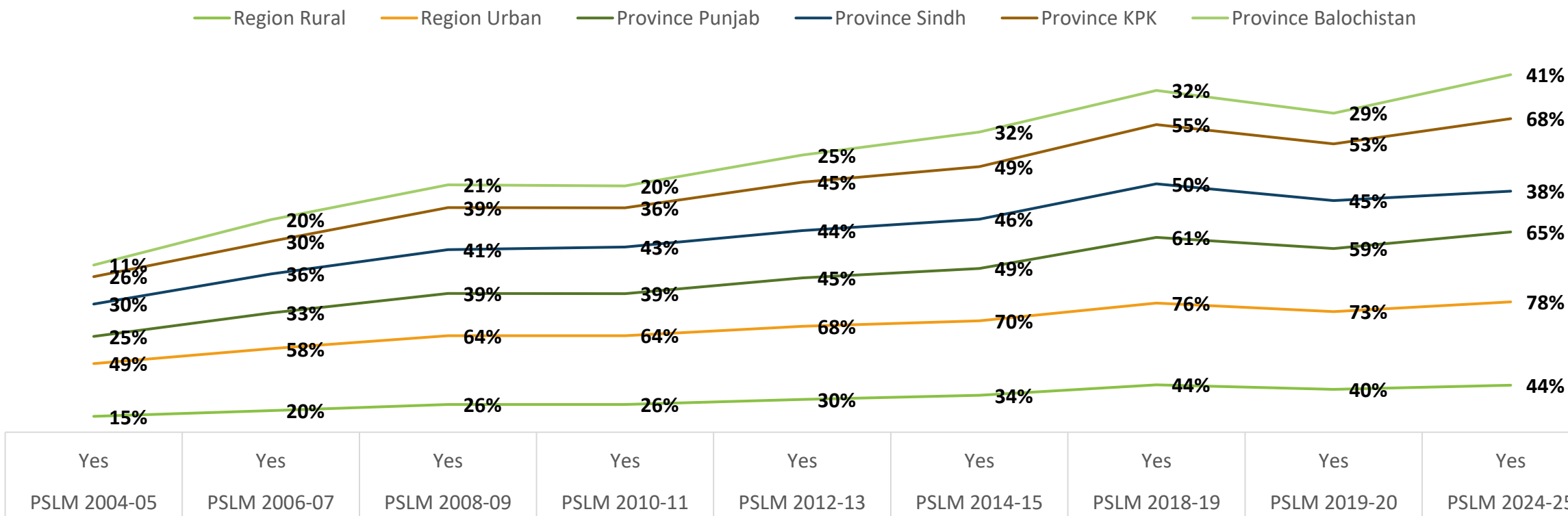

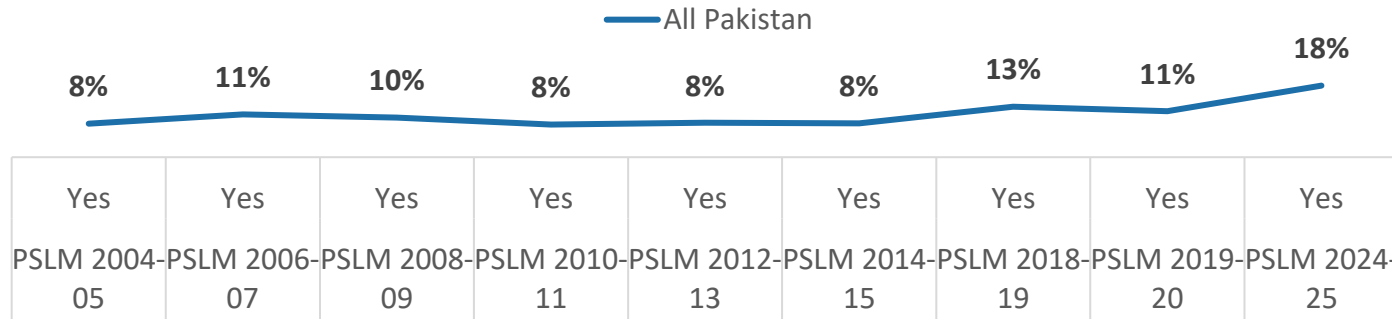
Do you have a refrigerator or freezer?



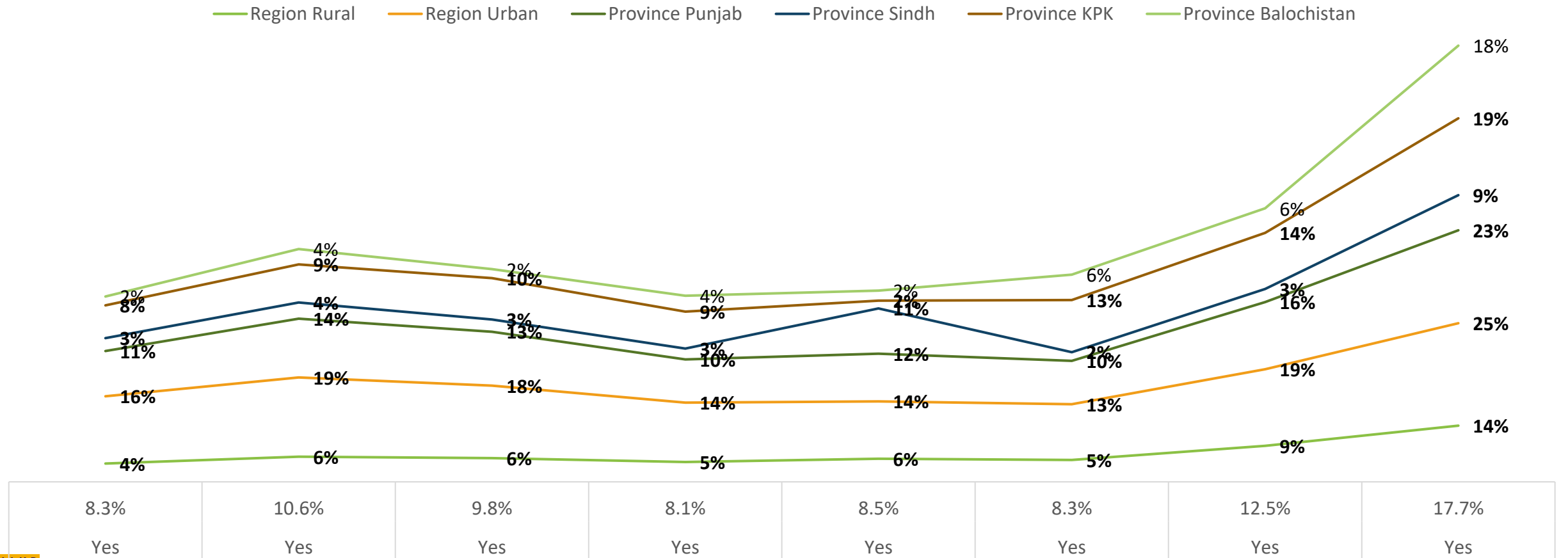
The number of freezers and refrigerators rose from 26% to 57% across Pakistan. The highest numbers were reported in Punjab and Urban regions at 61% and 76% respectively.



Do you have an air cooler?

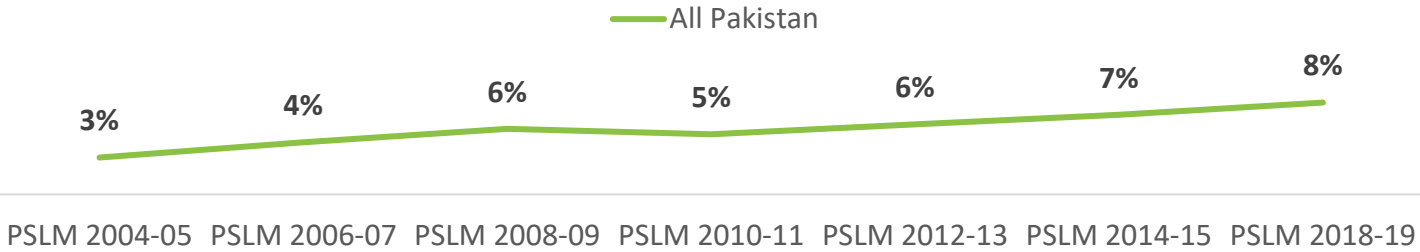


Air coolers rose in number till 2007 then experienced a drop and rose again by 10% in 2024 across Pakistan. While the lowest number of air coolers was found in Sindh at 3% the highest was found in Punjab at 16%.

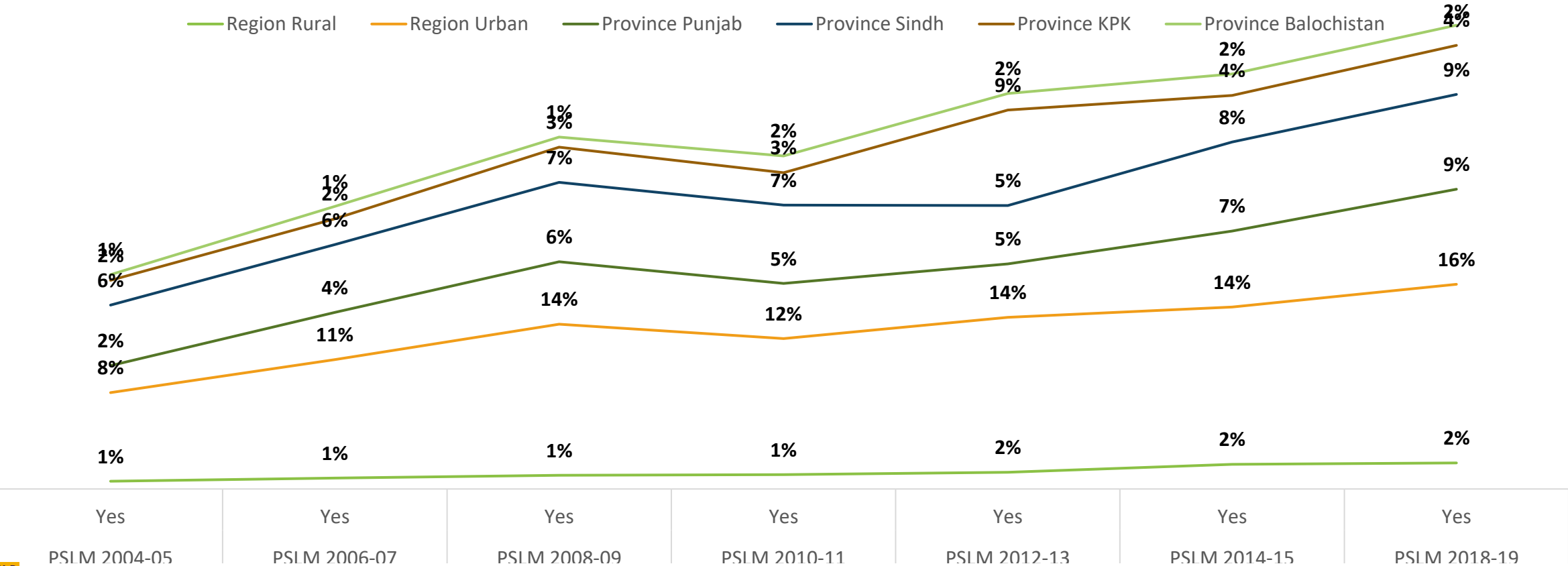

Do you have an air conditioner?

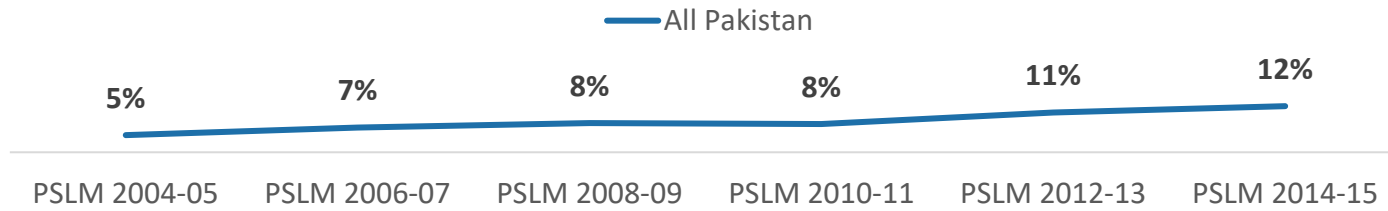

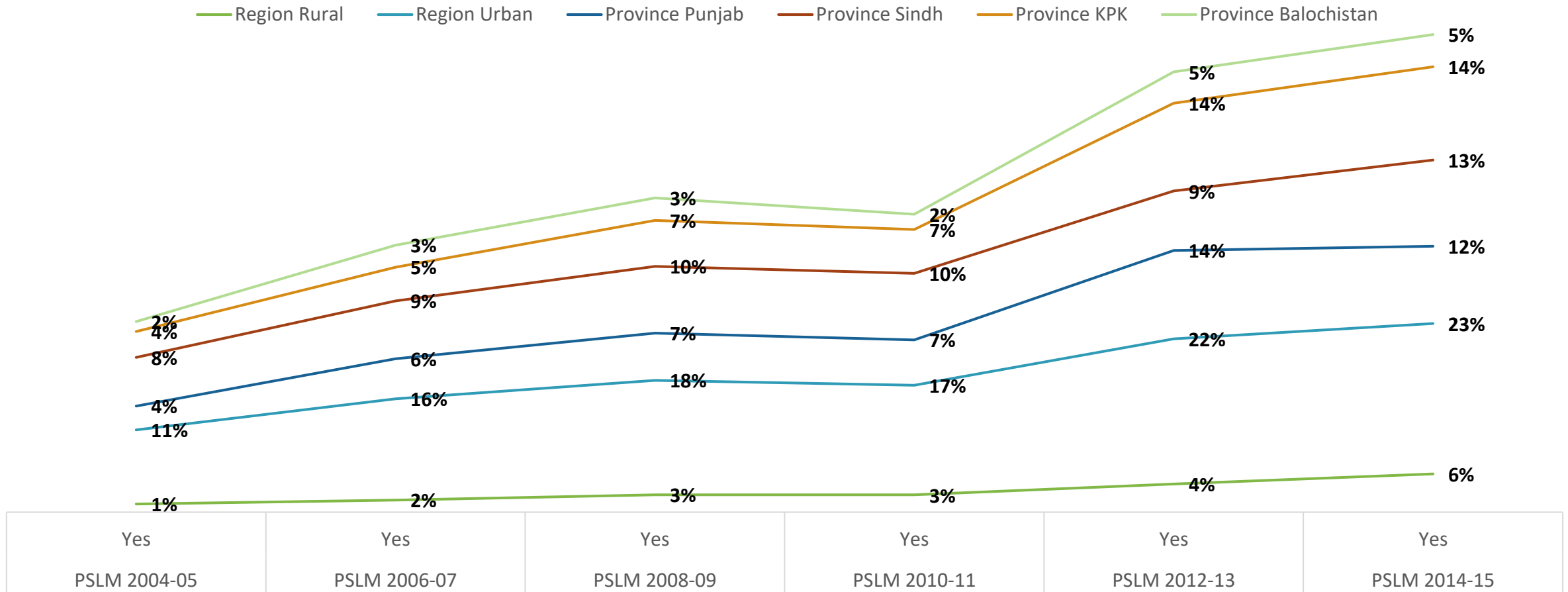

Do you have a computer, laptop or a tablet?

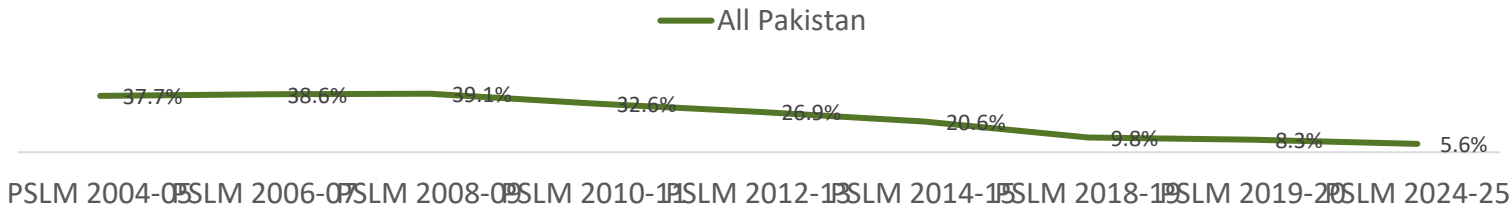

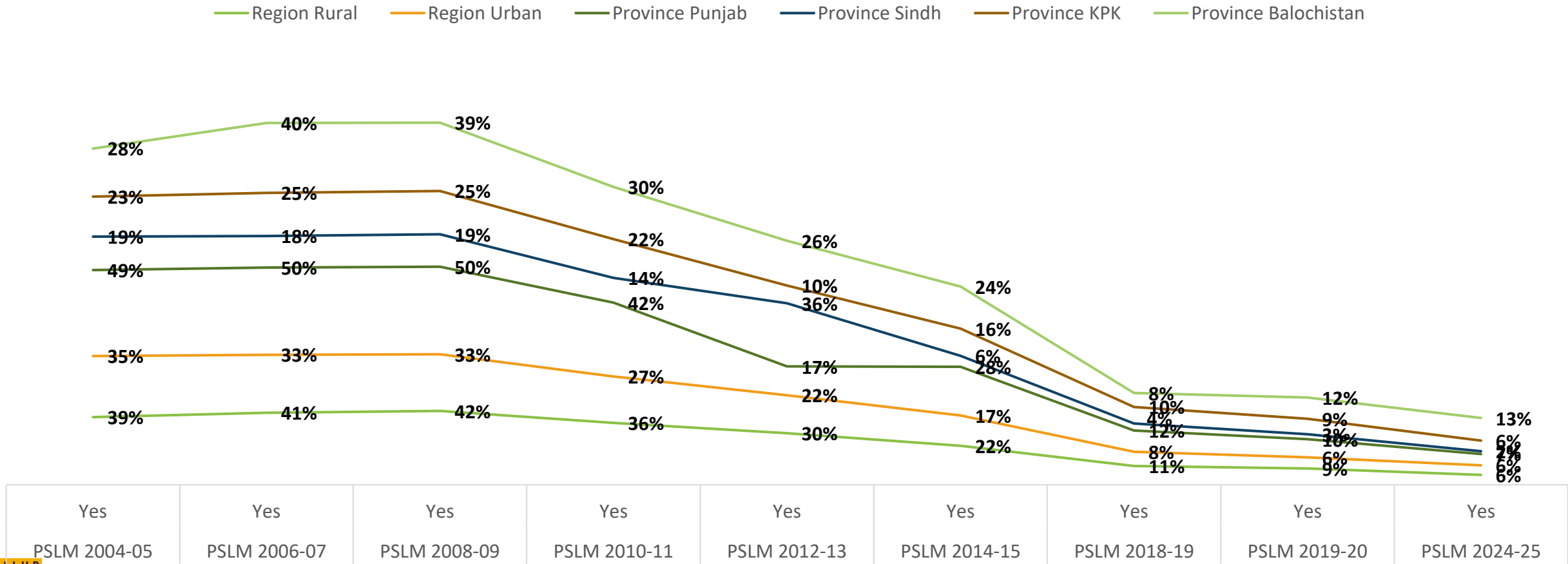

Do you have a Bicycle?



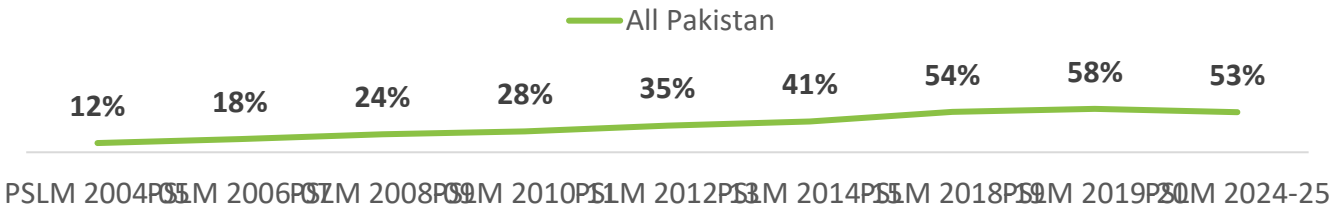
Bicycle ownership fell from 38% to 5.6% across Pakistan with steep declines occurring after 2008. A similar trend is apparent in the provinces with Sindh having the lowest number of bicycles at 2%.

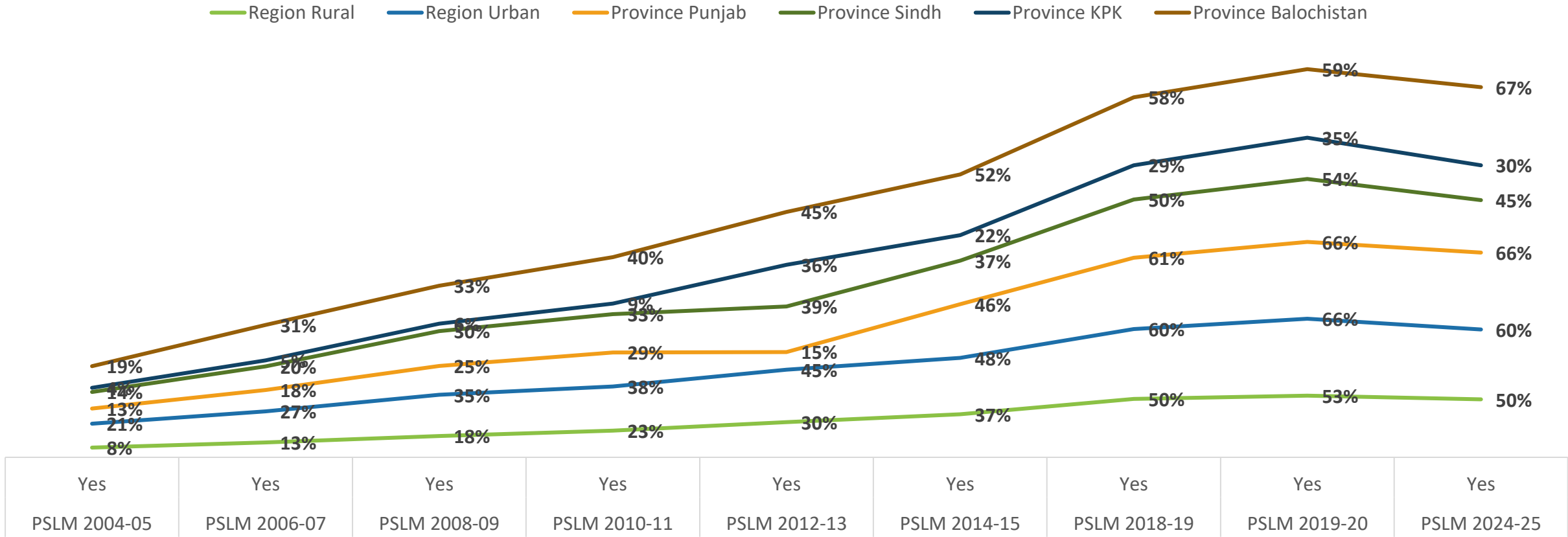

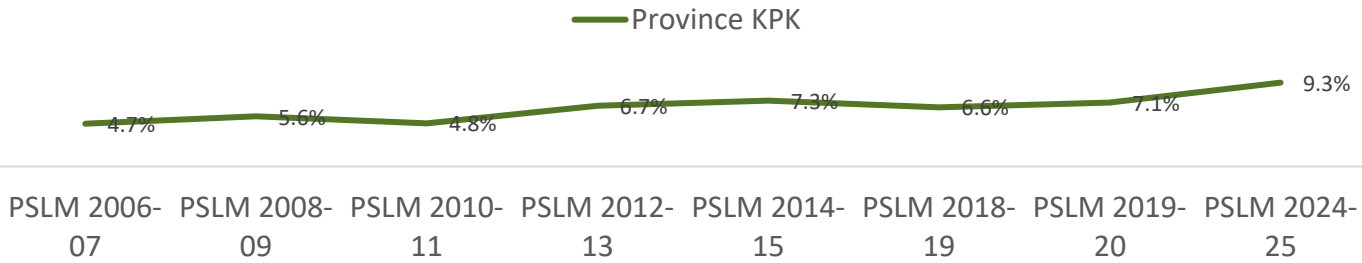
Do you have a motorcycle



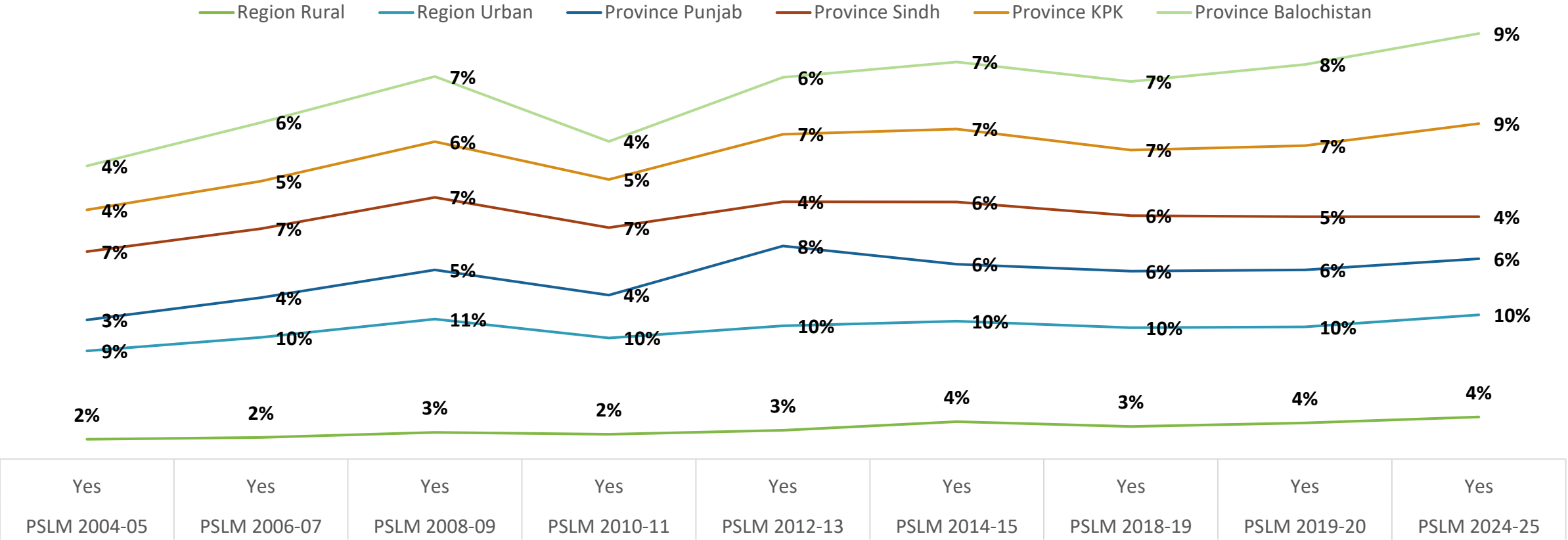
Motorcycle ownership rose from 12% to 58% across Pakistan with a sharp increase seen after 2006 and then declined by 5% in 2024. KPK has the lowest number of Motorcycles at 29% while the other provinces have numbers between 50% and 66%.



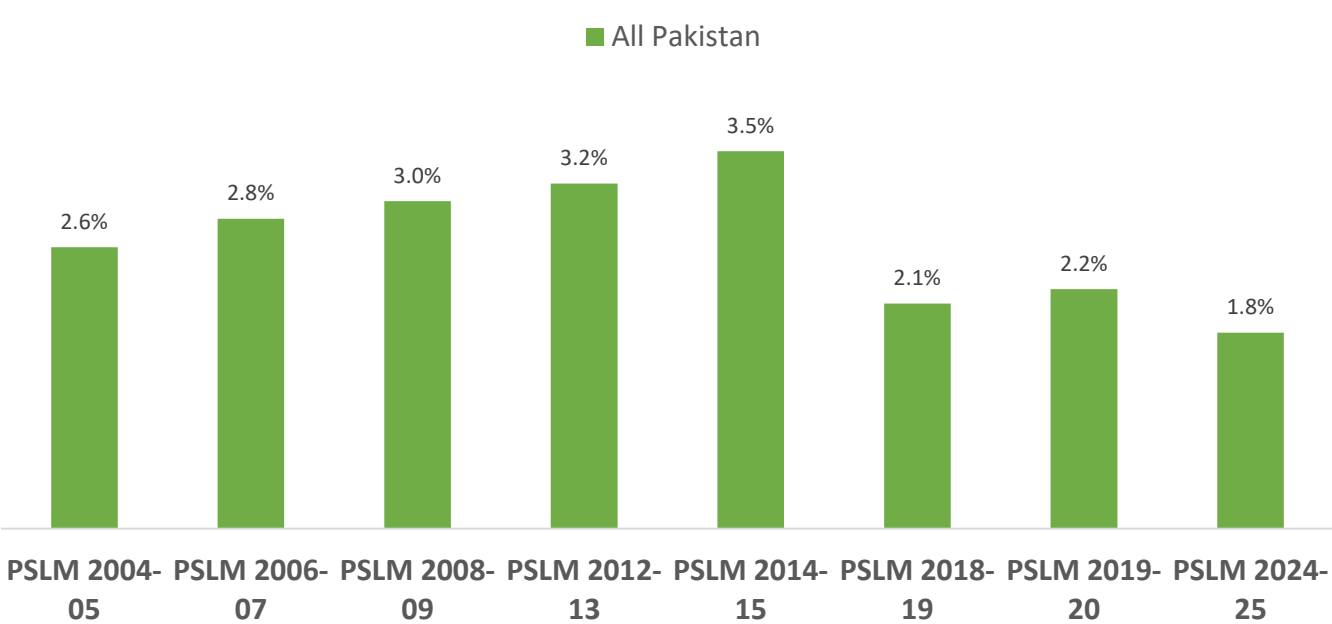
Do you have a car?



Car ownership largely remained constant throughout the years with an overall rise from 4% to 9%. Sindh saw a 2% decline in car ownership while the other provinces experienced a rise.

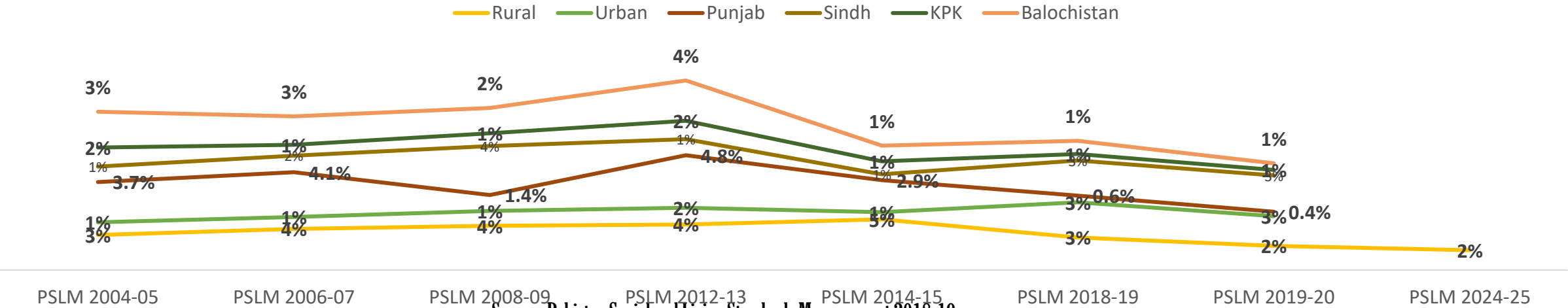


Do you have a tractor truck?



Tractor truck ownership was consistently 3% until 2019 when it dropped to 2% and later in 2024 it dropped below 2%. KPK has the lowest ownership of tractor trucks at only 1.1%.

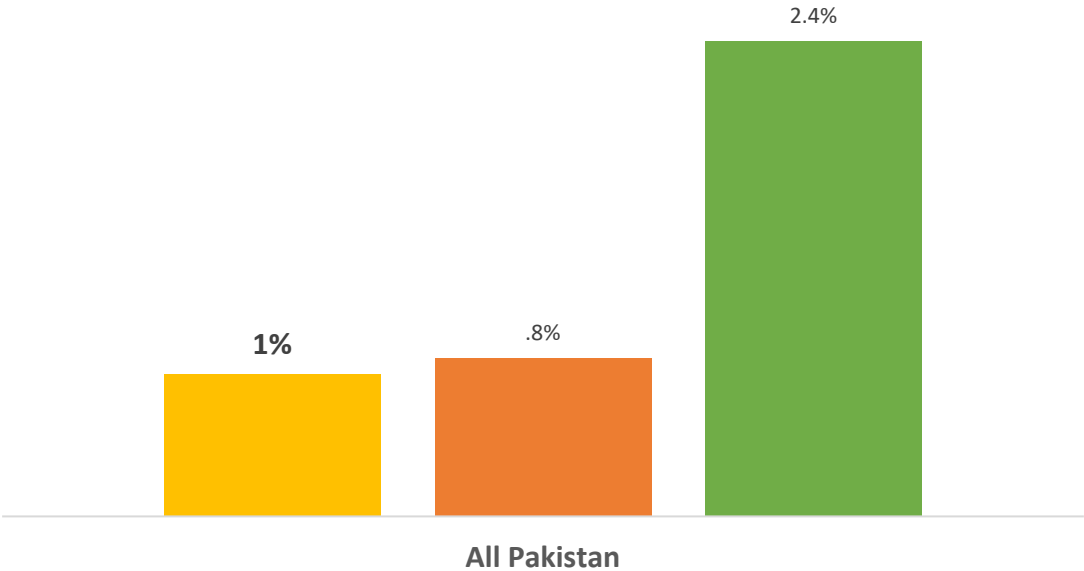

Do you have a VAN/TRUCK/BUS?

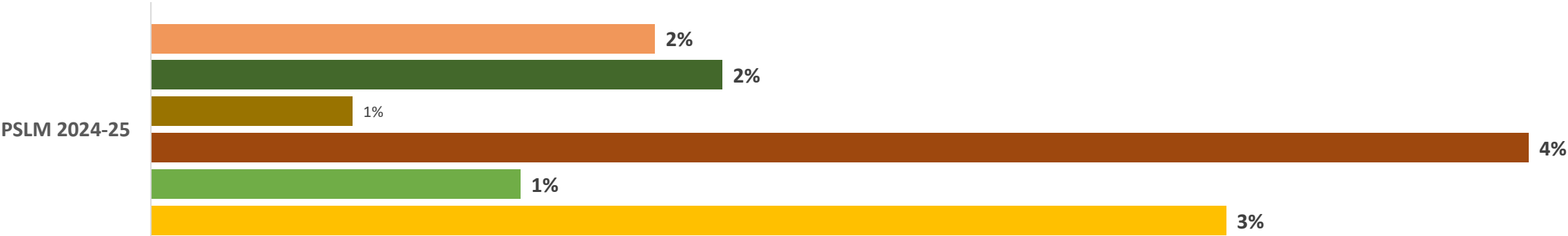

In 2024, around 2% of the population owned a van, truck or bus. Punjab had the highest ownership at 4% while Sindh had the lowest.

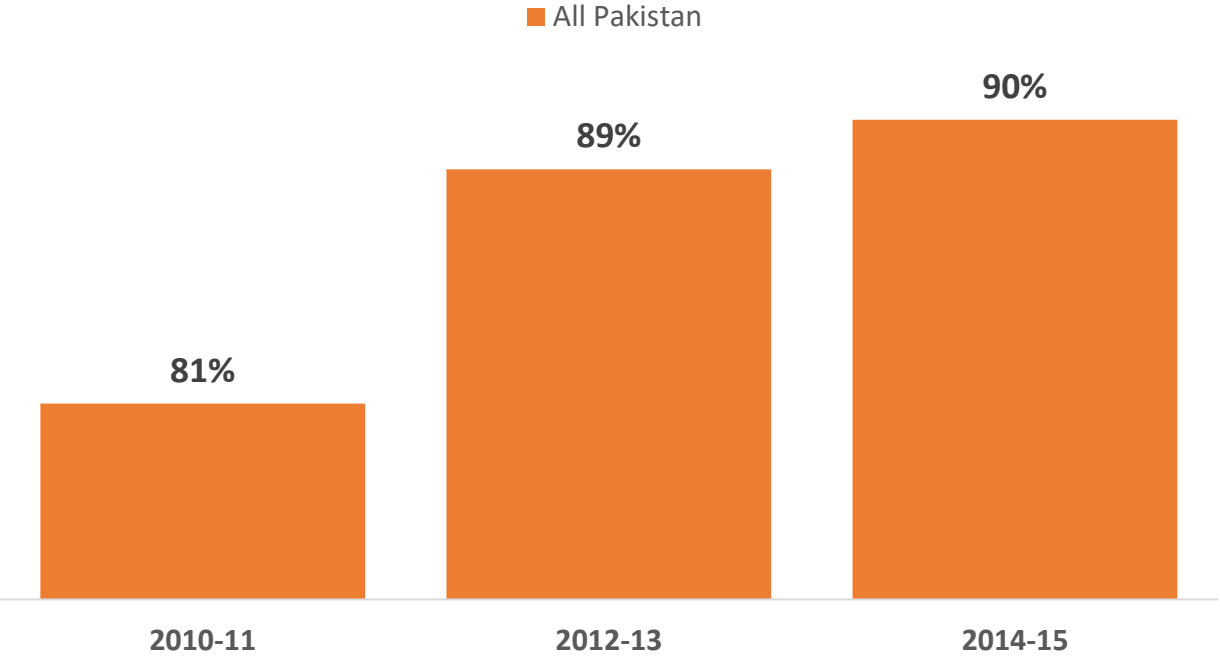

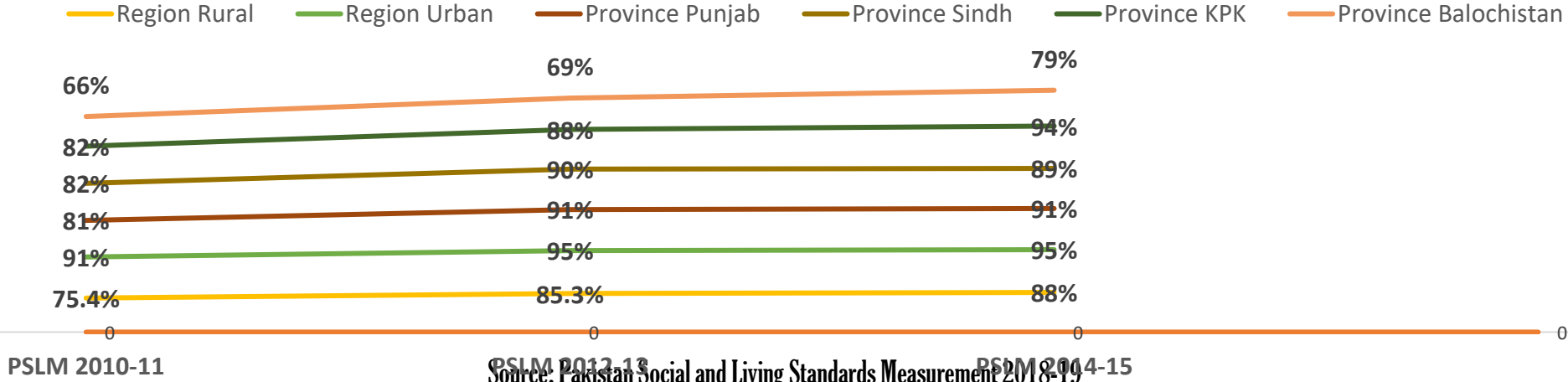

Do you have mobile phone / landline?



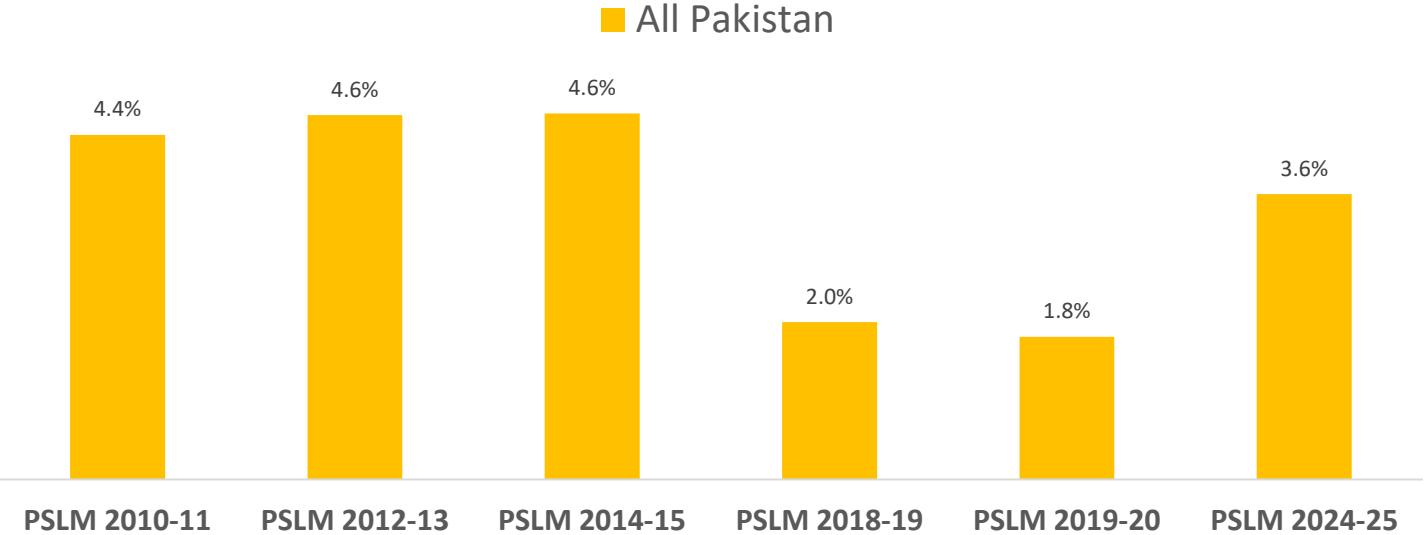

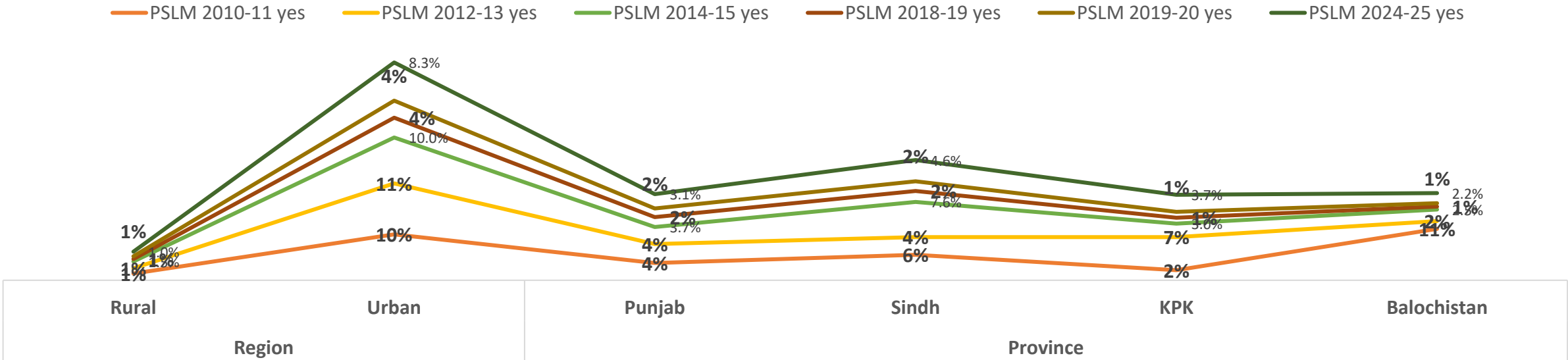

Do you have a cooking range?



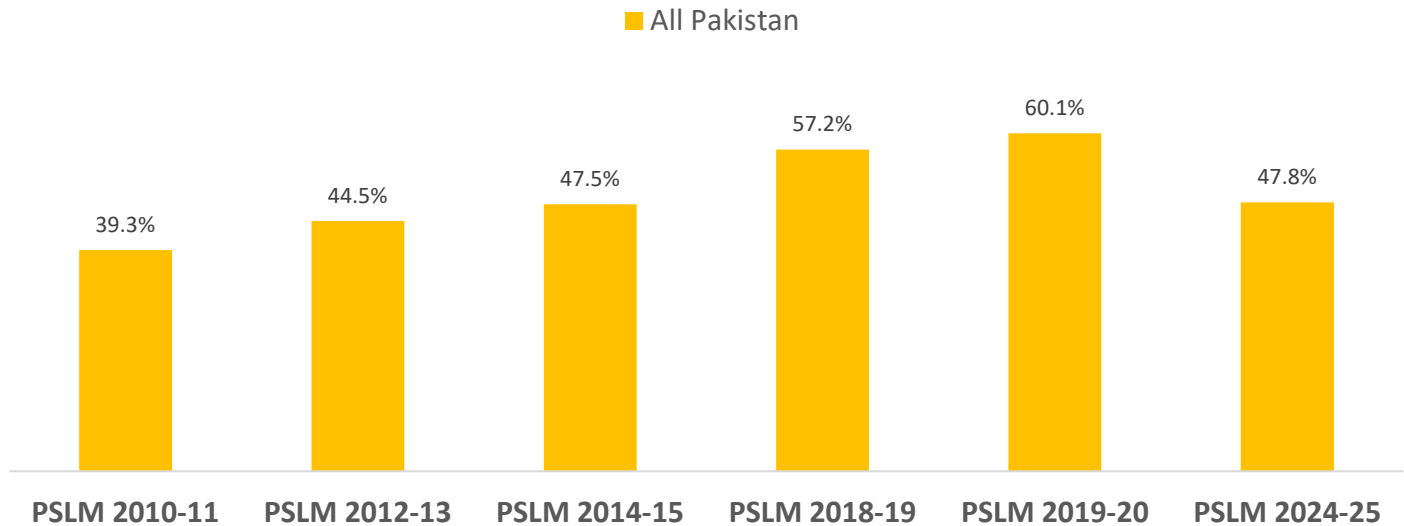

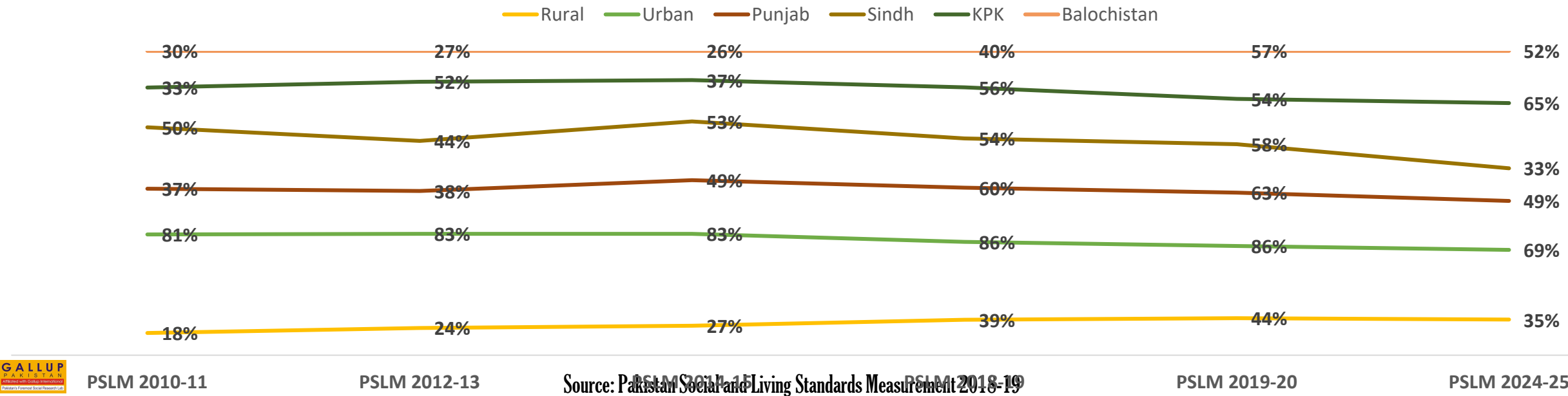

Do you have a stove?

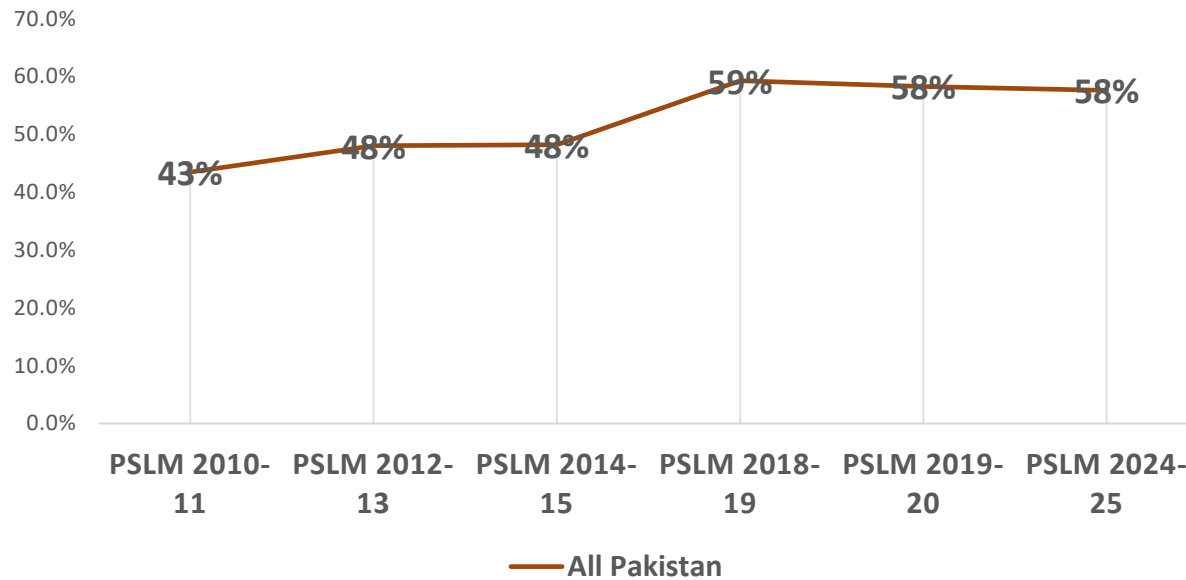

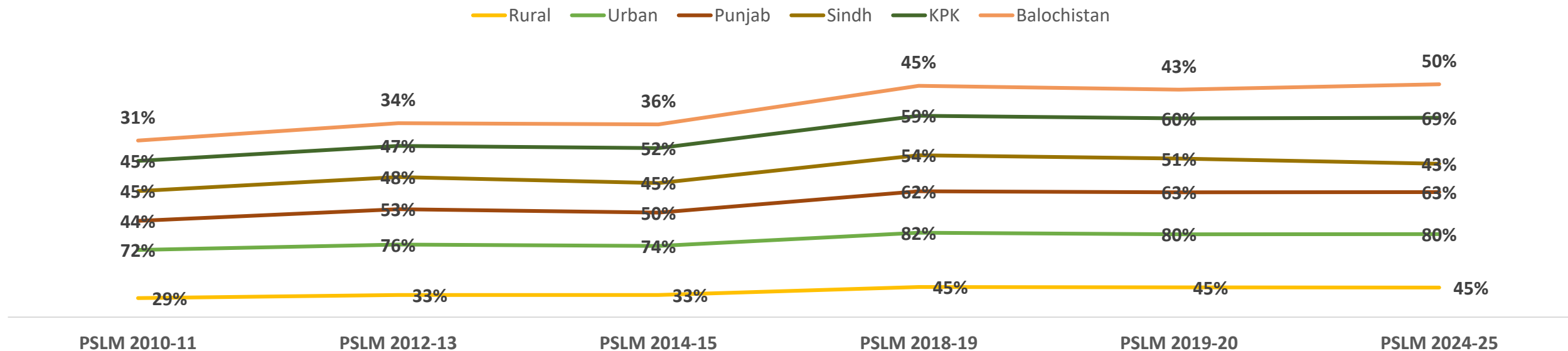


Do you have a washing machine?



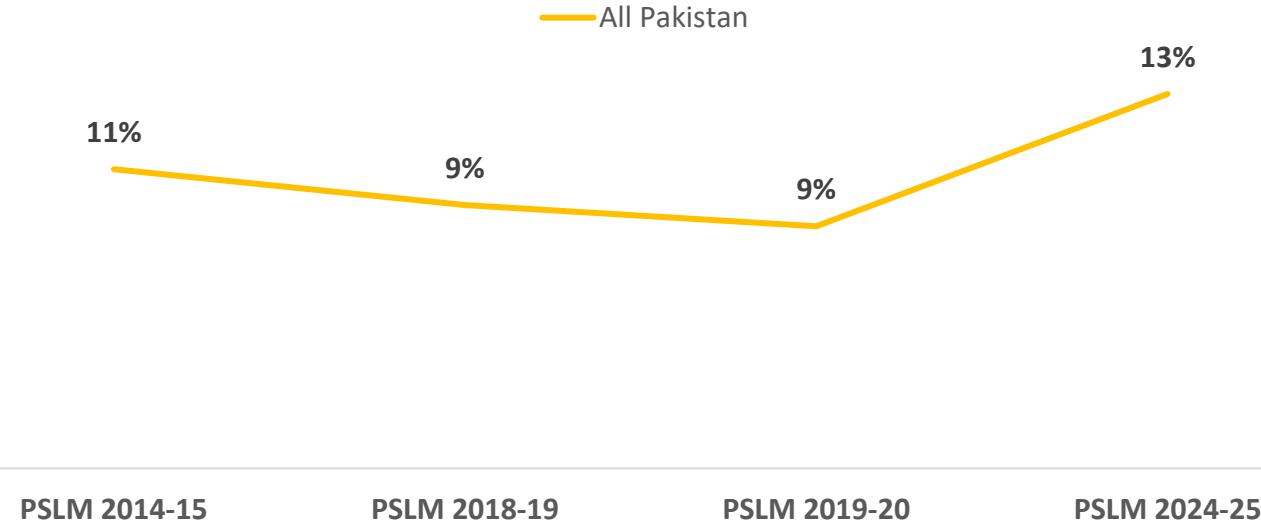

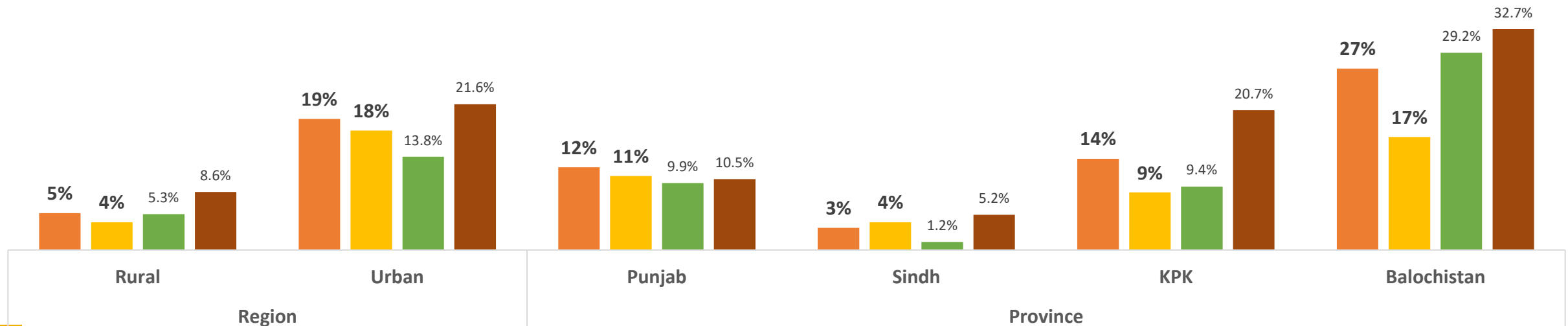
Do you have a heater?

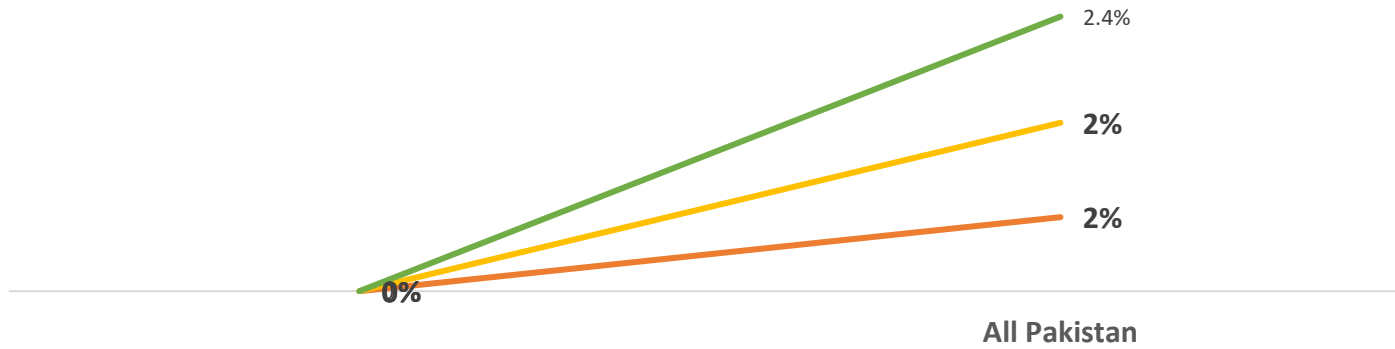

Do you have a Chinch Rickshaw?

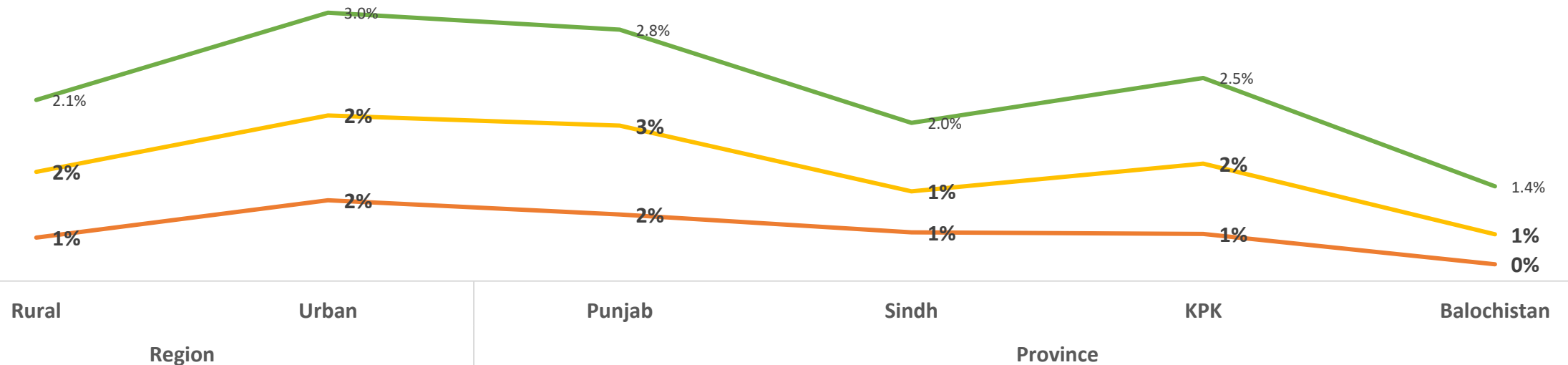

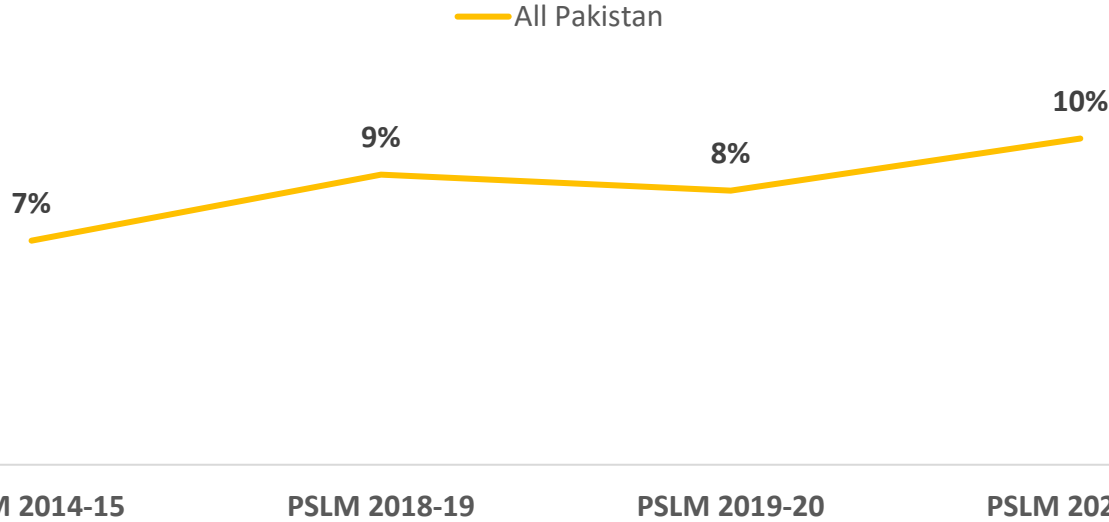

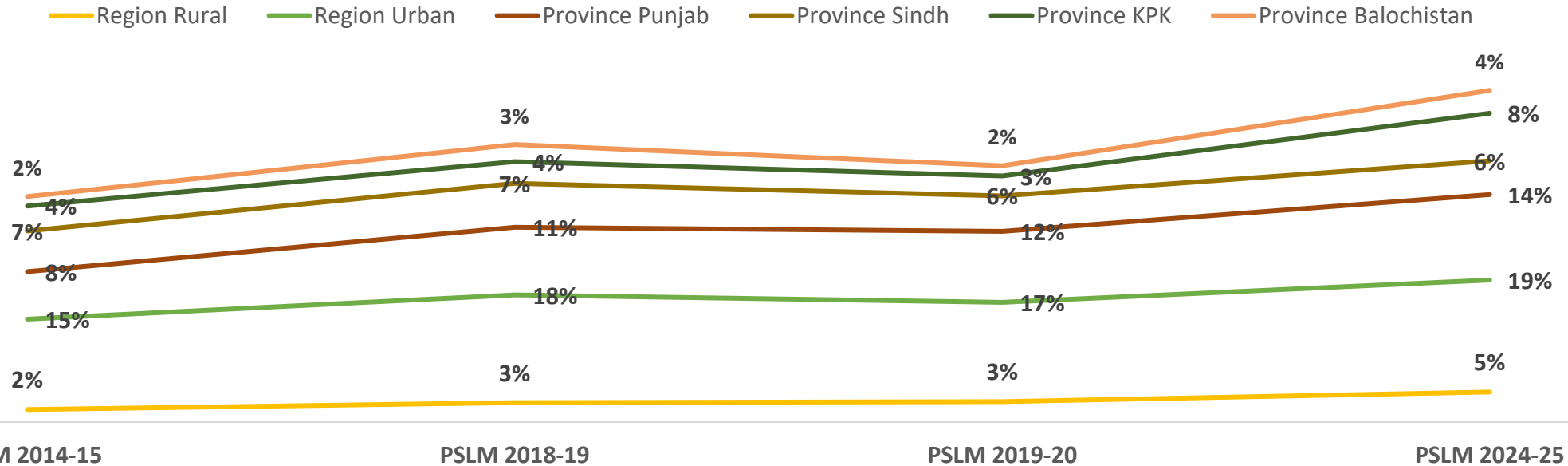

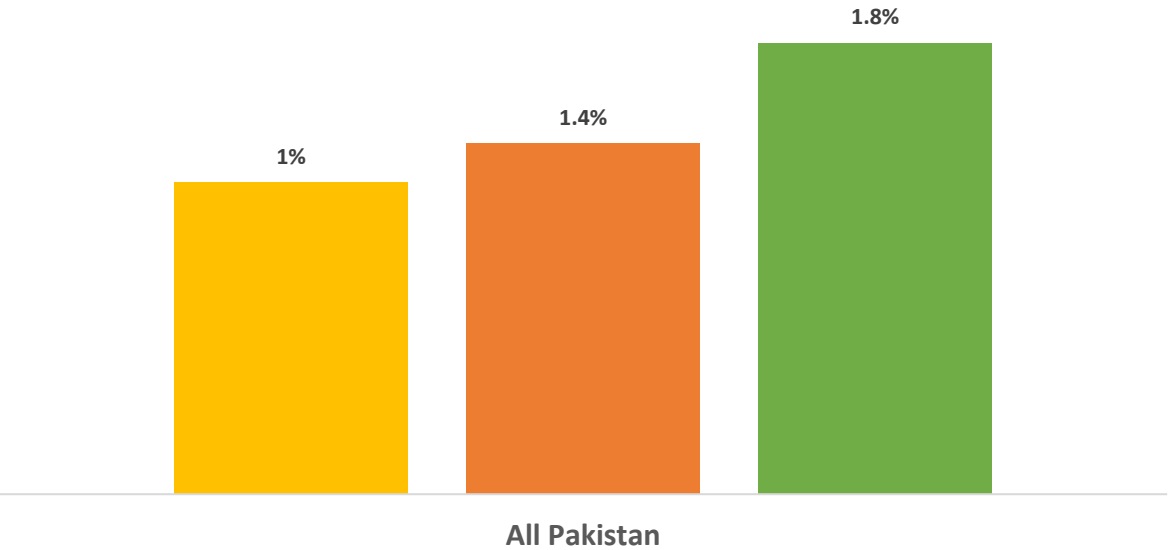

Do you have a water filter?

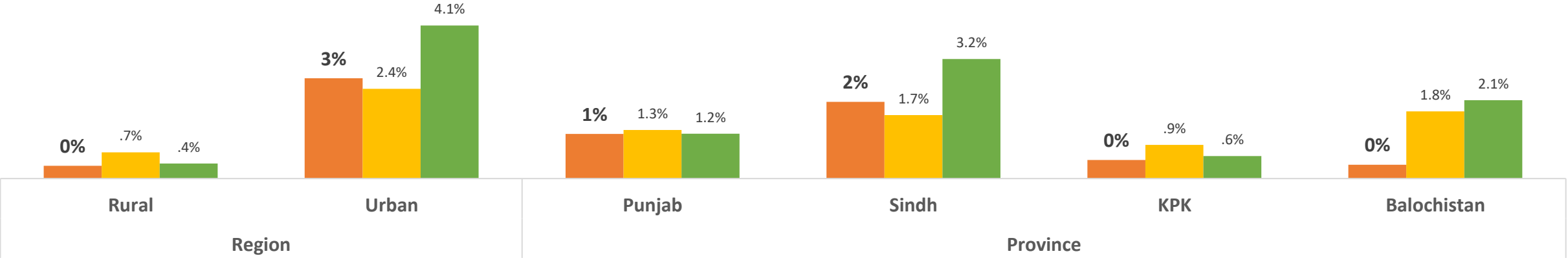

The number of water filters in Pakistan was 1% in 2018-19 and almost 2% in 2024-25. Sindh had the highest numbers at 3.

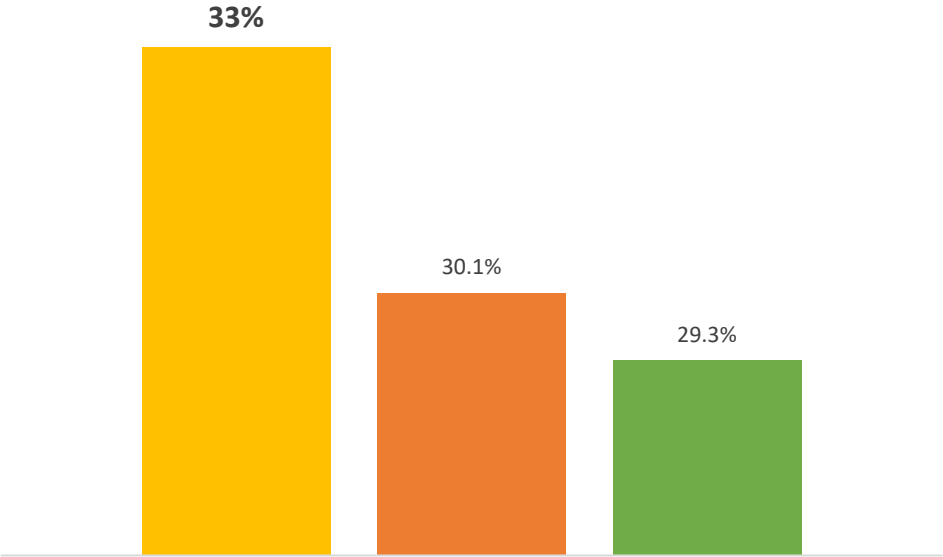

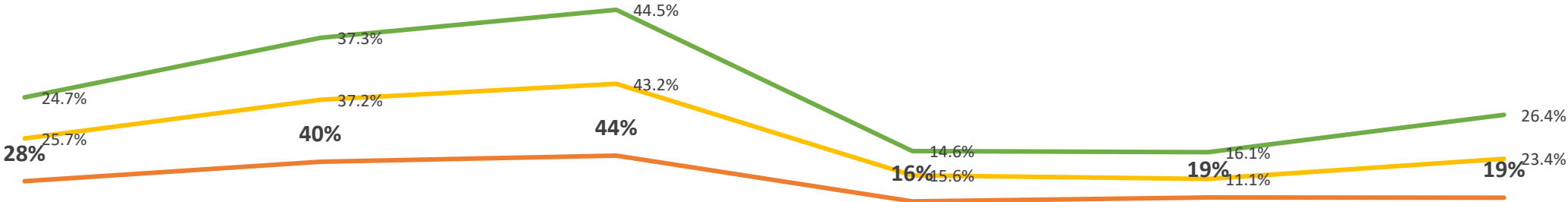

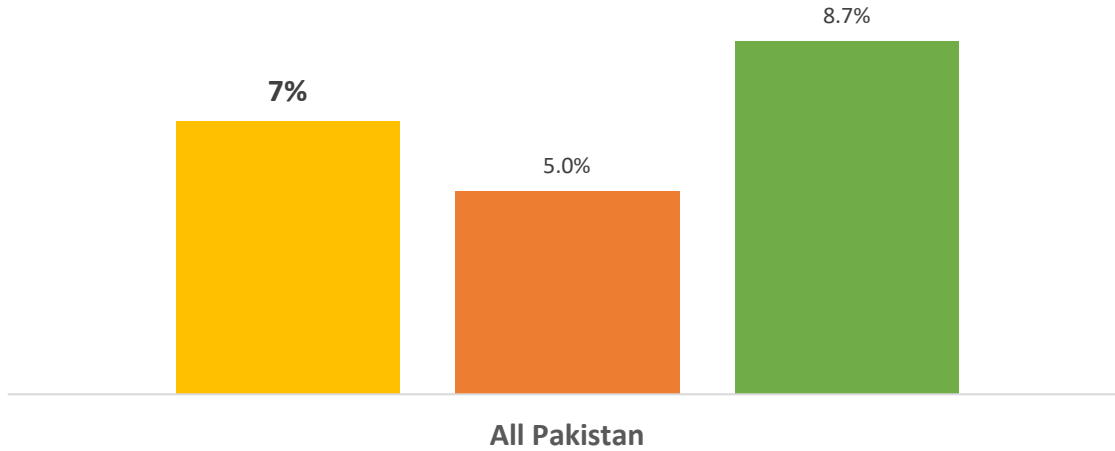

Do you have a turbine?

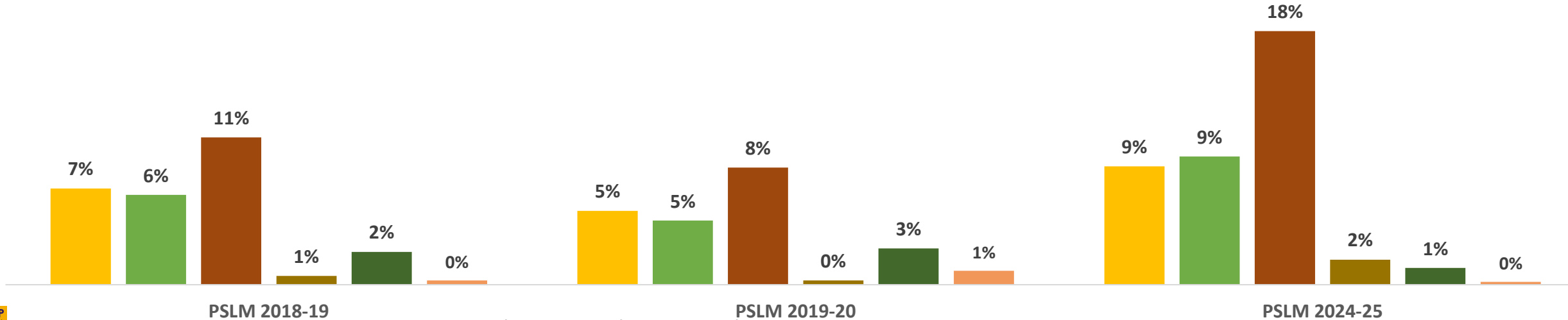

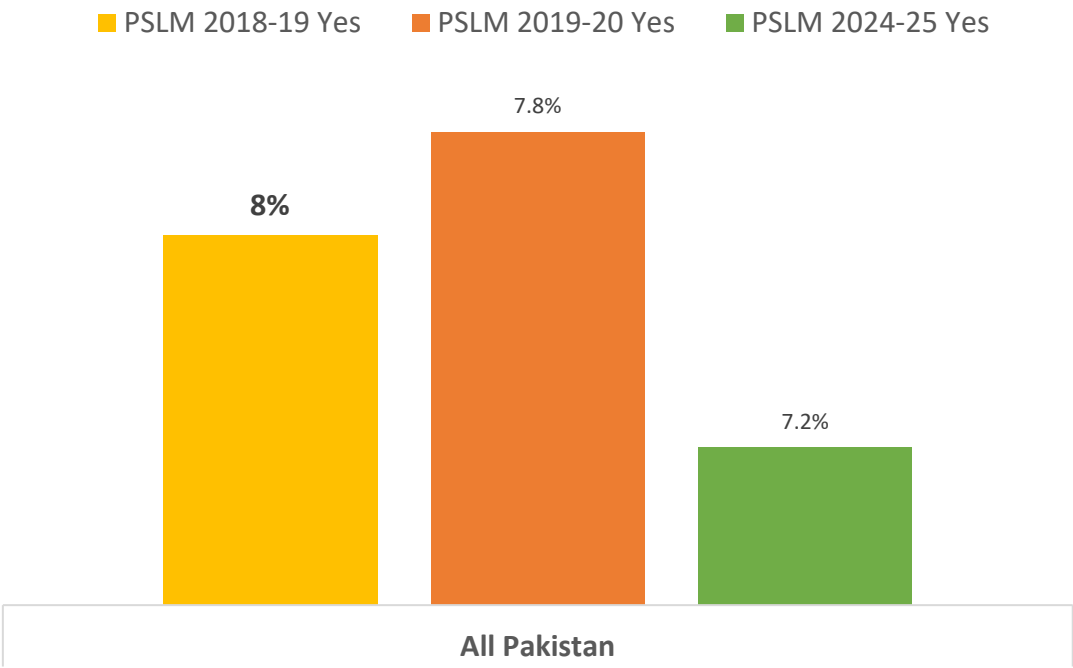

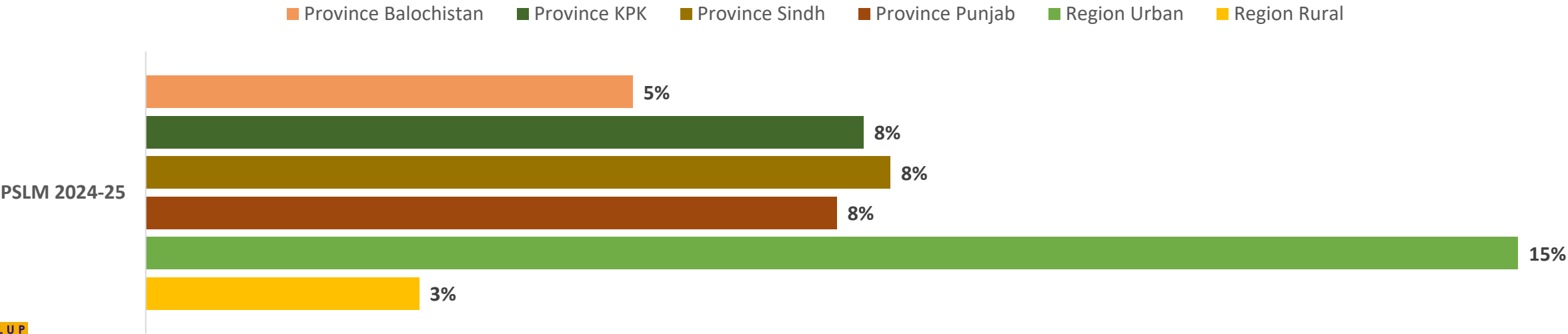

The number of geezers in Pakistan in 2024-25 were at 7%. KPK had the highest number at 15.

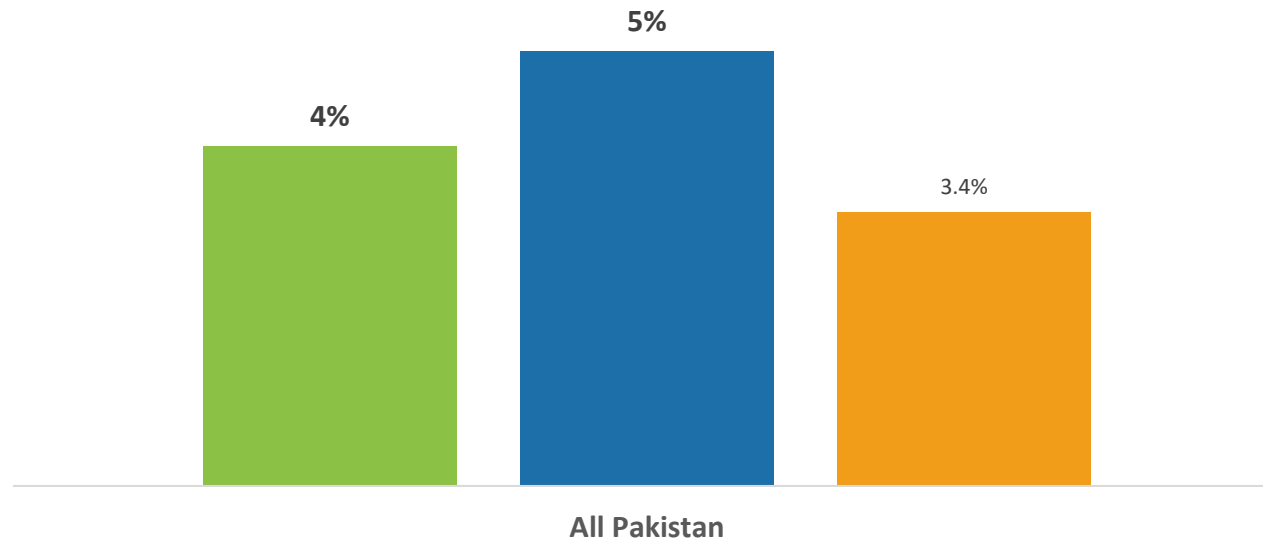

Do you have an animal cart?

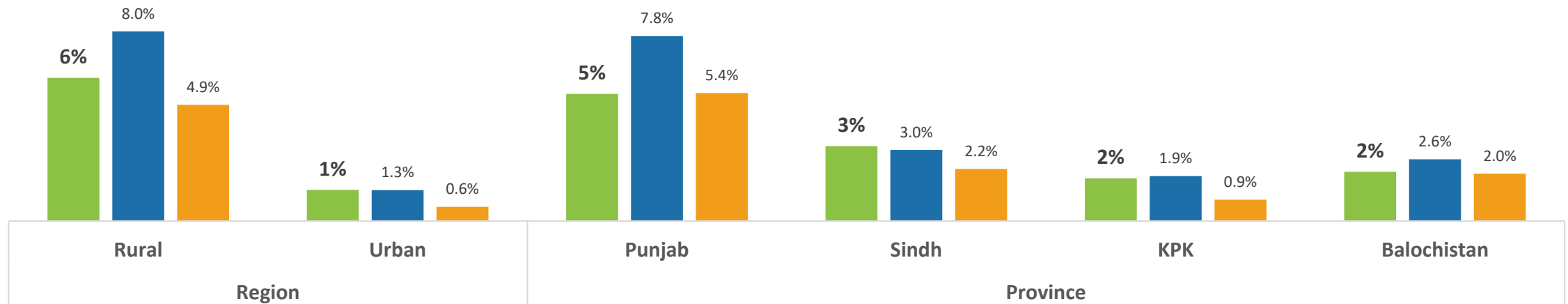

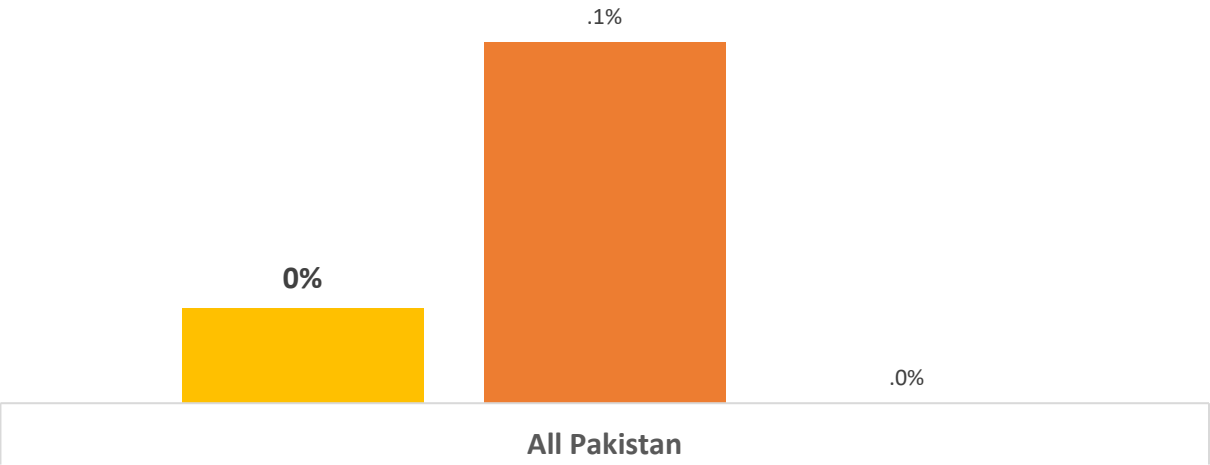

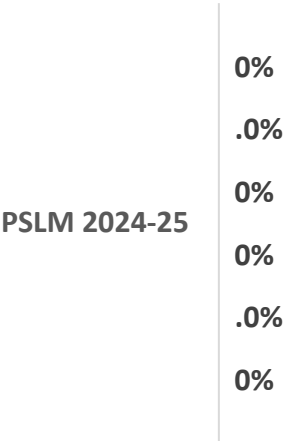

The number of boats in Pakistan in 2024-25 totaled at 0%. Sindh had the highest at 1% while other provinces remained at 0%.

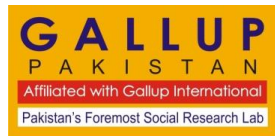
