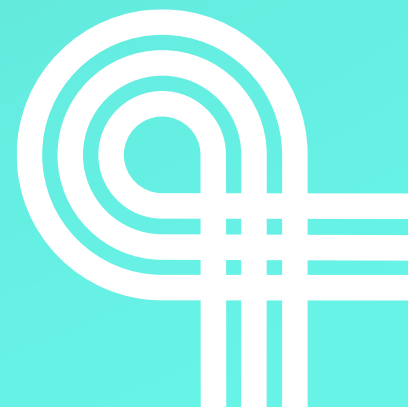

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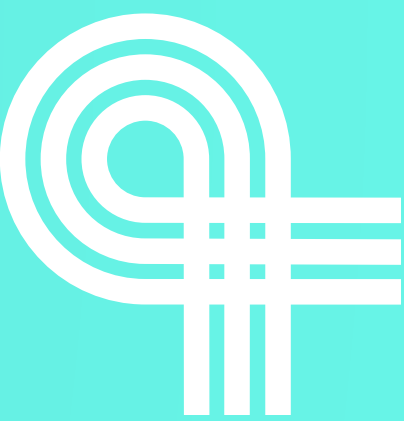

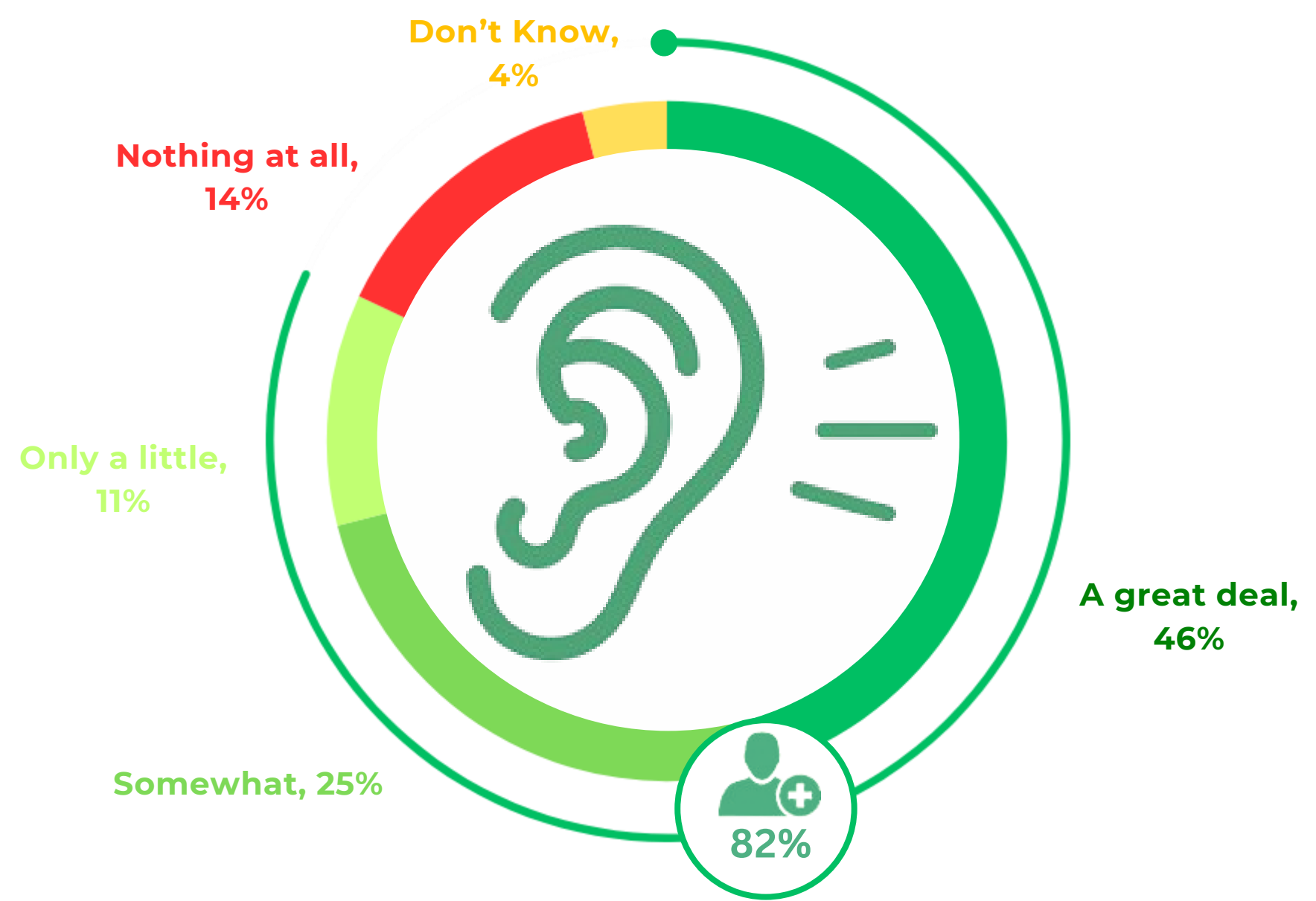

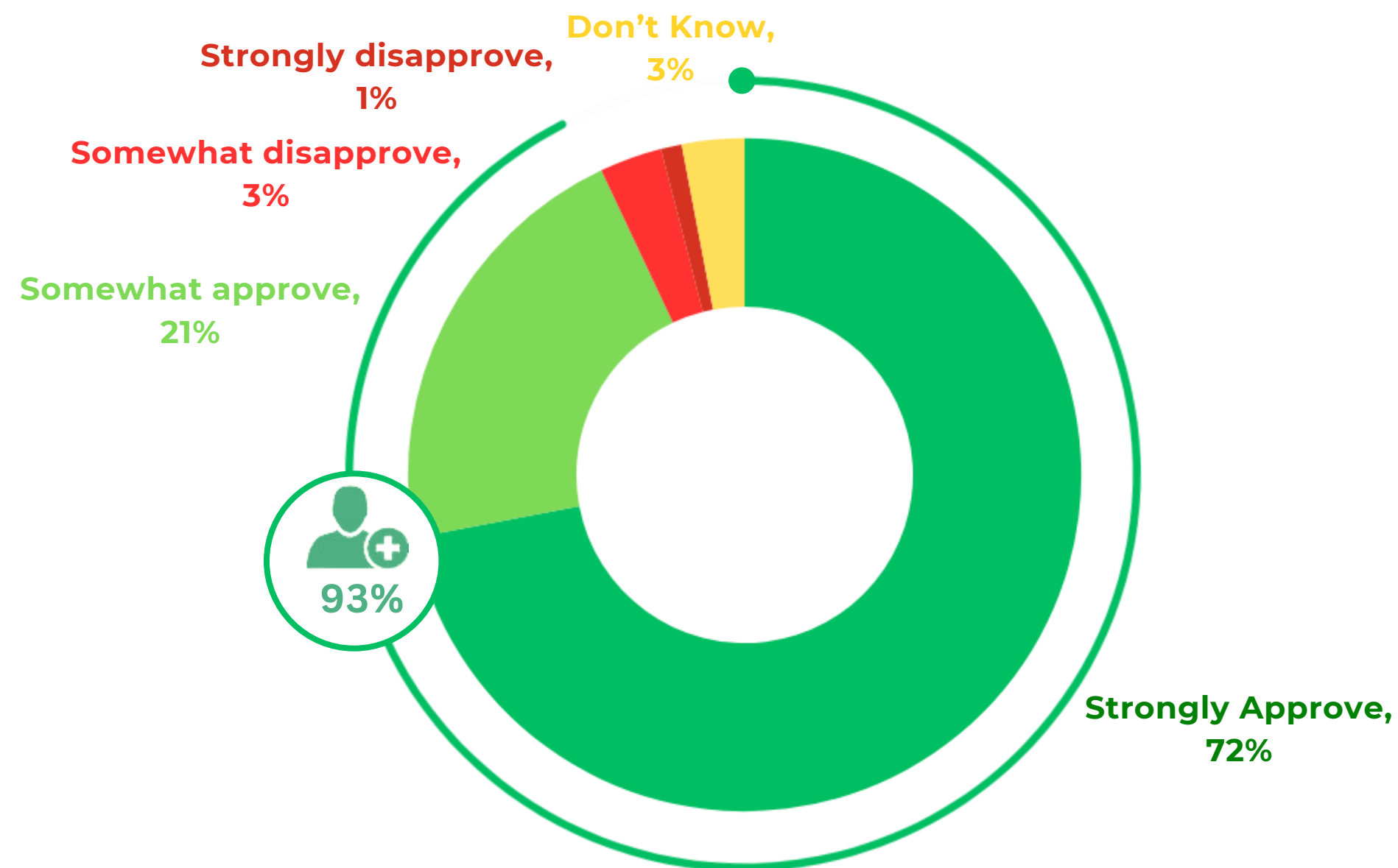

Do you approve or disapprove of Pakistan playing a role in mediating a ceasefire between the United States/Israel and Iran?

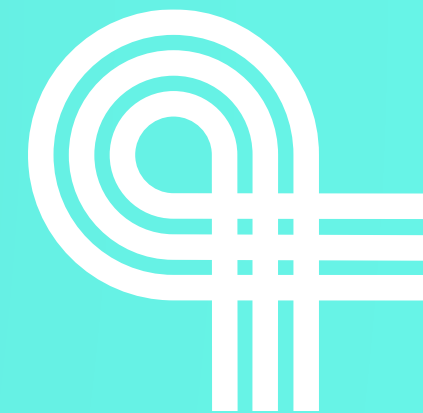


93% **Strongly + Somewhat** approve of Pakistan playing a role in mediating a ceasefire

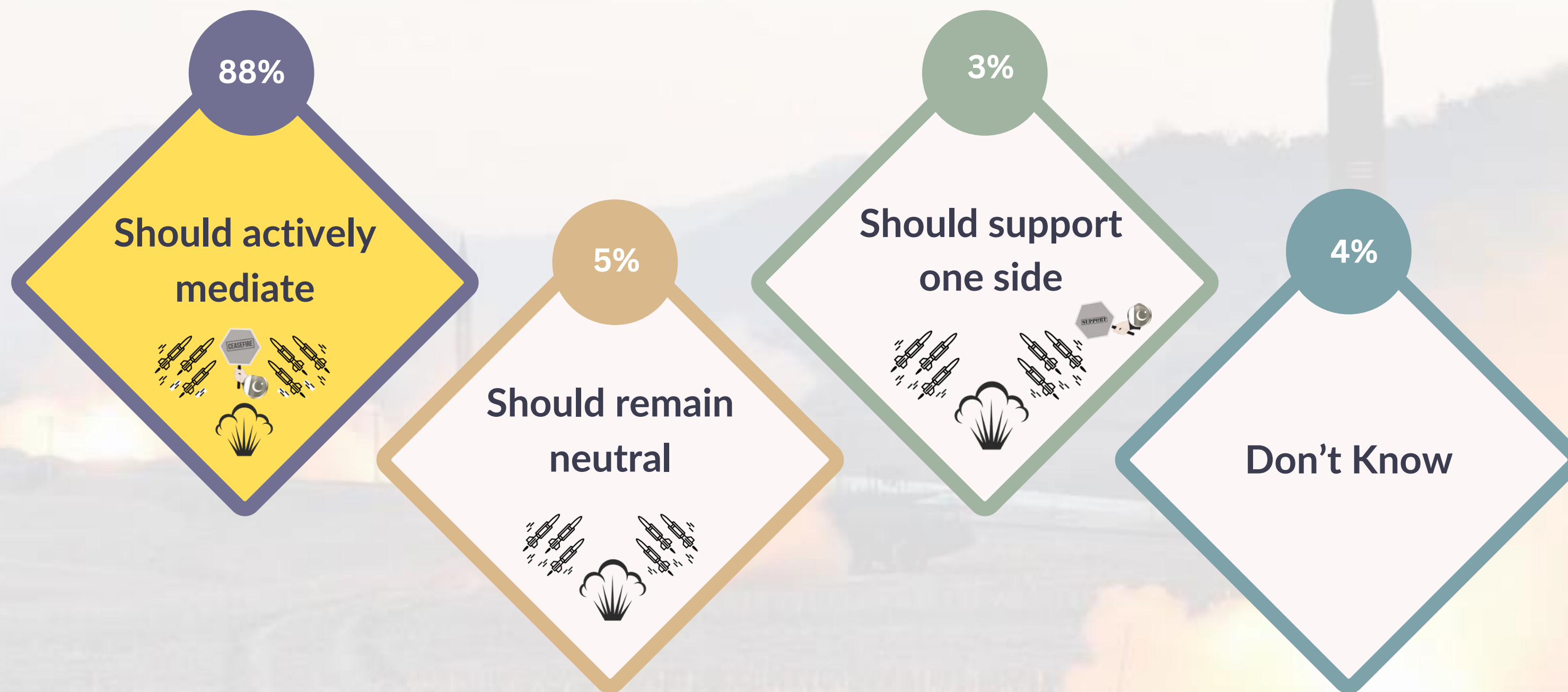

Majority of Pakistanis (88%) Support Active Involvement in International Conflicts.



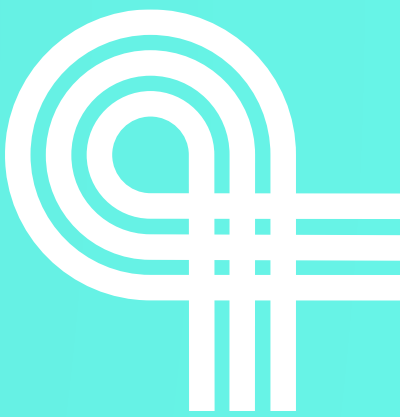
In your opinion, should Pakistan be involved in international conflicts like this, or should it stay neutral?



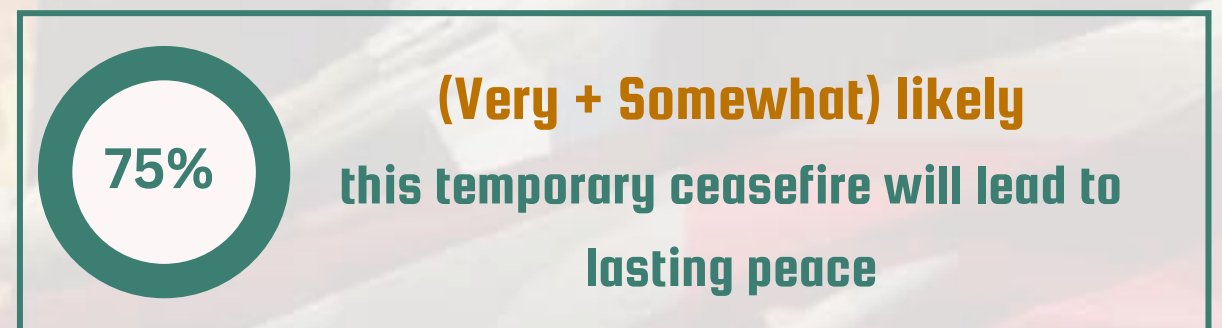
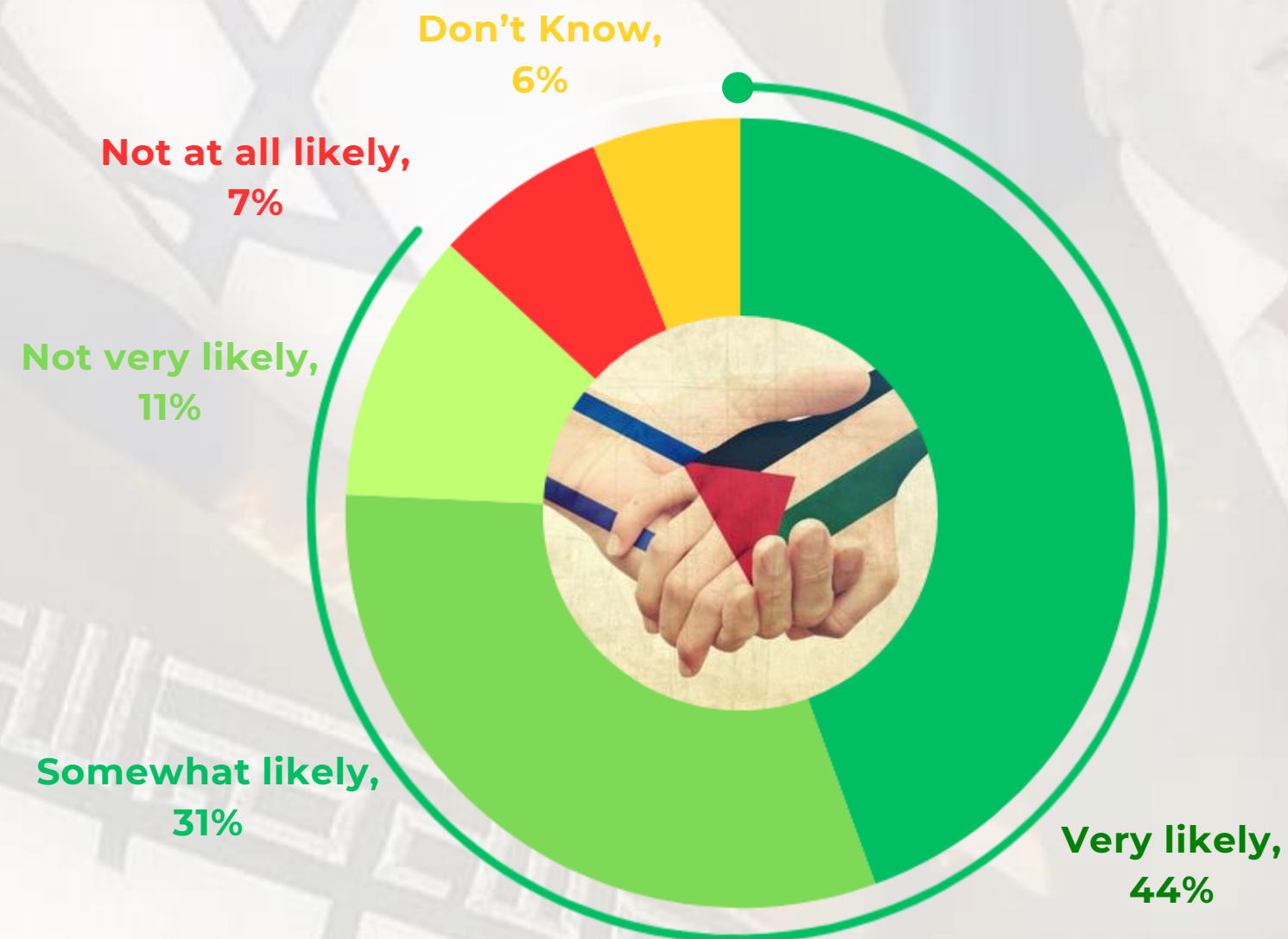

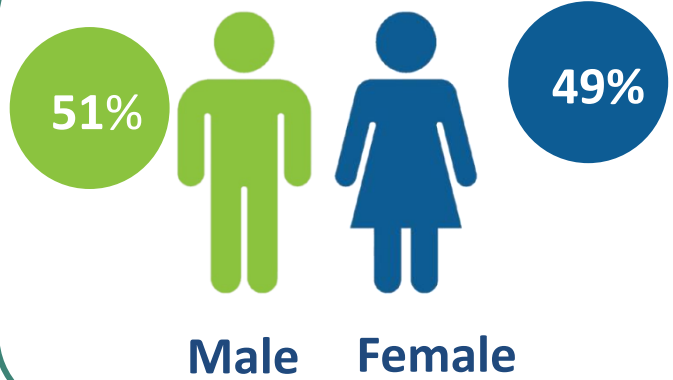

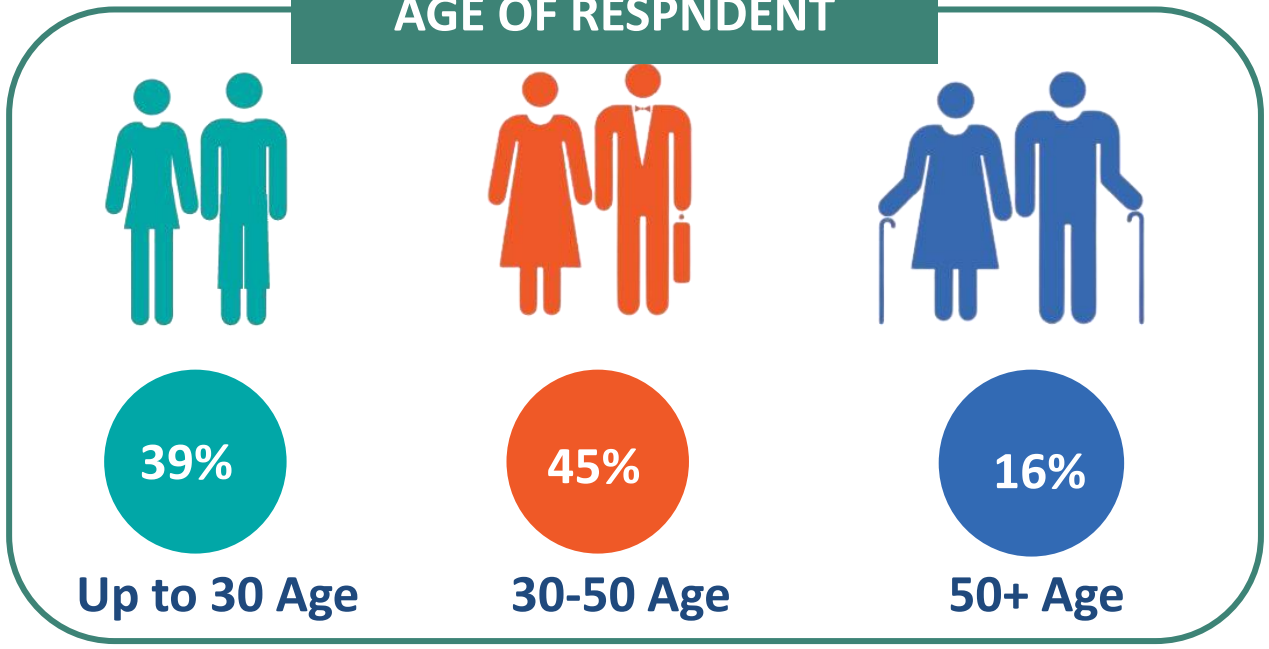

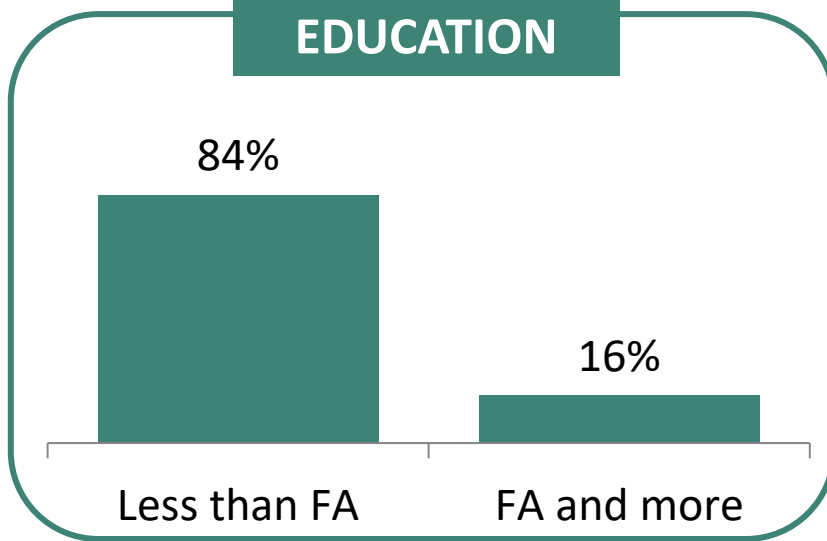

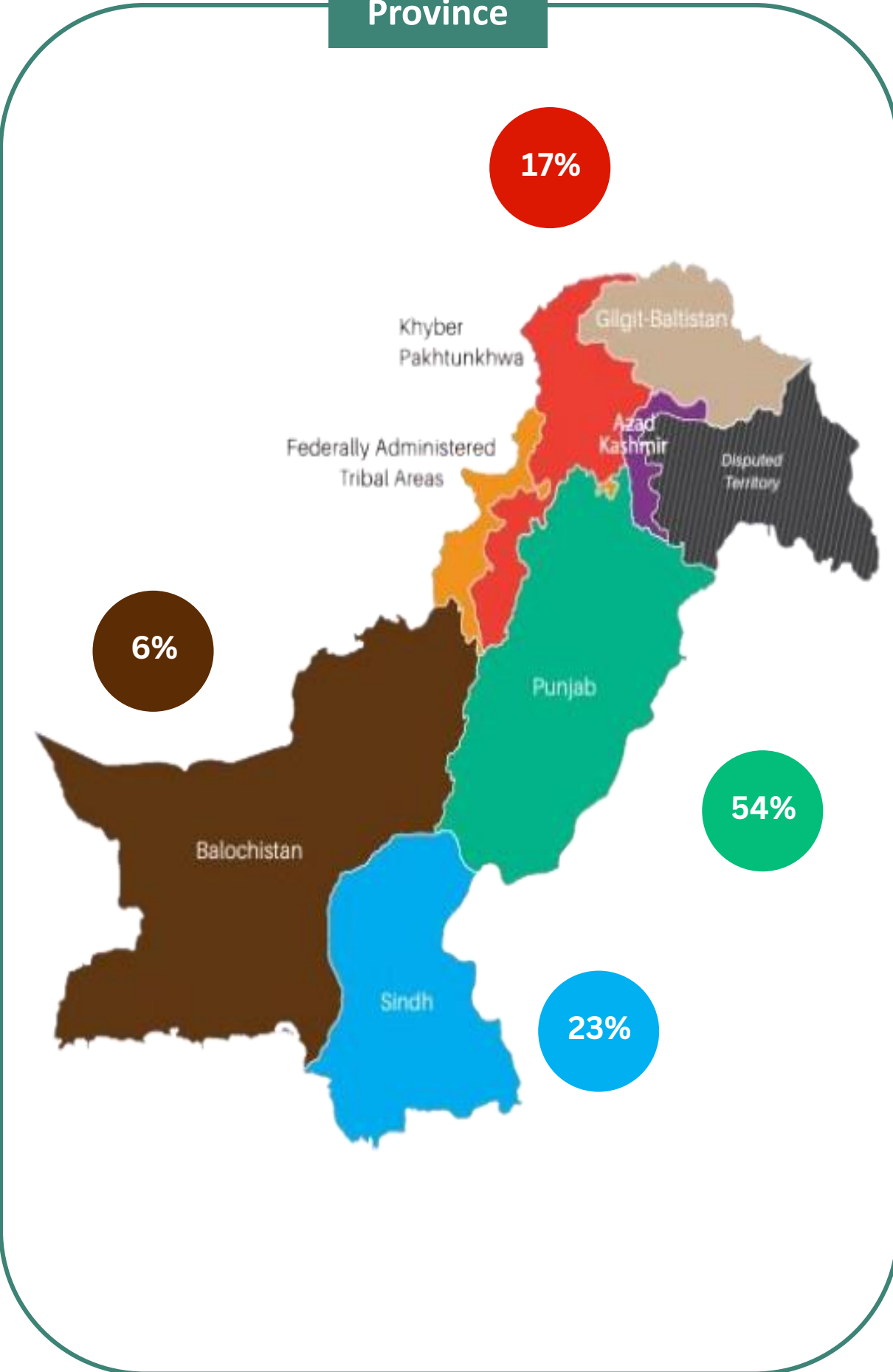
